#### Responsibilities of the Board

- Coordinate an exchange of information for the establishment and maintenance of child maltreatment prevention programs
- Develop and publicize Child Victim's Trust Fund (CVTF) opportunities
- Review, approve, and monitor expenditures of the CVTF
- Provide statewide educational and public informational seminars to develop appropriate public awareness regarding the prevention of child maltreatment
- Publish annual report of recommendations to reduce child maltreatment



- "Are They Good for Your Kids" campaign
  - Sponsored by Prevent Child Abuse Kentucky and educated caregivers on child safety issues
  - The campaign has received more than 5,141,268 impressions on social media





- Family Nurturing Center
  - Provided "Stewards of Children" training to 2,000 adult community members
  - 91% of participants indicated being more informed about ways to reduce child maltreatment

- Exploited Children's Help Organization (ECHO)
  - Educated children and adults in youth-serving organizations on preventing child abuse using evidenced based trainings (e.g., Darkness to Light initiative)
  - From July 2021 to June 2022 ECHO trained 3,620 children and 1,229 adults in Jefferson County



- South Central Kentucky Kids on the Block
  - Trained 6,148 children on child abuse prevention
  - 26 disclosures reported






#### **CVTF Medical Exam Reimbursements**
