- 12-week intensive program focused on addressing barriers in five domains of life: **physical, financial, spiritual, relational, and emotional**

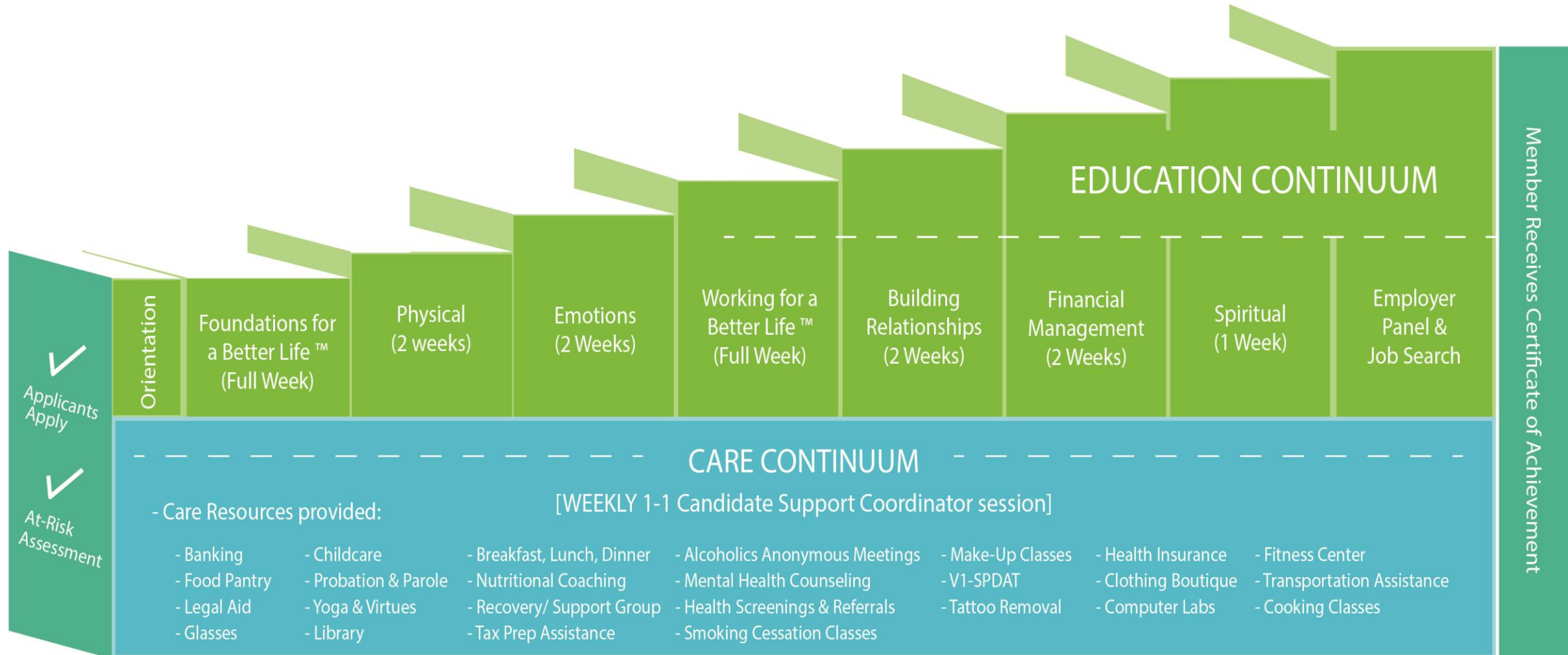

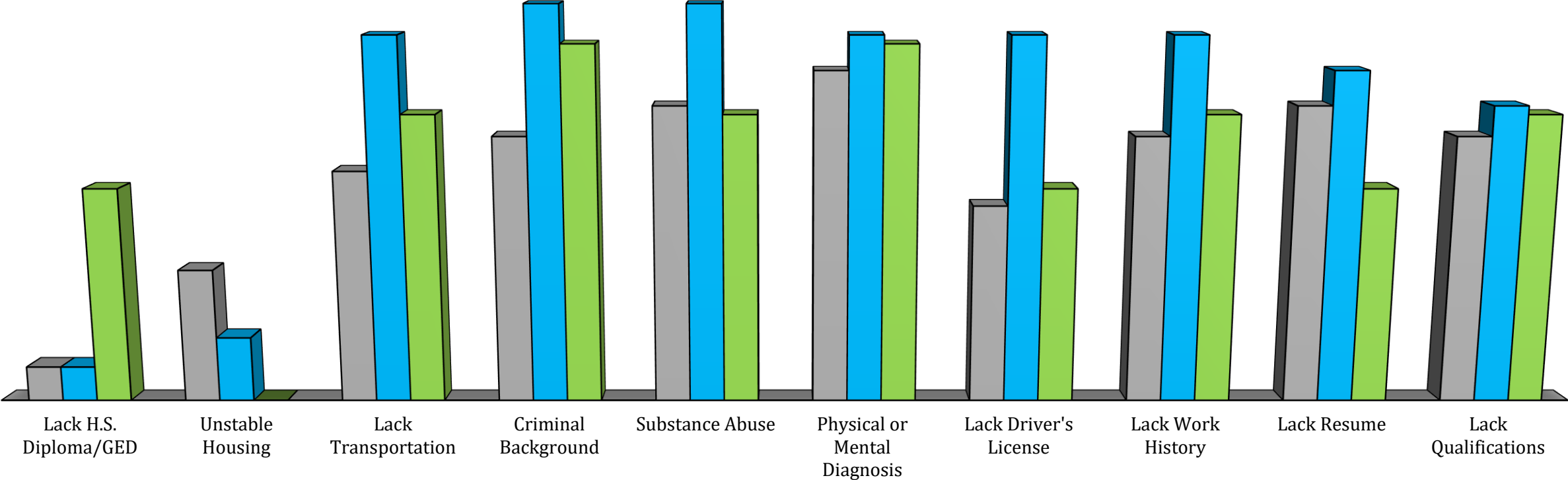

