

FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION CABINET Department of Revenue (As Amended at ARRS, August 2019)

103 KAR 15:050. Filing dates and extensions.

RELATES TO: KRS 131.081(11), 131.170, [136.100, 141.041,]141.160, 141.170[141.300] STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 131.130, <u>131.170, 141.050, 141.170</u> [141.042, 141.050, 141.300]

NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 131.170[131.081(11), 131.170, 141.042(7),] and 141.170 authorize the Department of Revenue to grant a taxpayer an extension of time to file a tax return[or to pay an installment of estimated income or limited liability entity tax]. This administrative regulation establishes the procedures to be used by an individual, a corporation, a pass-through entity, or a fiduciary[or a non corporate entity] to obtain an extension of time to file an income or limited liability entity tax return[or to pay an installment of estimated income tax for a taxable year].

Section 1. Definitions. (1) "Corporation" means a corporation as defined by KRS 141.010(4),[an S corporation as defined by KRS 141.010(25),] a limited liability company taxed as a corporation, or other entity taxed as a corporation for Kentucky income tax purposes.

- (2) "Date prescribed by KRS[136.100 or] 141.160" means the 15th day of the fourth month following the close of the taxable year.
 - (3) "Fiduciary" is defined by has the same meaning as KRS 141.010(10).
- (4) "General partnership" is a partnership composed of only general partners[5] who are personally liable for [the] partnership debts.
- (5) "Pass-through entity" is defined by [has the same meaning as] KRS 141.010(22)[21]. ["Noncorporate entity" means a partnership, a limited liability company treated as a partnership, a trust, a fiduciary, or other entity not tax as a corporation for Kentucky income tax purposes.]

Section 2. An extension of Time for Filing an <u>Individual</u>, <u>General Partnership</u>, <u>or Fiduciary</u>[Income or Limited Liability Entity] Tax Return. (1) Pursuant to KRS 131.081(11) and 141.170, a taxpayer may obtain an extension of time for filing a Kentucky <u>individual</u>, <u>general partnership</u>, <u>or fiduciary</u>[income <u>or limited liability entity</u>] tax return by means of either a federal extension or a Kentucky extension.

- (2) Federal extension.
- (a) A taxpayer granted an extension of time for filing a federal income tax return shall be granted the same extension of the due date, except as otherwise provided in KRS 141.170(2) time] for filing a Kentucky individual, general partnership, or fiduciary income or limited liability entity tax return for the same taxable year. A [if a]copy of the federal extension approval or the request for an automatic extension shall be [is] attached to the Kentucky individual, general partnership, or fiduciary [income or limited liability entity] tax return when it is filed if the taxpayer is relying upon the federal extension to extend the due date.

- (b) An extension of time for filing a Kentucky <u>individual</u>, <u>general partnership</u>, <u>or fiduciary[income or limited liability entity]</u> tax return granted pursuant to this subsection shall be valid for the extension period granted by the Internal Revenue Service[, except as otherwise <u>provided in KRS 141.170(2)</u>, in which a corporation shall be granted an extension of seven (7) month].
- (c) A copy of the federal extension shall not be mailed to the department separate from the Kentucky individual, general partnership, or fiduciary tax return. [on or before the date prescribed by KRS 141.160, except as provided in Section 3 of this administrative regulation.]

[(d) A corporation or pass-through entity shall write its Kentucky Account Number in the upper right hand corner of any federal extension submitted.]

- (3) Kentucky extension. A taxpayer may file an application for extension with the department on or before the date prescribed by KRS 141.160 for filing the return. [(a)] An individual, general partnership, or fiduciary[or a noncorporate entity] shall file Form 740EXT "Application for Extension of Time to File", Revenue Form 40A102.
- (a)[1.] An individual, general partnership, or fiduciary[or a noncorporate entity] shall state the reason for the request on the application for extension. The inability[Inability] to pay the tax liability shall not be a valid reason.
- (b)[2.] An individual, general partnership, or fiduciary[or a noncorporate entity] shall be notified by mail if the application for extension is denied. A copy of an approved application for extension shall not be returned to the <u>taxpayer.[individual, general partnership, or fiduciary or noncorporate entity.]</u>
- (c)[3-] In accordance with KRS 141.170, an individual, general partnership, or fiduciary[or a noncorporate entity] shall be granted an extension of time to file for six (6) months unless the application for extension is denied.
- (d)[4.] In accordance with KRS 141.170, an individual outside the United States shall be granted an extension of time to file for twelve (12) months unless the application for extension is denied.
- (e)[5.] A copy of the signed and dated application for extension shall be attached to the **Kentucky individual, general partnership, or fiduciary**[income] tax return when it is filed.
- Section 3. An Extension of Time for Filing a Kentucky Income or Limited Liability Entity Tax Return for Corporations and Pass-Through Entities. (1) Pursuant to KRS 131.081(11) and 141.170, a taxpayer may obtain an extension of time for filing a Kentucky income or limited liability entity tax return by means of either a federal extension or a Kentucky extension.
- (2) Federal extension. (a) A taxpayer granted an extension of time for filing a federal income tax return shall be granted the same extension of the due date, except as otherwise provided in KRS 141.170(2), for filing a Kentucky income or limited liability entity tax return for the same taxable year. A copy of the federal extension approval or the request for an automatic extension shall be attached to the Kentucky income or limited liability entity tax return when it is filed if the taxpayer is relying upon the federal extension to extend the due date.
- (b) An extension of time for filing a Kentucky income or limited liability entity tax return granted pursuant to this subsection shall be valid for the extension period granted by the Internal Revenue Service, except as otherwise provided in KRS 141.170(2).
- (c) A copy of the federal extension shall not be mailed to the department separate from the Kentucky income or limited liability entity tax return.

