LOCAL ASSISTANCE ROAD PROGRAM FY 27 APPLICATION CYCLE SUMMARY

The FY 27 Application Cycle began on June 1, 2025, ended on October 1, 2025:

Total Projects Submitted:	1,223
Total Project Cost Submitted:	\$121,329,654.51
Total Amount Requested (after match):	\$102, 433,041.55
# of Counties Applied (116 represented):	108
# of Cities Applied:	106

Total length of road mileage: 1,059.3 miles

LOCAL ASSISTANCE ROAD PROGRAM FUNDING FY 27

House Joint Resolution 76 signed into law -

Lists projects for the Local Assistance Road Program (“LARP”) - Totaling:

FY 27 = \$70,189,400.00
(less \$324,500 in duplicates = \$69,864,900)

FY 28 = \$20,000,000.00 + carryover

LOCAL ASSISTANCE ROAD PROGRAM FUNDING DISTRIBUTION FOR FY27

- Funds from House Joint Resolution 76 are allocated in Fiscal Year 2027.
- Memorandums of Agreement have been prepared and should be released for execution by the local public agencies today.
- Work may begin as soon as Memorandums of Agreement are finally executed.

LOCAL ASSISTANCE ROAD PROGRAM APPLICATION CYCLE FOR FY28

- Application Cycle Opened June 1, 2026.
- 6 applications, from 2 Counties and 4 Cities, have been received and are being processed as of June 24th.
- The applications through June 24, 2026 include 32 projects totaling \$2,685,434.



COUNTY/CITY BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

COUNTY/CITY BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

FY 2025 & FY 2026 - \$25 million authorized for each year

Summary of Awards:

- FY 2025: Phase I, II, and III:

- i. 58 Bridges funded: 41 replacement projects & 7 repair/preservation projects
- ii. Total funding authorized - \$24,988,014

- FY 2026: Phase IV, V, VI, & VII:

- i. 48 Bridges funded: 39 replacement projects & 9 repair/preservation projects
- ii. Total funding authorized - \$25,740,369.60
- iii. Phase VII will be announced soon.
- iv. Total Underruns during biennium: \$728,959.51

- **TOTAL FUNDING FOR FY 2025-2026 REMAINING: \$575.92**

COUNTY/CITY BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

FY 2025 & FY 2026 - \$50 million authorized

- Total Bridges Awarded: 106 bridges for repair and/or replacement
- Total Completed: 23 bridges (includes finalized reimbursement requests)

- TOTAL FUNDING AWARDED: \$49,999,424.08
- TOTAL FUNDING REMAINING: \$575.92