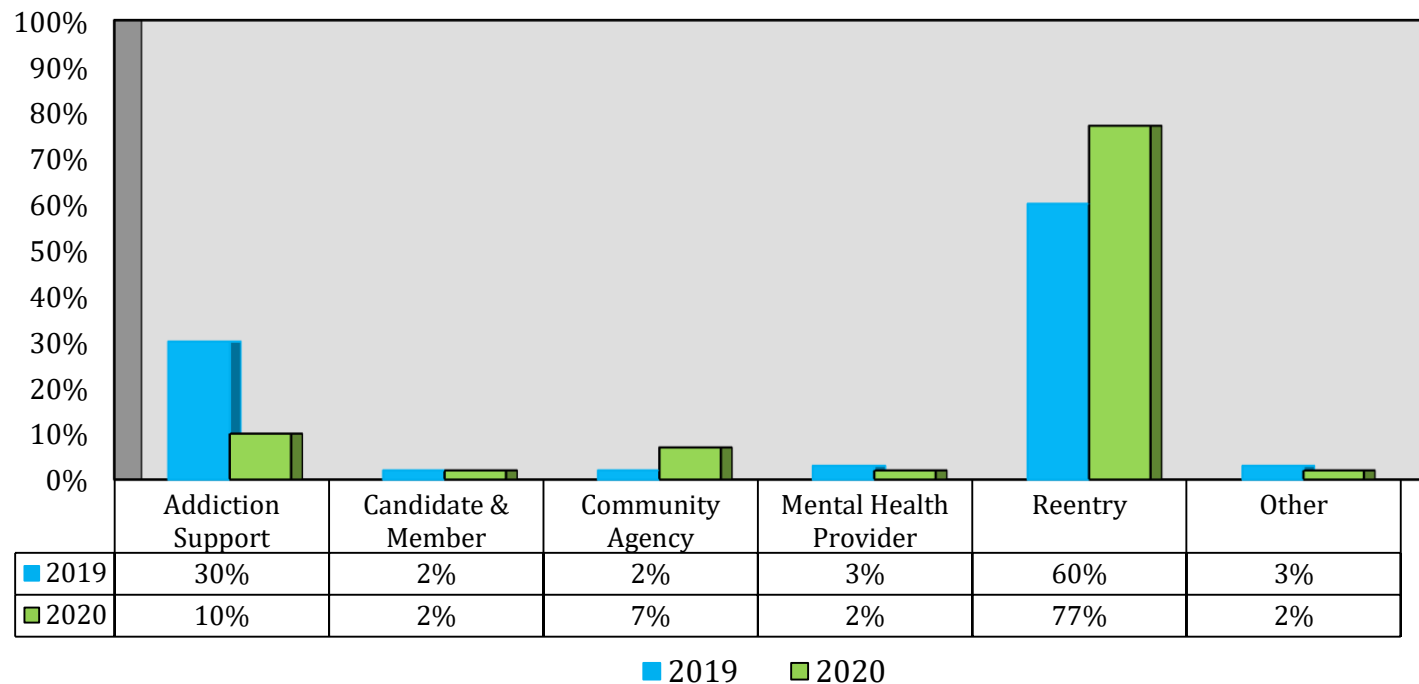

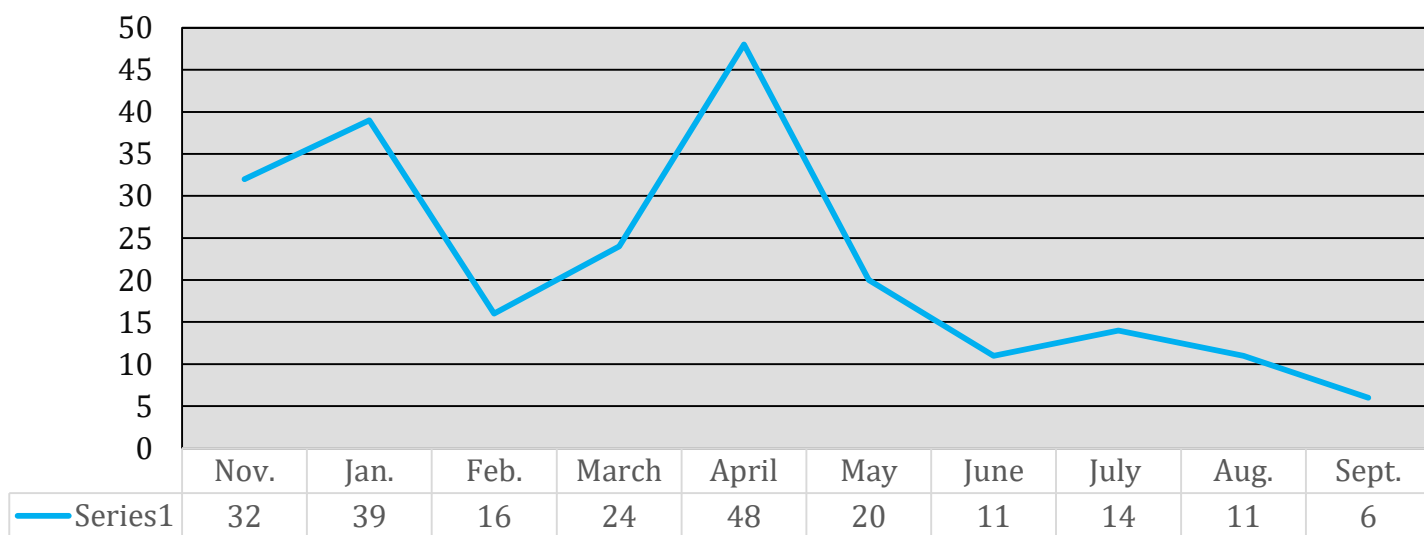

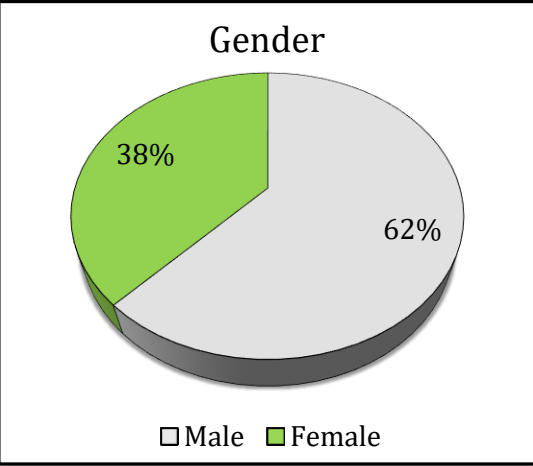
