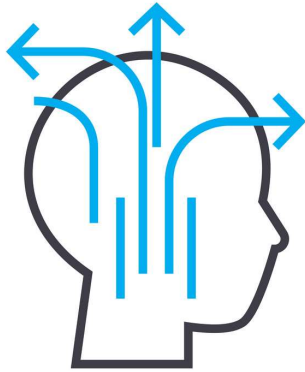

- **Goal #3:** To have a greater influence on public policy relating to child sexual abuse and exploitation

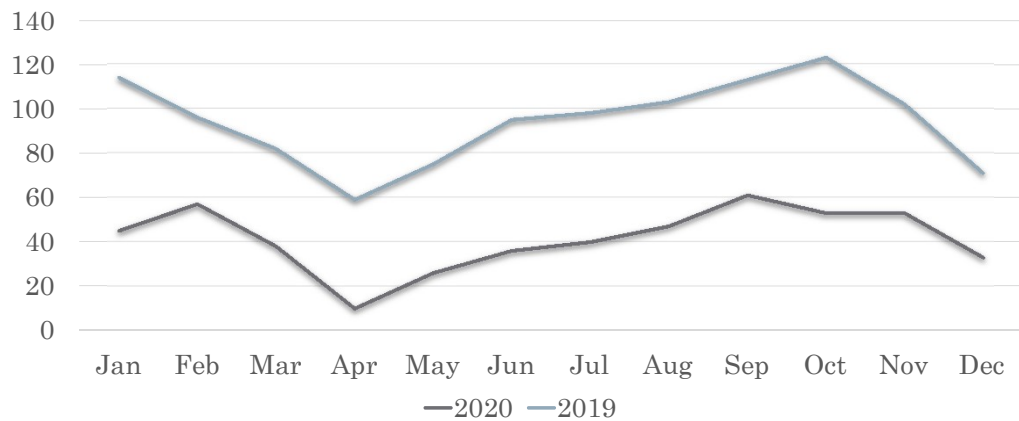

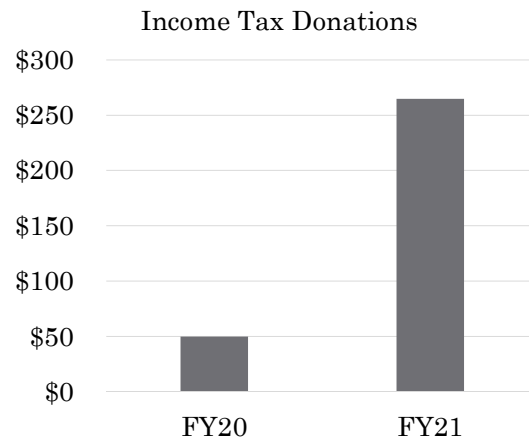
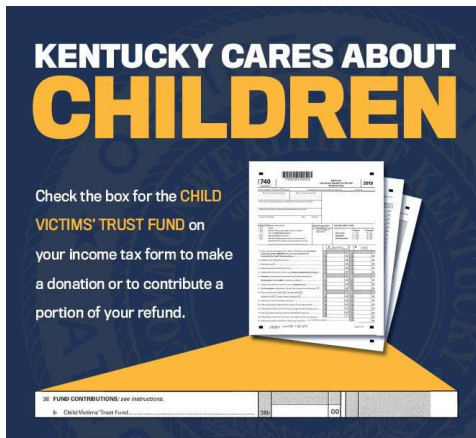
## Child Victims' Trust Fund

