



Healthcare Jumpstart Program UK Health Care — BCTC Partnership (Cont.)

This partnership allows students to complete prerequisite courses while still in high school

Program begins during freshman year of high school

In the spring semester of the senior year, students will enroll at BCTC, complete the Selective Admission Application process, and begin the first nursing course in August

Healthcare Jumpstart Program UK Health Care — BCTC Partnership (Cont.)



Support is provided in a variety of ways: exploring and cultivating student's interest in nursing - saving time and money as they earn their credentials & laying the foundation for a future career

While completing the program, students have the option to accept a full-tuition scholarship from UK HealthCare, guaranteeing employment upon graduations.

Other Efforts

Along with increasing capacity, admitting each semester is helping in three significant ways:



Improves retention of existing students since they can now immediately jump back into the program in the following semester should they fail a course or have some other life events



Improves transitioning from the LPN to the ADN program



Improves workload satisfaction to retain faculty by reducing the "new course" preparation load and providing a more consistent teaching schedule
