



Anderson Forest Products out of Tompkinsville, KY produces high quality, specification-based wood products. Their most popular products are custom reels, crates, and shipping platforms, which are available in hardwood and plywood. They were able to increase production capacity 30%, reduce cycle time, increase quality, increase customer base and improve safety with the installation of a new custom lay-up automation cell while adding 5 full-time positions to their team.

Murray Mold and Die out of Murray, KY is a contract tool and die shop and is primarily engaged in manufacturing special tools and fixtures for use with machine tools, hammers, die-casting machines, and presses. They were able to increase production speed 39%, add capacity, improve accuracy and reduce lead times with the installation of a new EDM Machine while increasing their workforce by nearly 5%.


