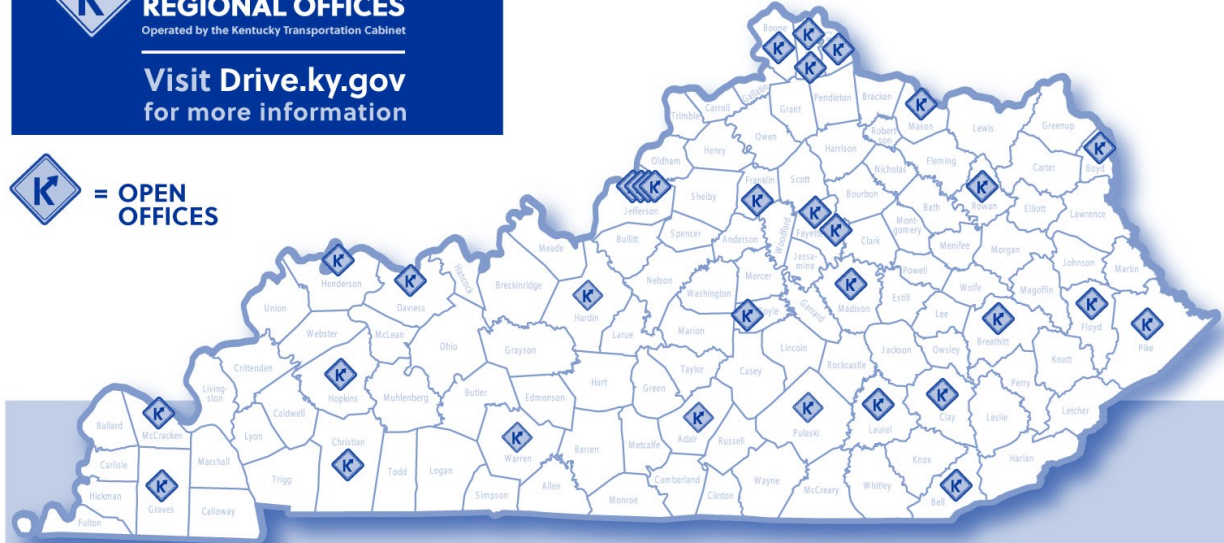

POPOP DRIVER LICENSING PORTABLE DRIVER LICENSING OFFICE

The annual Popup program is in its 9th month. It has held more than 160 local events in Kentucky's 94 Popup-eligible counties. With its local partners, the program will host a total of 220 events in 2022.

The Popup Driver Licensing Program helped Eastern Kentuckians in the aftermath of the July flooding.

- The mobile licensing program was immediately on the ground offering services in 11 locations — FEMA Disaster Recovery Centers and Kentucky State Resort Parks sheltering those displaced by the floods.
- The program's services span nearly 700 business hours over 23 days. More than 40 KYTC employees from regional offices across the state worked the Emergency Disaster Relief Popups.
- More than 3,300 Kentuckians were issued credentials at the Emergency Disaster Relief Popups.
