- 1 AN ACT relating to executive orders and declaring an emergency.
- 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 3 → SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 205 IS CREATED TO
- 4 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 5 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary and unless required under
- 6 federal law, the Department for Medicaid Services and any managed care organization
- 7 with whom the department contracts for the delivery of Medicaid services are hereby
- 8 prohibited from expending any Medicaid funds on any of the following:
- 9 (1) Cross-sex hormones in amounts greater than would normally be produced
- 10 <u>endogenously in a healthy person of the same age and sex; and</u>
- 11 (2) Gender reassignment surgery to alter or remove physical or anatomical
- characteristics or features that are typical for and characteristic of a person's
- 13 <u>biological sex.</u>
- → Section 2. Notwithstanding any law, administrative regulation, executive order,
- or directive to the contrary, Executive Order 2024-632 shall be of no force or effect as of
- 16 the effective date of this Act.
- → Section 3. Notwithstanding any law, administrative regulation, executive order,
- or directive to the contrary, any administrative regulation, executive order, or directive
- 19 that is identical to or substantially the same as Executive Order 2024-632 shall be of no
- force or effect as of the effective date of this Act through January 1, 2028.
- 21 → Section 4. Whereas the General Assembly seeks to protect the rights of all
- 22 Kentuckians, an emergency is declared to exist, and Sections 2 and 3 of this Act take
- 23 effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a
- 24 law.
