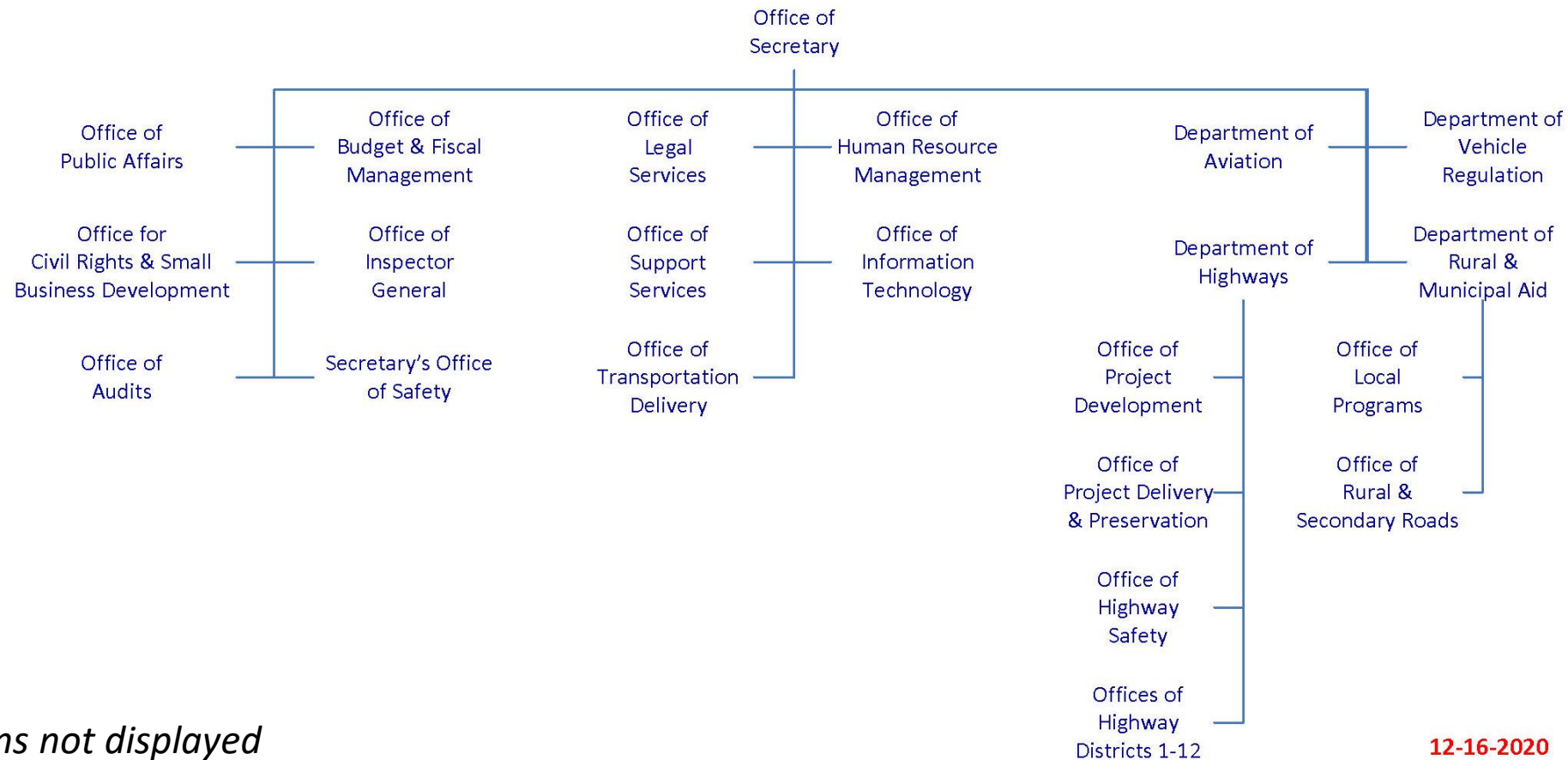


## Functional Responsibilities

# KYTC Organization