- (3) Kentucky extension. A taxpayer may file an application for extension with the department on or before the date prescribed by KRS 141.160 for filing the return. [(b)-]A corporation[, S-corporation,] or pass-through entity shall file Form 720EXT "Extension of Time to File Kentucky Corporation/LLET Return", Revenue Form 41A720SL.
- (a)[1.] A corporation shall be granted an extension of time to file for seven (7) months pursuant to KRS 141.170(2).[six (6) months.]
 - (b)[2.] A pass-through entity shall be granted an extension of time to file for six (6) months.
- (c)[3.] A copy of an approved application for extension shall not be returned to the corporation or pass-through entity.
- (d)[4.][3.] The extension shall become valid when mailed to the department on or before the date prescribed by KRS 141.160 for filing the return.
- (e)[5.][4.] The corporation or pass-through entity shall attach a copy of the signed and dated application for extension to its Kentucky income [tax] or limited liability entity tax[and LLET] return when it is filed["Kentucky Corporation Income Tax And LLET Return", Revenue Form 71A720, when it is filed].
- (4) An extension of time for filing <u>a Kentucky</u>[an a <u>unitary combined or elective</u> <u>eonsolidated mandatory nexus consolidated</u>] income <u>or limited liability entity</u> tax return <u>that includes more than one taxpayer</u> shall constitute an extension of time for filing for each <u>taxpayer included in the return[member of the affiliated group]</u>.
- (5) An extension of time for filing a corporation income tax return shall constitute an extension of time for filing a limited liability entity tax return for the same taxable year.
- <u>Section 4[Section 3]</u>. Payment of Tax. (1) An extension of time to file [an income or limited liability entity tax return] shall not constitute an extension of time to pay the tax.
- (2) A taxpayer shall determine if an amount of tax remains unpaid on or before the date prescribed by KRS [136.100 or]141.160 for filing the return.
- (3) If tax remains unpaid, a <u>payment[eheck]</u> for the amount of the unpaid tax shall be submitted to the department on or before the date prescribed by KRS [136.100 or]141.160 for filing the return along with the Kentucky extension <u>form to ensure proper processing of payments[or a copy of the federal extension]</u>.
- [(4) A group filing a unitary or elective consolidated income and limited liability entity tax return and making a payment of tax with the application for extension shall file a Kentucky extension to ensure proper processing of payments A corporation shall write its Kentucky Account Number in the upper right hand corner of the federal extension submitted.
- [(5) An affiliated group filing a mandatory nexus consolidated income tax return and making a payment of tax with the application for extension shall file a Kentucky extension to ensure the proper processing of payments.]
- <u>Section 5[Section 4]</u>. Interest and Penalties. (1) Statutory interest shall be paid from the date prescribed by KRS [136.100 or]141.160 for filing the return until the tax is paid.
- (2) If the envelope bearing the return is postmarked on or before the filing date, the late filing penalty prescribed by 131.180 shall not apply.
- [Section 5. Extension of Time to Pay Estimated Income Tax. (1) A request for an extension of time to pay an installment of estimated tax prescribed by KRS 141.042 and 141.300 shall be submitted to the Department of Revenue, 501 High Street, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601.
 - (2) The request shall state a basis for the extension.
- (3) An extension of time to pay an installment of estimated tax shall be granted for thirty (30) days under exceptional circumstances.

(4) Interest shall be paid from the due date of the installment of estimated tax until the tax is paid.]







RELATES TO: KRS 304.3-235[19 RS HB 220.]

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: [19 RS HB 220,] KRS 304.2-110[.]

NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 304.2-110 authorizes the commissioner of the Department of Insurance to make reasonable rules and administrative regulations necessary for or as an aid to the effectuation of any provision of the Kentucky Insurance Code, as defined in KRS 304.1-010. KRS 304.3-235[19 RS HB 220] requires insurers and insurance groups to file a corporate governance annual disclosure form. This administrative regulation provides specific details on the contents of the required disclosure and incorporates a form to be utilized by reporting entities to permit efficiency in the review and submission.

Section 1. Definitions. (1) "Corporate Governance Annual Disclosure" or "CGAD" <u>is defined by</u> <u>KRS 304.3-235(1)(c)[shall mean the corporate governance annual disclosure form to be filed pursuant to this administrative regulation].</u>

- (2) "Insurance group" <u>is defined by KRS 301.3-235(1)(a)</u>[shall mean those insurers and affiliates included within an insurance holding company system as defined by KRS 304.37-010(3)].
 - (3) "Insurer" is defined by KRS 304.37-010(7)[(2)].
- (4) "Senior Management" means["Senior Management." The term "senior management" shall mean] any corporate officer responsible for reporting information to the board of directors at regular intervals or providing this information to shareholders or regulators, such as[and shall include, for example and without limitation,] the Chief Executive Officer ("CEO"), Chief Financial Officer ("CFO"), Chief Operations Officer ("COO"), Chief Procurement Officer ("CPO"), Chief Legal Officer ("CLO"), Chief Information Officer ("CIO"), Chief Technology Officer ("CTO"), Chief Revenue Officer ("CRO"), Chief Visionary Officer ("CVO"), or any other "C" level executive.

Section 2. Filing Procedures. (1) The Corporate Governance Annual Disclosure form or CGAD form shall be filed by June 1 of each calendar year in accordance with the provisions of KRS 304.3-235(3) through (6) (1) No later than June 1 of each calendar year, an insurer required to file a CGAD, or the insurance group of which the insurer is a member required to file a CGAD, shall submit to the commissioner a Corporate Governance Annual Disclosure Form that contains the information described in Section 3 of this administrative regulation and include any additional relevant information necessary to permit the commissioner to gain an understanding of the corporate governance of the insurer or the insurance group of which the insurer is a member.

- (2) The CGAD shall include a signature of the insurer's or insurance group's chief executive officer or corporate secretary attesting to the best of that individual's belief and knowledge that the insurer or insurance group has implemented the corporate governance practices described in the CGAD and that a copy of the CGAD has been provided to the insurer's or insurance group's Board of Directors or the appropriate committee of the board of directors.
- (3)(a) The insurer or insurance group may choose to provide information on governance activities, depending on its corporate governance structure, that occur at:
- 1. The ultimate controlling parent level;
- 2. An intermediate holding company level; or
- 3. The individual legal entity level.
- (b) The insurer or insurance group is encouraged to make the CGAD disclosures at the level at which the insurer's or insurance group's:
- 1. Risk appetite is determined;
- 2. Earnings, capital, liquidity, operations, and reputation are overseen collectively and at which the supervision of those factors are coordinated and exercised; or
- 3. Legal liability for failure of general corporate governance duties would be placed.
- (c) If the insurer or insurance group determines the level of reporting based on these criteria, it shall indicate which of the three (3) criteria was used to determine the level of reporting and explain any subsequent changes in level of reporting.
- (2)[(4)] If[Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, if] the CGAD is completed at the insurance group level, then it shall be filed with the lead state of the group as determined by the procedures outlined in the most recent Financial Analysis Handbook adopted by the NAIC, which is available at www.naic.org. In these instances, a copy of the CGAD shall[must] also be provided to the chief regulatory official of any state in which the insurance group has a domestic insurer, upon request.
- [(5) An insurer or insurance group may comply with this section by referencing other existing documents if the documents provide information that is comparable to the information described in section 3. The insurer or insurance group shall clearly reference the location of the relevant information within the CGAD and attach the referenced document if it is not already filed or available to the regulator.
- (6) Each year following the initial filing of the CGAD, the insurer or insurance group shall file an amended version of the previously filed CGAD indicating where changes have been made. The filing should identify if no changes were made in the information or activities reported by the insurer or insurance group.]
- Section 3. Contents of Corporate Governance Annual Disclosure. (1) *[*The insurer or insurance group shall be as descriptive as possible in completing the CGAD, with inclusion of attachments or example documents that are used in the governance process.
- (2)] The CGAD description of the governance framework and structure required by KRS 304.3-235(5) shall include the following considerations: (a)[The CGAD shall describe the insurer's or insurance group's corporate governance framework and structure including consideration of the following:]

