 12-week intensive program focused on addressing barriers in five domains of life: physical, financial, spiritual, relational, and emotional








Comparative Barriers: September 2018-2020 Cohorts





Reentry, Recovery & Recidivism Reduction


 Alleviates Judges, Prosecutors, and Public Defenders "serving" dual roles as social workers

- Increases judicial efficiency
- Decreases overcrowding in the detention center
- Enhances community partnership collaboration

Multidisciplinary Recovery Reentry Team (MRRT)


 A community driven team that provides care interventions and resources in association with the judicial process, minimizing convictions with the goal of reducing recidivism.

Stakeholders



- Weekly Meetings
- Collaboration and coordination of services to reduce relapse and recidivism
- All stakeholders are involved preventing someone falling through the cracks as they move through treatment continuum

MRRT Methodology






<u>Life Learning Center – Economic Impact</u>



\$141,000 in detention costs every rolling 30-day period

\$1 invested in Life Learning Center = \$2.17 in detention cost savings

(average of 100 diverted inmates receiving services from Life Learning Center)



- Cost of \$47 per day in County detention (including medical)
- Life Learning Center program costs from 2018 Form 990
