

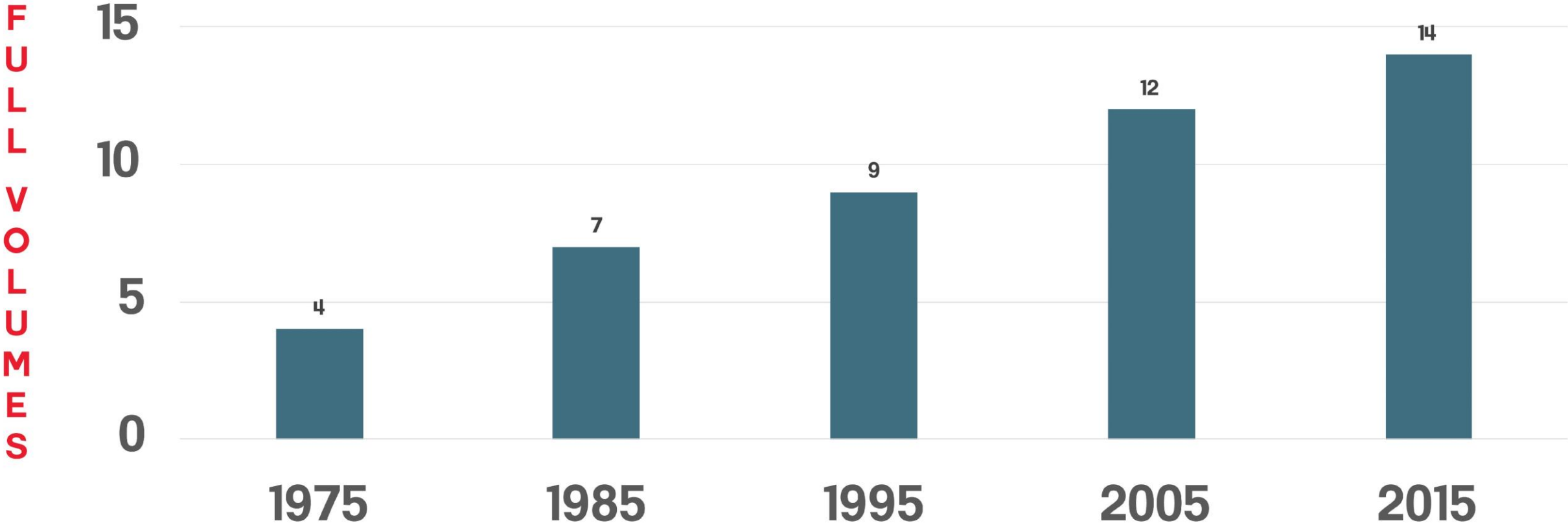

## **GOALS OF RED TAPE REDUCTION:**

- **REPEAL OBSOLETE REGULATIONS AND AMEND OVERLY RESTRICTIVE ONES, 33% REDUCTION OVERALL**
- **CREATE THE LEAST RESTRICTIVE REGULATORY ENVIRONMENT WITHOUT COMPROMISING PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY**
- **ALIGN WITH FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS.**
- **AVOID INCONSISTENCIES, UNNECESSARY DUPLICATION**
- **MAKE REGULATIONS EASIER TO CONSISTENTLY UPDATE BY MODERNIZING AND DIGITIZING OUR REGULATORY CODE AND PROCESS**
- **KENTUCKY IS TRANSFORMING STATE GOVERNMENT FROM REGULATION MAKERS INTO REGULATION MANAGERS.**

**OVERALL RED TAPE REDUCTION PROJECT:**

- **4,700+ REGULATIONS, 2208 REVIEWED SO FAR (47%)**



**395 REPEALED**



**787 AMENDED**



**54% OF REVIEWED REGULATIONS REQUIRED REPEAL OR AMENDING.**

- **GOAL IS TO ELIMINATE OR REVISE 1/3RD OF ALL REGS BY END OF 2019...WITHOUT COMPROMISING HEALTH, SAFETY OR SERVICE**



# **RTR SUCCESS STORIES**

- **ELIMINATION OF “CUT RULE” REINTRODUCED PRO WRESTLING TO KENTUCKY**
- **KYTC - NEW ONLINE SYSTEM MAKES FOR EASY SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED OF KY’S APPROXIMATELY 140,000 CDL HOLDERS. STREAMLINES DOCUMENT SUBMISSION, MAKES IT EASIER FOR SMALL BUSINESSES TO OPERATE WITH KYTC**
- **NEW METAL COMMODITIES OVER-WEIGHT HAULING PERMIT ENABLES ALUMINUM AND OTHER METAL INDUSTRIES TO RECEIVE THE SAME BENEFITS EXTENDED TO THE STEEL INDUSTRY, ENHANCING THE KY COMPETITIVE LANDSCAPE**

# IMPROVED SERVICE METRIC EXAMPLES:

- **CONSTRUCTION PLAN REVIEWS BY HBC: 90% REDUCTION IN REVIEW TIME (WAS 56 WORKDAYS, NOW 5 ON AVG), AFTER FUNCTION WAS REORGANIZED AND REGS WERE STREAMLINED.**
- **IN 2018 PLUMBING DIVISION IS STARTING TO DO LIVE SKYPE INSPECTIONS, SAVING TIME AND TRAVEL COSTS, AND SPEEDING UP CONSTRUCTION.**
- **KY CLAIMS COMMISSION WAS REORGANIZED AND STREAMLINED, SAVING OVER \$300K/YR. 6 YEAR BACKLOG OF PAYMENTS TO CRIME VICTIMS WAS CLEARED.**
- **KY REAL ESTATE AUTHORITY WAS REORGANIZED AND STREAMLINED, WITH A REDUCTION IN STAFFING, COSTS AND OFFICE SPACE. ONLINE LICENSING WAS IMPLEMENTED AND (AFTER A FEW STARTUP BUMPS) HAS NOW IMPROVED SERVICE TIME SIGNIFICANTLY.**

# PRO-BUSINESS REGULATION CHANGES:

- **DPL STREAMLINED OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING, USING ONLINE LICENSING APPLICATION FOR 23 BOARDS & REGISTRIES UNDER PPC.**
- **ELIMINATED THE REQUIREMENT FOR CAST IRON PIPING IN BUILDINGS OVER 45FT TALL, SAVED THE INDUSTRY MILLIONS WITH NO SAFETY COMPROMISE.**
- **ELIMINATED DOI REGULATION REQUIRING THAT PRIVACY NOTICES BE MAILED ANNUALLY. INSTEAD, THEY ARE MAILED ONLY IF THERE IS A CHANGE. WILL SAVE INSURANCE COMPANIES MILLIONS WITH NO IMPACT TO CONSUMERS.**
- **EEC SUCCESSFULLY PETITIONED FEDERAL EPA TO DROP THE REFORMULATED GASOLINE (RFG) REQUIREMENT FOR NORTHERN KY, SAVING CITIZENS 18 CENTS A GALLON STARTING JULY 1 2018.**

- CONTINUE TOWARD 33% REDUCTION/UPDATE OF REGULATIONS
- DIGITIZATION AND MODERNIZATION OF REGULATORY PROMULGATION
- SYNCHRONIZE STATE AND FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS

- GET IT DONE WITHOUT COMPROMISING PUBLIC SAFETY OR SERVICE!