- (a) The board and various committees thereof ultimately responsible for overseeing the insurer or insurance group and the level at which that oversight occurs. The insurer or insurance group shall describe and discuss the rationale for the current board size and structure; and
- (b) The duties of the board and each of its significant committees and how they are governed, as well as how the board's leadership is structured, including a discussion of the roles of chief executive officer and chairman of the board within the organization.
- (2) In accordance with KRS 304.3-235(5)(a)4., the description of the policies and practices of the most senior governing entity and significant committees shall include a discussion of the following factors:[(3) The insurer or insurance group shall describe the policies and practices of the most senior governing entity and significant committees thereof, including a discussion of the following factors:]
- (a) How the qualifications, expertise and experience of each board member meet the needs of the insurer or insurance group.
- (b) How an appropriate amount of independence is maintained on the board and its significant committees.
- (c) The number of meetings held by the board and its significant committees over the past year as well as information on director attendance.
- (d) How the insurer or insurance group identifies, nominates, and elects members to the board and its committees. The discussion should include, for example:
- 1. Whether a nomination committee is in place to identify and select individuals for consideration;
 - 2. Whether term limits are placed on directors;
 - 3. How the election and re-election processes function; and
 - 4. Whether a board diversity policy is in place and if so, how it functions.
- (e) The processes in place for the board to evaluate its performance and the performance of its committees, as well as any recent measures taken to improve performance. [{-] including any board or committee training programs that have been put in place.]-].
- (3)[(4)] The insurer or insurance group shall describe the policies and practices for directing senior management, including a description of the following factors:
- (a) Any processes or practices (i.e., suitability standards) to determine whether officers and key persons in control functions have the appropriate background, experience and integrity to fulfill their prospective roles, including:
- 1. Identification of the specific positions for which suitability standards have been developed and a description of the standards employed; and
- 2. Any changes in an officer's or key person's suitability as outlined by the insurer's or insurance group's standards and procedures to monitor and evaluate **these**[such] changes.
- (b) The insurer's or insurance group's code of business conduct and ethics, the discussion of which considers, for example:
 - 1. Compliance with laws, rules, and administrative regulations; and
 - 2. Proactive reporting of any illegal or unethical behavior.
- (c) The insurer's or insurance group's processes for performance evaluation, compensation, and corrective action to ensure effective senior management throughout the organization,

including a description of the general objectives of significant compensation programs and what the programs are designed to reward. The description shall include sufficient detail to allow the commissioner to understand how the organization ensures that compensation programs do not encourage **or[**and/or] reward excessive risk taking. Elements to be discussed may include, for example:

- 1. The board's role in overseeing management compensation programs and practices;
- 2. The various elements of compensation awarded in the insurer's or insurance group's compensation programs and how the insurer or insurance group determines and calculates the amount of each element of compensation paid;
- 3. How compensation programs are related to both company and individual performance over time;
- 4. Whether compensation programs include risk adjustments and how those adjustments are incorporated into the programs for employees at different levels;
- 5. Any clawback provisions built into the programs to recover awards or payments if the performance measures upon which they are based are restated or otherwise adjusted; and
- 6. Any other factors relevant in understanding how the insurer or insurance group monitors its compensation policies to determine whether its risk management objectives are met by incentivizing its employees.
 - (d) The insurer's or insurance group's plans for CEO and senior management succession.
- (4) The description of processes required by KRS 304.3-235(5)(a)4.c. shall include a discussion of:[(5) The insurer or insurance group shall describe the processes by which the board, its committees and senior management ensure an appropriate amount of oversight to the critical risk areas impacting the insurer's business activities, including a discussion of:]
- (a) How oversight and management responsibilities are delegated between the board, its committees, and senior management;
- (b) How the board is kept informed of the insurer's strategic plans, the associated risks, and steps that Senior Management is taking to monitor and manage those risks;
- (c) How reporting responsibilities are organized for each critical risk area. The description should allow the commissioner to understand the frequency at which information on each critical risk area is reported to and reviewed by senior management and the board. This description may include, for example, the following critical risk areas of the insurer:
- 1. Risk management processes, *for example, an [(An)* ORSA Summary Report filer may refer to its ORSA Summary Report pursuant to the Risk Management and Own Risk and Solvency Assessment Model Act, *NAIC model law III-505[)]*;
 - 2. Actuarial function;
 - 3. Investment decision-making processes;
 - 4. Reinsurance decision-making processes;
 - 5. Business strategy or finance[strategy/finance] decision-making processes;
 - 6. Compliance function;
 - 7. Financial reporting or internal auditing [reporting/internal auditing]; and
 - 8. Market conduct decision-making processes.