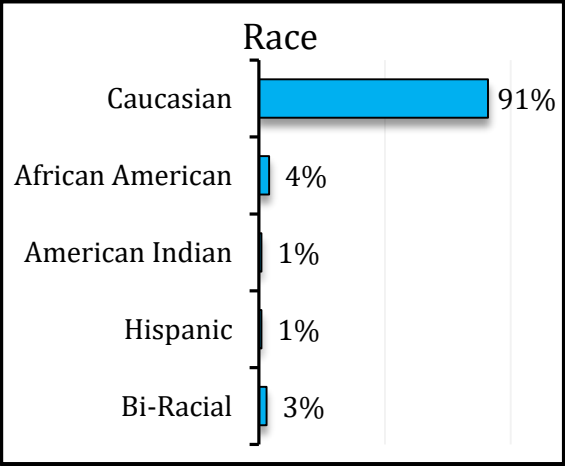
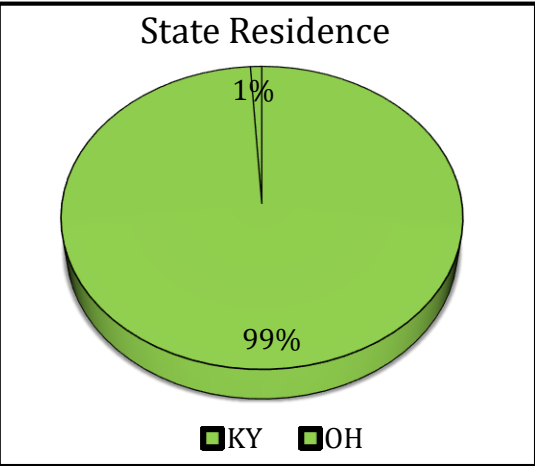
Candidates Enrolled Per Month



