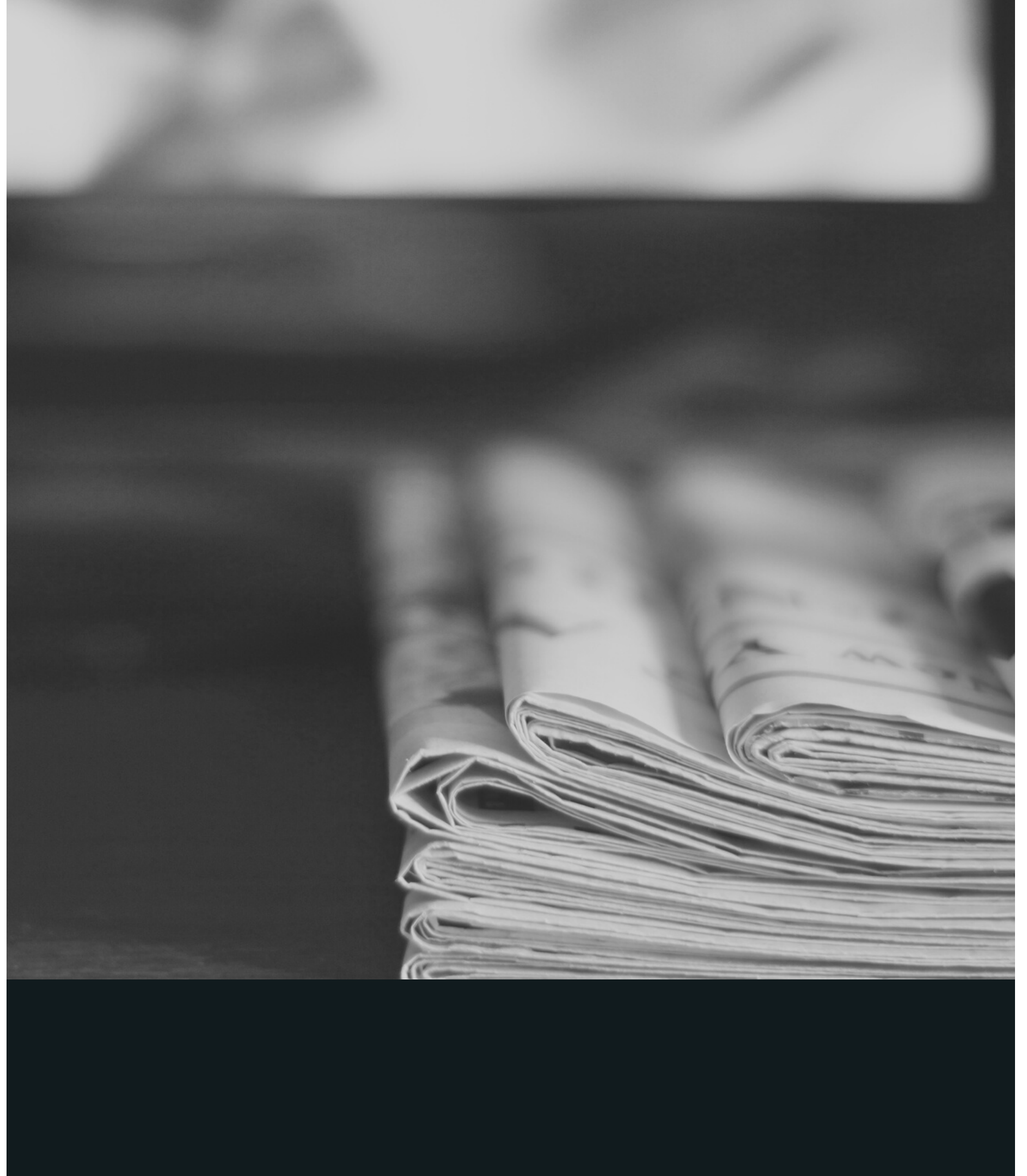
70,466 Overdose Deaths in