Enrollment Growth



2005

Began with 3 Middle School boys in a house on Chestnut Street.

2005-2012

WES's enrollment steadily grew, with each Middle School grade averaging 5 students.



2013-2017

WES expanded by adding a new elementary class annually.

Fall of 2024

WES increased enrollment to ~140 students.



August 2025

WES will open its doors to girls in Pre-K through 2nd grade, with plans to gradually add a new class each year through 8th grade.

Fall of 2012

WES began a new chapter when it opened an Elementary School with a Pre-K and Kindergarten Class.

2017-2018 (Academic year)

WES opened for Pre-K through 8th grade for boys.

Moved into dorm space at the current location of 3628 Virginia Ave.

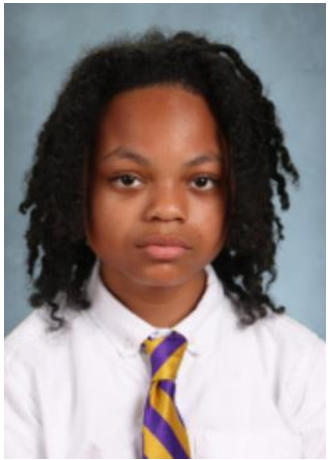

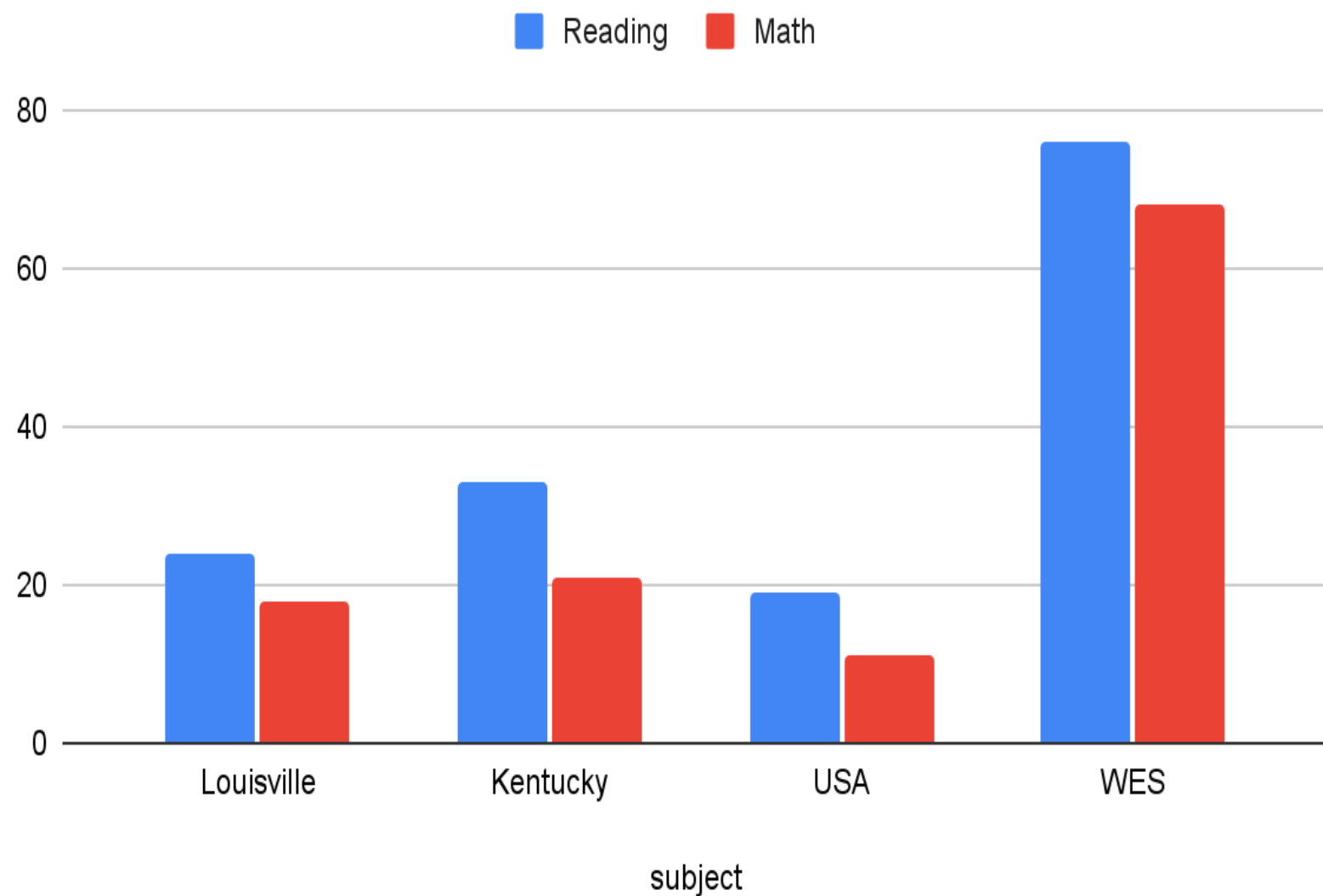
