- 100%
 - Are unable to be safe in a home environment
 - Have a confirmed history of physical and verbal abuse
 - Have a history of hospitalizations and placement disruptions
- 40%+ have suspected or confirmed history of human trafficking/exploitation



- Contract with CHFS to support youth with complex needs
- Low-census, high-acuity program for youth requiring specialized care, programming, and single-room occupancy
- Enhanced staffing ratios and oversight