US in 2019

and prescription drugs



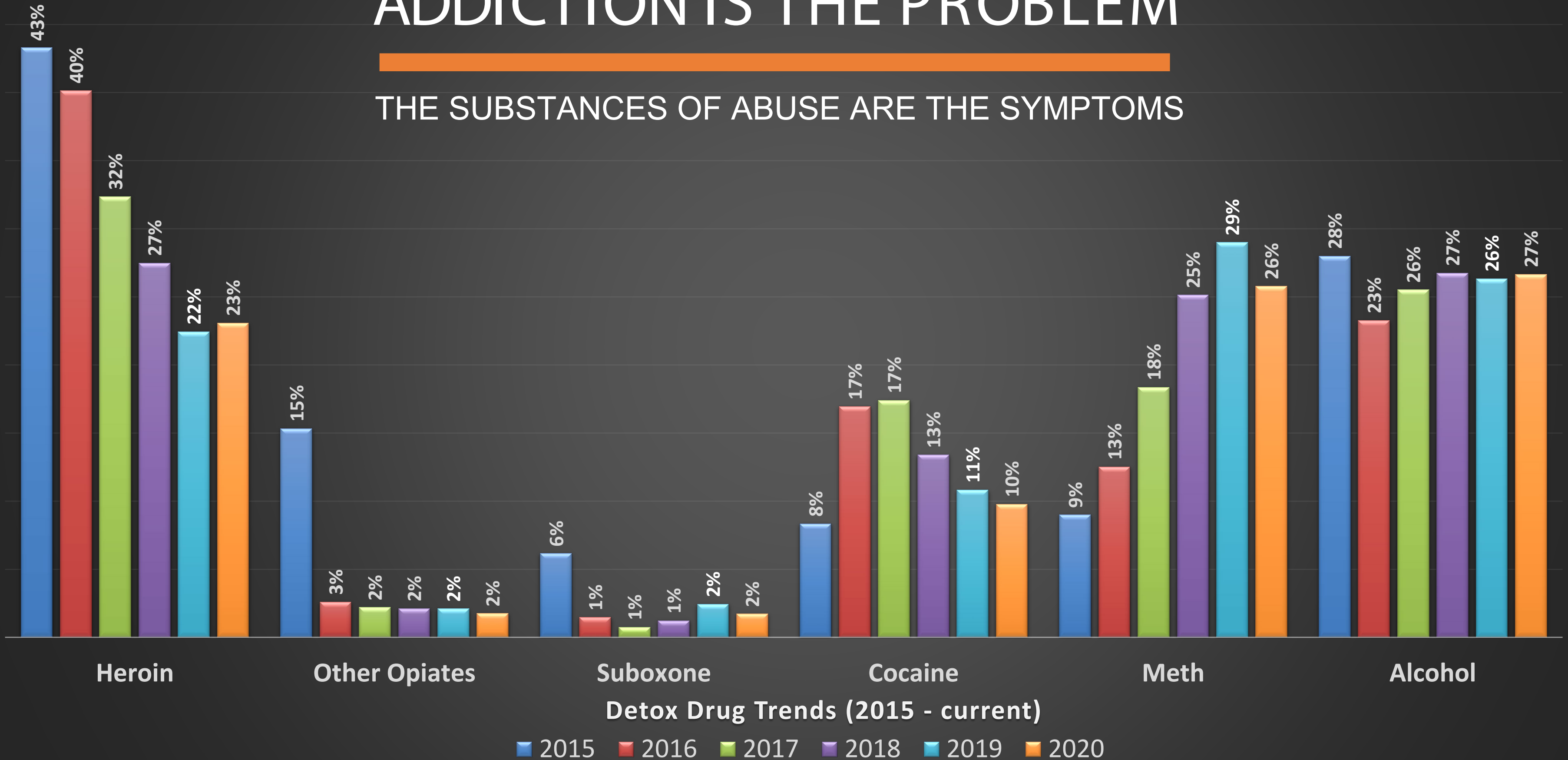