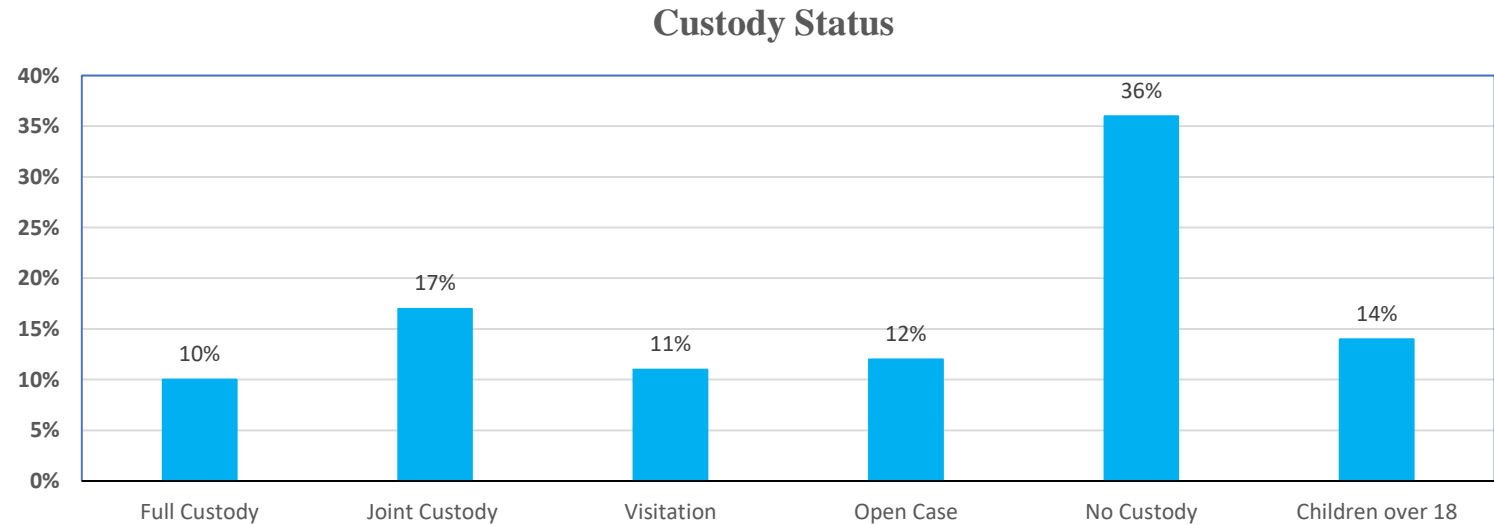
Candidate & Family Demographics

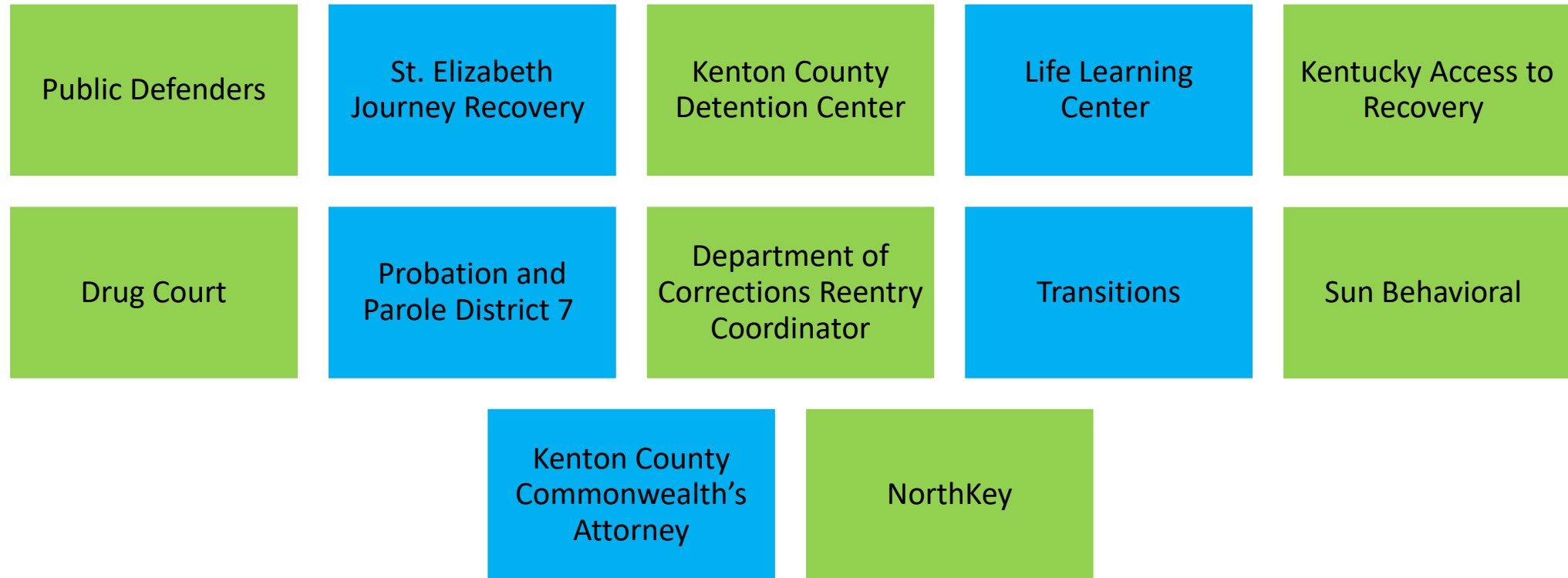
Reentry, Recovery & Recidivism Reduction

