Road Fund Cash Management



History of Cash Management

- With the enactment of the 2000-2002 Biennial Budget, the General Assembly established the Prefinancing Road Projects Program.
- The 2002-2004 Biennial Budget added the requirement of the Cabinet to maintain a minimum Road Fund cash management target of \$100 million.
- Prior to Fiscal Year 2000, the Cabinet managed the highway program on an obligation basis by setting aside the entire cost of a highway project phase at the time work was approved to begin.
- The Cabinet has developed cash management practices and tools to forecast and monitor cash activity on an on-going basis.
- The Authorization Review Team (ART) meets regularly to discuss financial status of the Road Fund and cashflow impacts and to plan for SYP project authorizations.
