

KYTC INVESTMENTS:
FUNDING OF MAINTENANCE, PAVEMENT, BRIDGES



MAINTENANCE

KYTC is responsible for maintaining the state-owned transportation assets. Activities include upkeep such as mowing, tree and brush trimming, drainage maintenance, snow and ice control, and pavement patching among other duties.

PRIMARY FUNDING is through the Operations and Maintenance Budget (FE). A sub-set of the budget (FE02) is dedicated to bridge maintenance and bridge emergency repairs.

PAVEMENT

KYTC is responsible for the care and preservation of **28,000 CENTERLINE MILES AND 65,000 LANE MILES OF THE STATE TRANSPORTATION NETWORK.**

PRIMARY FUNDING is through the Six Year Plan (asset management projects), Pavement Preservation (FD05) and the Rural Secondary budget.



BRIDGES

KYTC is responsible for the care and preservation of **9,000 STATE-OWNED BRIDGES.**

PRIMARY FUNDING is through the Six Year Plan and FE02, which is a small portion of the Maintenance Budget (FE).

MAINTENANCE IMPACTS PAVEMENT AND BRIDGES

With routine maintenance, the lifespan of the pavement and bridges is extended and need and cost of asset management projects is reduced.