- **Alleviates Judges, Prosecutors, and Public Defenders “serving” dual roles as social workers**
- **Increases judicial efficiency**
- **Decreases overcrowding in the detention center**
- **Enhances community partnership collaboration**

Multidisciplinary Recovery Reentry Team (MRRT)

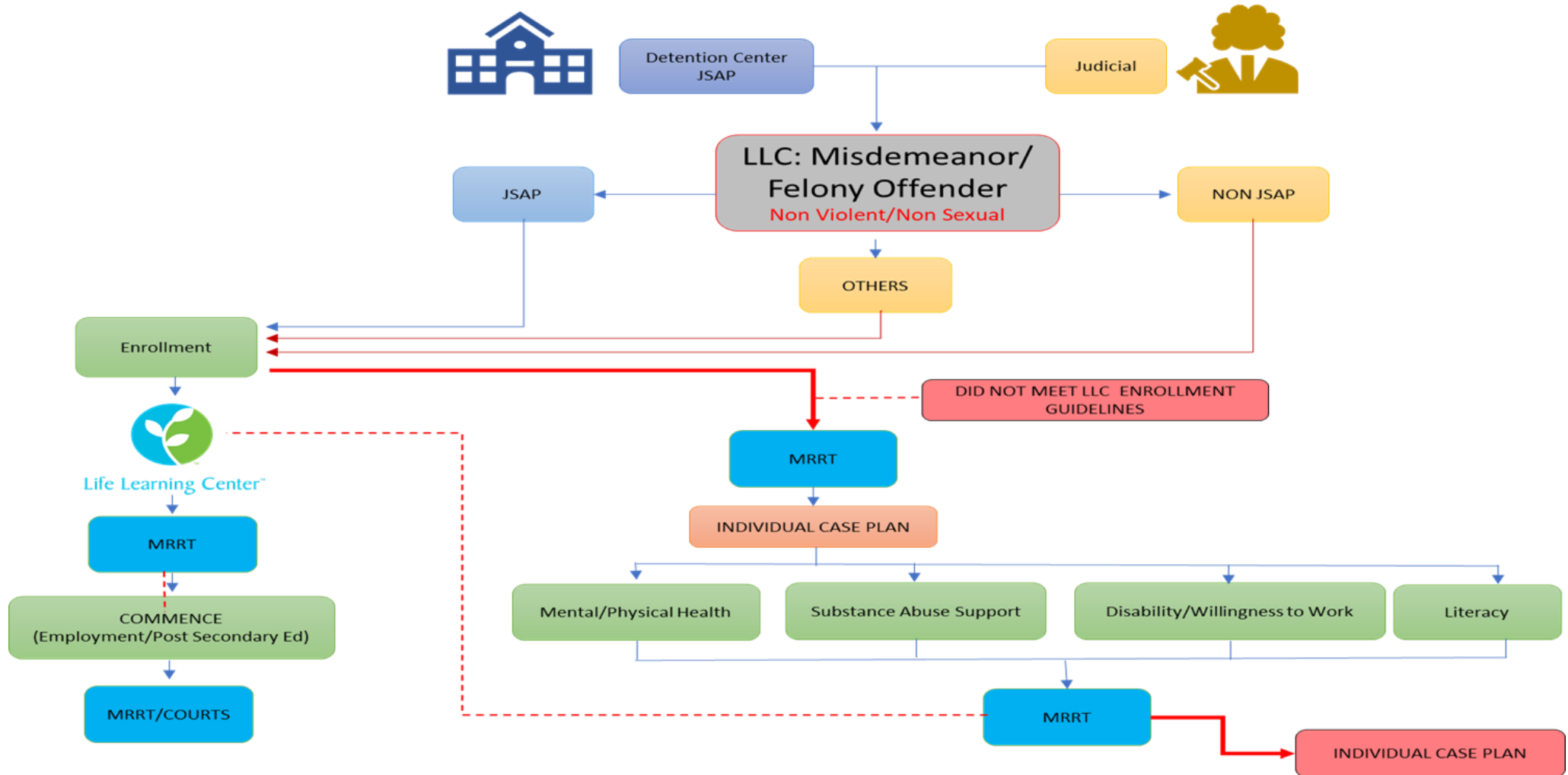
- **A community driven team that provides care interventions and resources in association with the judicial process, minimizing convictions with the goal of reducing recidivism.**