Chart

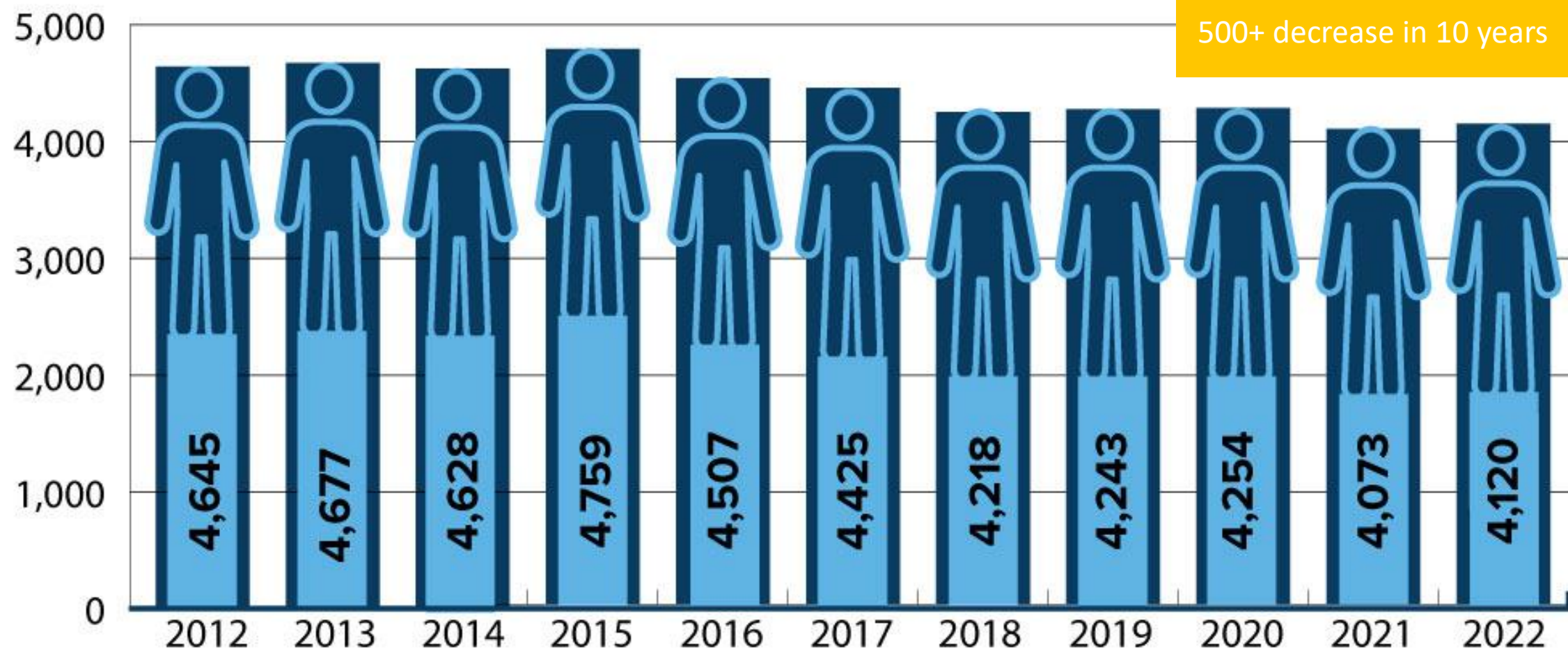

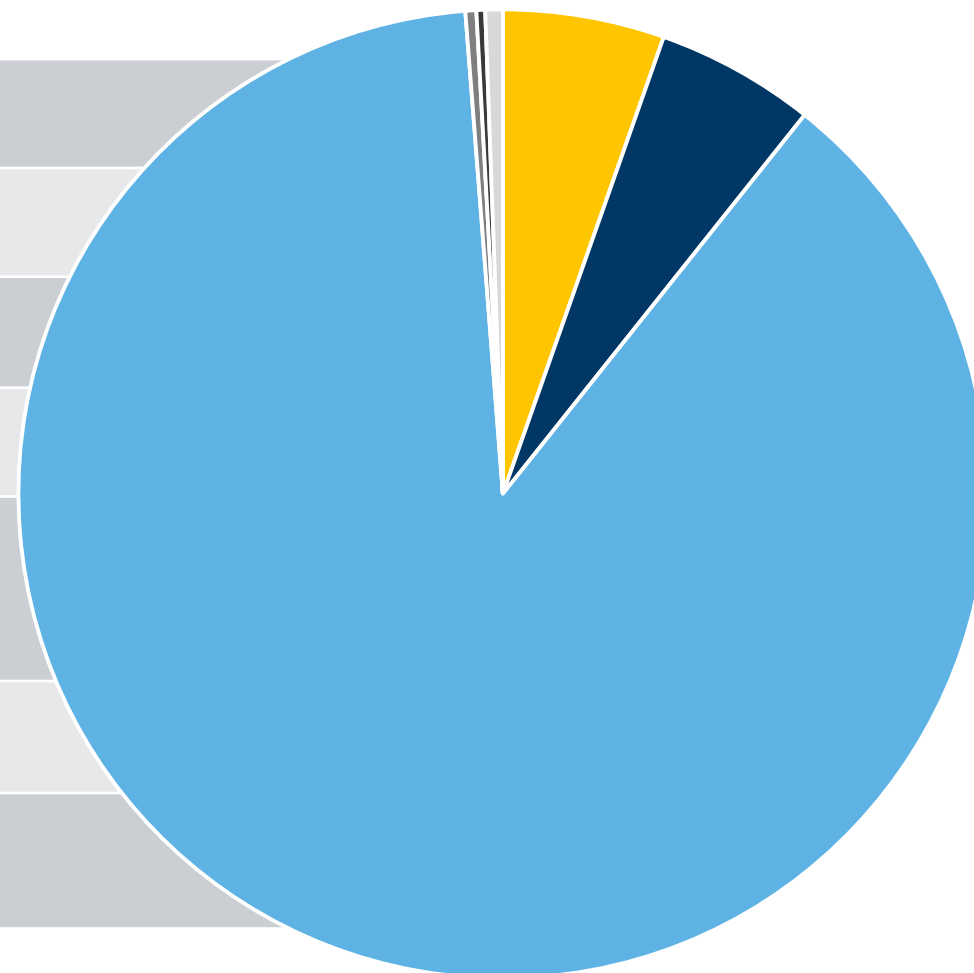
