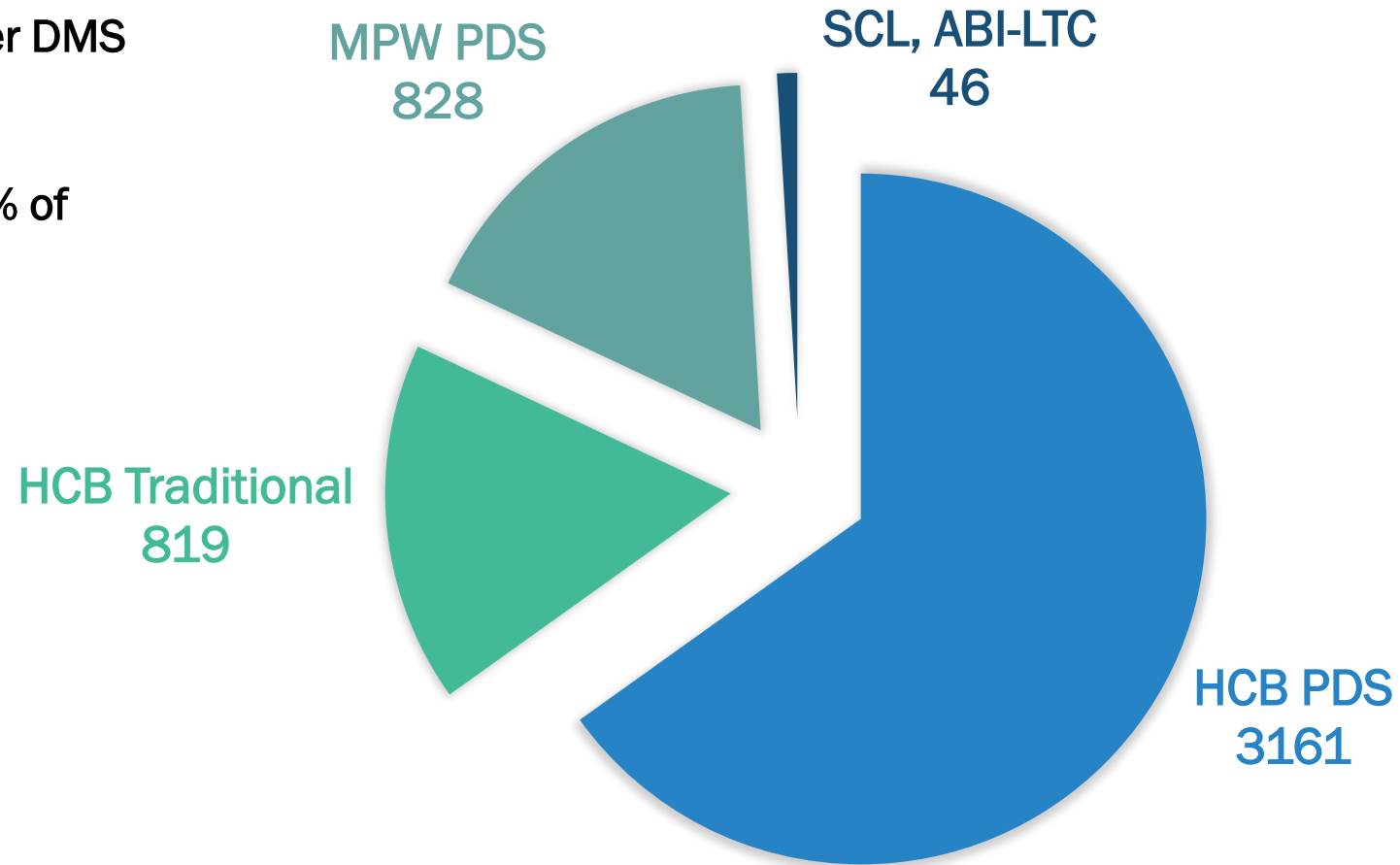

OLDER ADULT POPULATION GROWING AT AN ASTOUNDING RATE

- Today in Kentucky about 1 in 5 people is an adult over 65 years of age.
- 85+, is growing at a rate of 132% vs. 72%
- By 2040, 85+ will be 14.6 million: up from 6.3 million in 2015.
- 100+ population increase by 168% (2015 – 2040).
- From 72,000 to 193,000 centenarians.
