


THE KRS PENSION CONUNDRUMS

As pension contribution rates go up, employers:

- May outsource
- Might not replace retirees and other terminations
- May withhold wage increases

All could potentially result in:

- A declining payroll
- Requiring a higher contribution rate to cover the normal cost and pay the unfunded liability
- More employee cut backs
- ...and so on.

- Continuing to improve our investment management
- Operating most effectively and efficiently

- Extend the moratorium for another year for the 49.43% contribution rate
- Evaluate plan to be determined by KRS
- A plan is being worked on by DPH and LHDs
 - Improve the financial sustainability of Local Health Departments
 - Improve Health Status