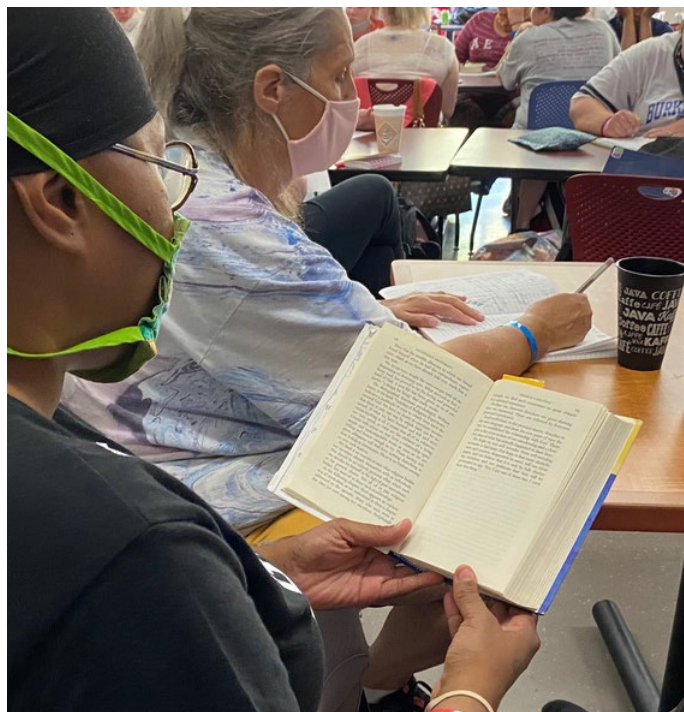

