Dear Ms. Cabbage:

We received your response on behalf of the Governor dated January 28, 2021. Perhaps the intent of our request for additional information was misread, misunderstood, or misinterpreted. The failure to produce the requested information has delayed the process for this Committee.

The response was essentially a repetitive denial of the allegations of impeachment and a defense based on interpretation of caselaw. That was and is not a response to what was essentially a request for production of documents. In normal proceedings, a motion to compel production of the information requested or a subpoena would be issued to direct compliance with the request. To be courteous, this Committee is resubmitting the request for the information previously requested.

Our request seeks communications concerning any executive order related to or covering in-person church worship and interstate travel restrictions regarding implementing, enforcing, or giving guidance related to these executive orders, including, but not limited to **emails, letters, phone logs, fax logs, messages, or recordings**. This request seeks documents or communications from March 1, 2020, until May 31, 2020.

The following is, again, requested:

1. Any communications by any means, including, but not limited to telephone communication, electronic communication, digital communication, written communications, facsimile communications, by and between the Governor or his designee and entities involved with the religious organizations, including, but not limited to, any Cabinet member, member of the Governor's executive staff, the KSP Commissioner, or


any other sworn or unsworn employee of the KSP, any peace officer, any employee of the State or a local health department, and any local official either elected or appointed.

2. Any communications by any means, including, but not limited to telephone communication, electronic communication, digital communication, written communications, facsimile communications, by and between the Governor or his designee and entities involved with the proposed travel ban, including, but not limited to, any Cabinet member, member of the Governor's executive staff, the KSP Commissioner, or any other sworn or unsworn employee of the KSP, any peace officer, any employee of the State or a local health department, any employee of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, any local official either elected or appointed, any uniformed or civilian employee of the National Guard, any local or state official from a state bordering Kentucky, and any officer or employee of the Federal government.

Whether the allegations in the Petition rise to the level of impeachment is within the province of this Committee. While your defenses have been received and will certainly be considered, the determination of appropriate action or no action will be made after the Committee has examined the materials presented and requested. This Committee does not seek another document that denies the allegations and directs the Committee on what it can or cannot do.

In the prior submission we did not receive any emails, letters, phone logs, fax logs, or recordings. This is not acceptable. If necessary, these records may be subpoenaed. ***To swiftly address the Petition for Impeachment we request the information on or before 6:00 p.m. on Monday, February 8, 2021.***