Stakeholders



- **Weekly Meetings**
- **Collaboration and coordination of services to reduce relapse and recidivism**
- **All stakeholders are involved preventing someone falling through the cracks as they move through treatment continuum**

MRRT Methodology

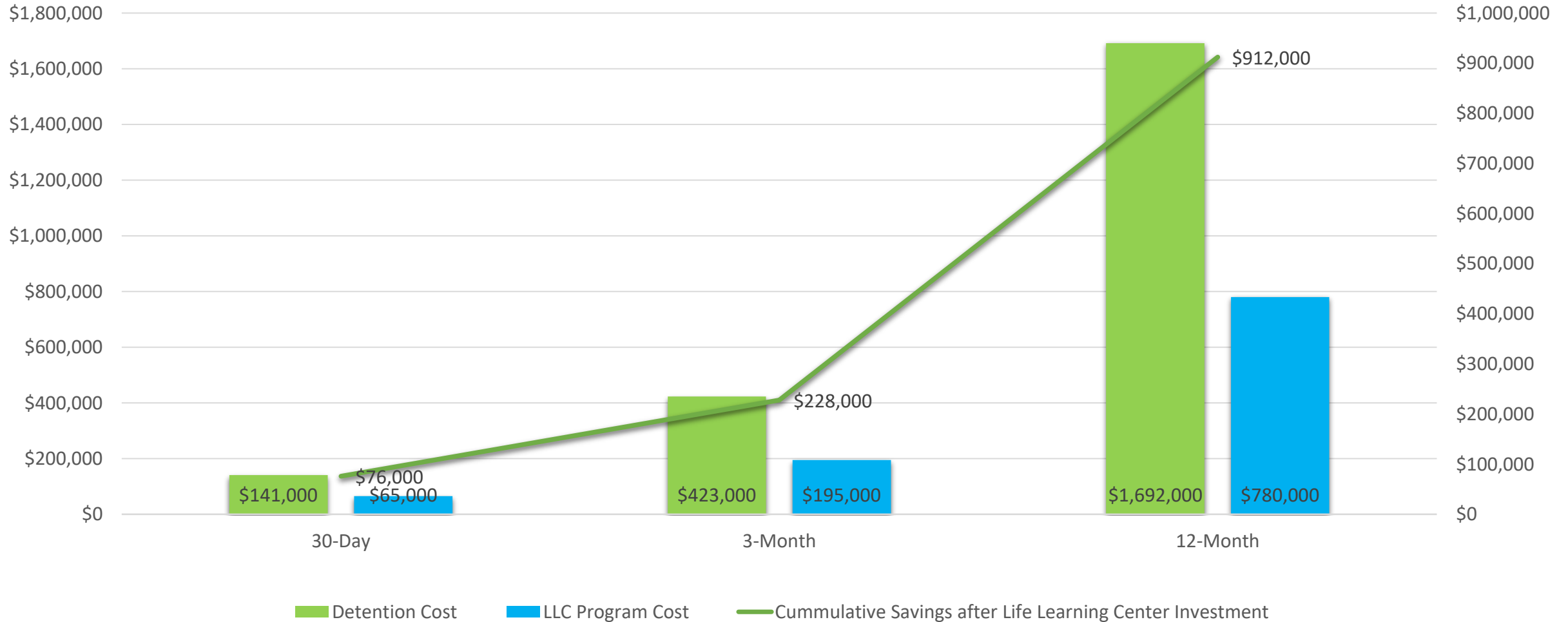


Life Learning Center – Economic Impact

\$141,000 in detention costs every rolling 30-day period

\$1 invested in Life Learning Center = \$2.17 in detention cost savings

(average of 100 diverted inmates receiving services from Life Learning Center)



- Cost of \$47 per day in County detention (including medical)
- Life Learning Center program costs from 2018 Form 990
