Passed in 2011

WHY AN ID MATTERS

- ACCESS TO JOBS
- ACCESS TO HOUSING
- INTERACTION WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT
- OPEN A BANK ACCOUNT
- ACCESSING GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS

ID ACCESS BILL

- Lowers the Cost of an ID from \$10 to \$5
- Allows Unaccompanied Minors(16&17) to get an ID without parental consent
 - Similar language to SB 21 from 21RS and Birth Certificate Language (KRS 213.141)
 - Must go through an entity that would verify homelessness
- Allows for a person to <u>renew</u> a Driver's License without a fixed address
 - Delayed Implementation date
 - Help people maintain employment and their life while they are temporarly Homeless
