In-House Electronic Poll Book System (EPB)

Under KRS 117.001(9), an e-poll book is “an electronic device capable of holding a file of voter data and related information for use in identifying registered voters prior to a voter’s receiving or casting a ballot and allowing a voter to electronically sign in on an electronic registered voter roster in lieu of signing a paper registered voter roster.”