- Funds regional and statewide prevention programs

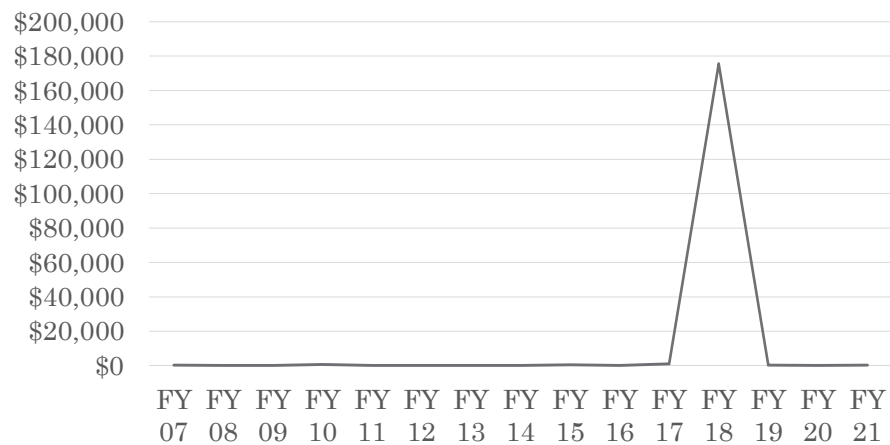

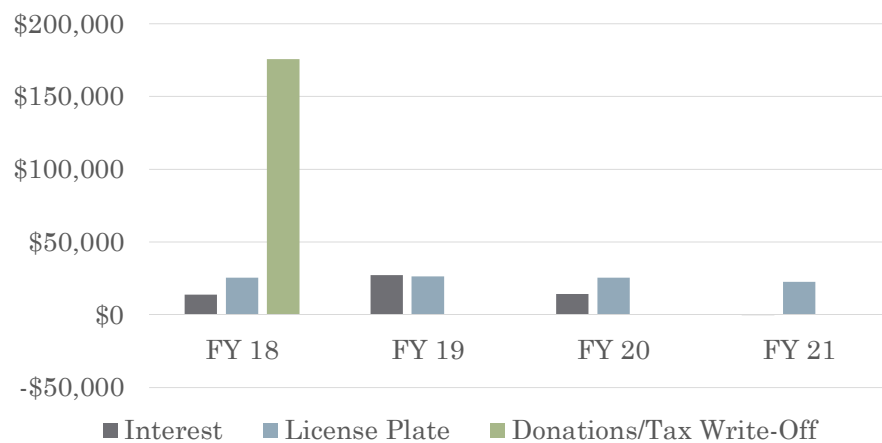

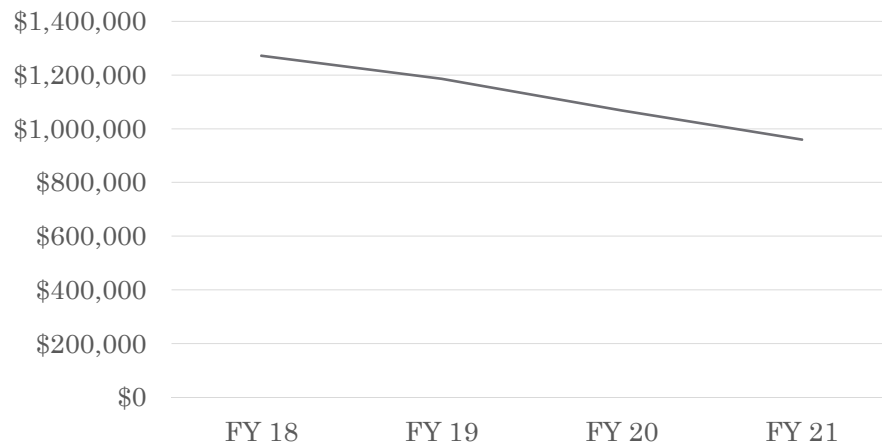
## CVTF License Plate Revenue - Historical



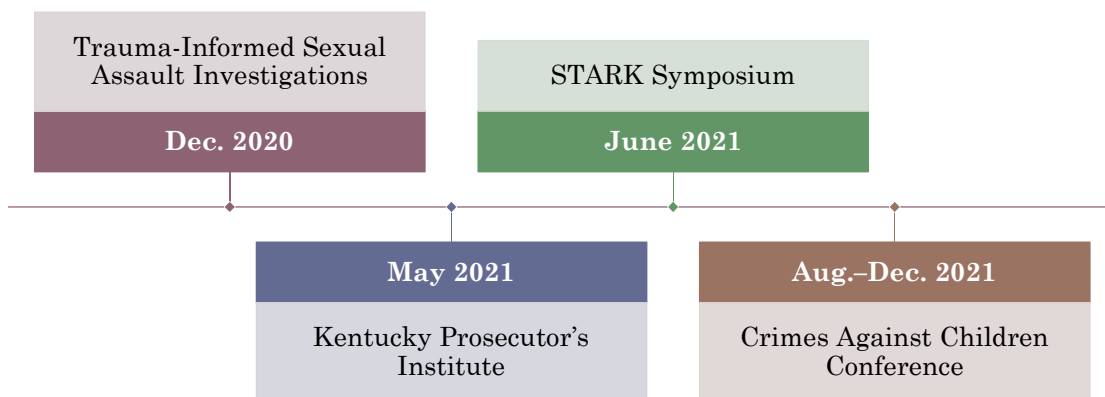
## CVTF Revenue Generated
