IRS Guidance on Incorrect 1099-G

- Taxpayers who receive an incorrect Form 1099-G for unemployment benefits they
 did not receive should contact the issuing state agency to request a revised Form
 1099-G showing they did not receive these benefits.
- Taxpayers who are unable to obtain a timely, corrected form from states should still file an accurate tax return, reporting only the income they received.
- A corrected Form 1099-G showing zero unemployment benefits in cases of identity theft will help taxpayers avoid being hit with an unexpected federal tax bill for unreported income.
- The IRS previously issued guidance requested by states on identity theft guidance regarding unemployment compensation reporting. No Forms 1099-G should be issued to those individuals the states have identified as ID theft victims.
