Revision to Proposed Regulation

105 KAR 1:411



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This regulation establishes procedures for the administration of the hospital and medical insurance benefits provided to retirees of the KPPA administered systems, as well as establishes eligibility requirements, necessary documentation for proof of insurance, deadlines for filing for reimbursement, and forms.



Revision to Proposed Regulation

- 1. KPPA seeks revisions to the proposed amendment to 105 KAR 1:411 Section 4(1)(b)(3) for consistency with language used throughout this regulation and other KPPA regulations.
- 2. Revisions to proposed amendment to 105 KAR 1:411 Section 4(1)(b)(3) before this Joint Committee:

For a member with a <u>membership</u>[hire] date that began July 1, 2003 through July 31, 2004, his or her hire date shall be used to determine if the hospital and medical insurance plan premiums are paid as a percentage of the [single premium] contribution rate as established in subparagraph 1. of this paragraph, or as a dollar amount of the contribution rate as established in subparagraph 2. of this paragraph.
