

CASE EXAMPLE

Narrative

This case involves traumatic asphyxia (*play pen wedging*) resulting in the death of a fivemonth-old infant.

Risk Factors

- Criminal History
- DCBS History
- Environmental Neglect
- Family violence
- Financial issues
- Housing Instability
- Lack of childcare
- MAT
- Medical Management Issues

- Medically Fragile Child
- Mental Health Issues –
 Caregiver
- Overwhelmed Caregiver
- Substance abuse (in home)
- Supervisional neglect
- Unsafe Sleep





CASE EXAMPLE

Narrative

This case involves the suicide of a ten-year-old child.

Risk Factors

- Coroner Issues
- Environmental Issues
- Financial Issues
- Law Enforcement Issues

Missed Opportunities

This case is noteworthy for what is absent – while the coroner and law enforcement may have made the accurate determination for cause of death, the investigation lacked any significant information regarding psychosocial background for the family.

PARTNERSHIPS

The Panel recently partnered with the Kentucky Safety Prevention Alignment Network (KSPAN) and developed the Child Home Safety Committee.