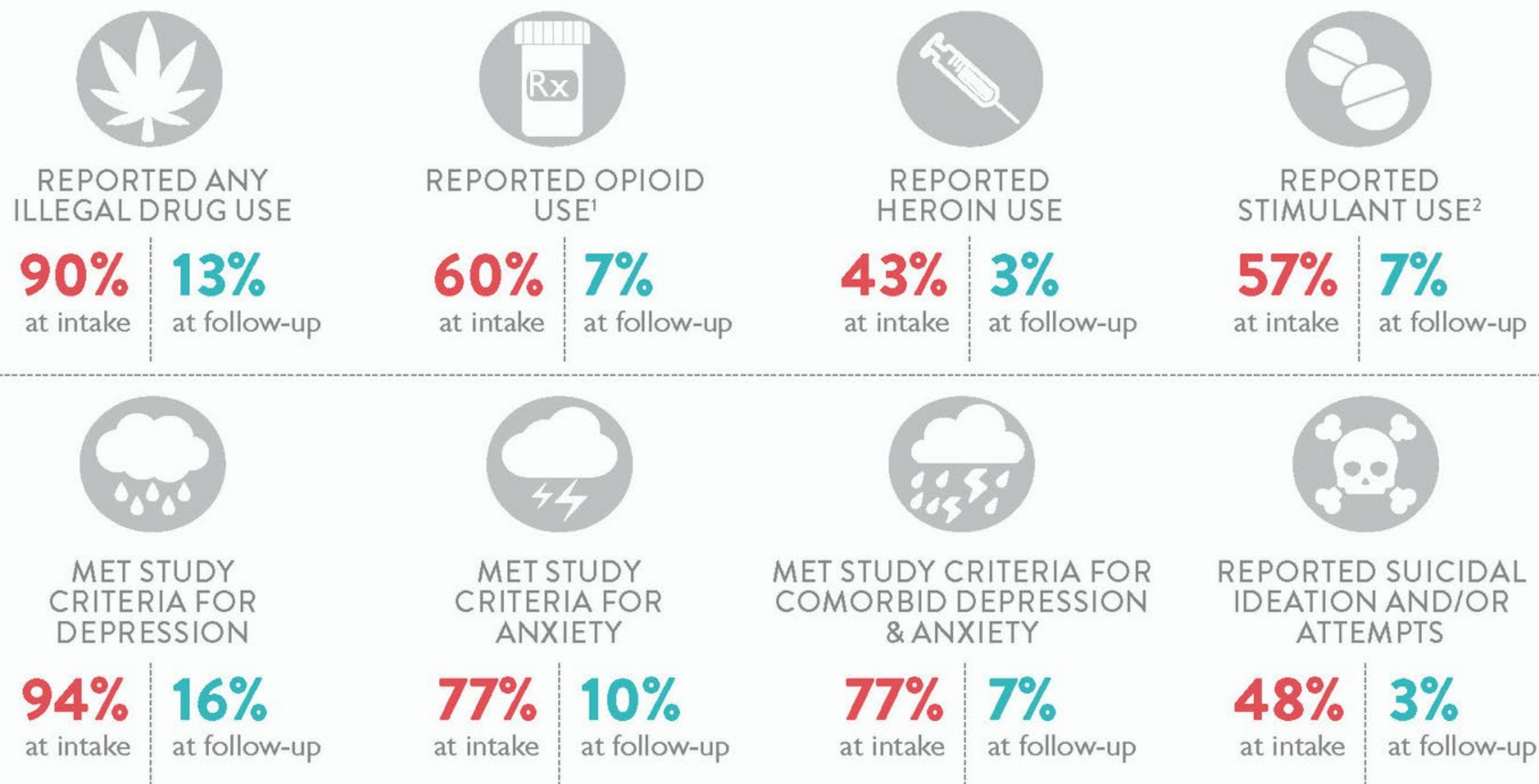

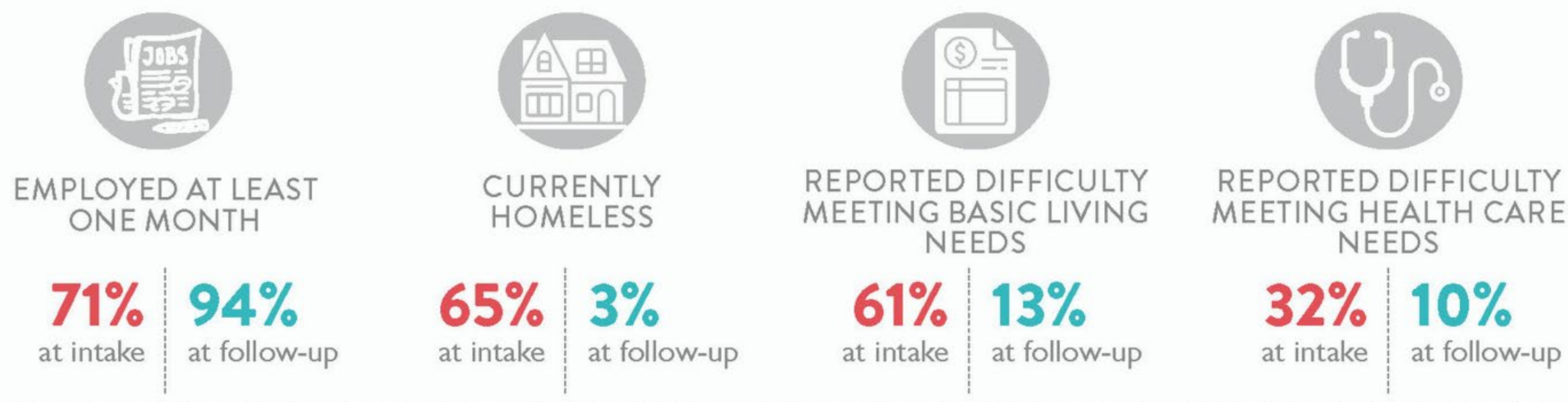
