

Petition to add one or more new articles of impeachment to be voted on by the House
Impeachment Committee

I hereby petition the Impeachment Committee and the Kentucky House of Representatives to add one or more articles of impeachment against Governor Andy Beshear on the grounds that he was an active member of a conspiracy to illegally rig the following Democratic Party primaries, all five of which were contested primaries:

- 2015: The Democratic primary for Governor in favor of Jack Conway;
- 2015: The Democratic primary for Secretary of State in favor of Alison Lundergan Grimes;
- 2018: The Democratic primary for the U.S. House of Representatives in the 6th Congressional District against me;
- 2019: The Democratic primary for Governor against me;
- 2020: The Democratic primary for the U.S. Senate in favor of Amy McGrath and against Representative Charles Booker.

In all five of these Democratic primaries, Andy Beshear conspired with the leadership of the Kentucky Democratic Party (the KDP) and other powerful and wealthy Democrats both inside and outside of Kentucky to violate KRS 118.105 (1). Rigging one or more primary elections and chronically violating KRS 118.105 (1) are impeachable offenses.

During the entire time when Andy Beshear was Kentucky's Attorney General, he failed and refused to do anything at all to stop chronic primary-election-rigging by the KDP, and that refusal constituted an impeachable offense and a violation of his oath of office as Attorney General. In fact, Attorney General Andy Beshear filed numerous bad-faith and legally meritless pleadings designed to prevent several civil actions I had filed against the KDP and certain Democratic candidates for election fraud in primaries from ever coming to trial or from ever being heard on their merits or decided on their merits in any court of law. Those bad-faith pleadings filed by Andy Beshear constituted obstruction of justice and constitute another impeachable offense.
