# Nurturing Children Program

From July 1, 2022 to July 13, 2023 we had 56 graduates. Of those graduates, 88% increased their level of empathy. 82% of graduates decreased their belief in corporal punishment.

89% of parents who have completed this program have not recommitted acts of child abuse and/or neglect.

# Thanks to grant funding and partnerships with Laurel County Health Department and Cribs for Kids we have....

 Provided Safe Sleep Education and tools to more than 200 families.

# Thanks to grant funding and partnerships with Cumberland Valley Area Development we have....

 Provided over 30 car seats to individuals in need and provided Car Seat Safety Check Events and education to the community.



According to Kentucky's 2022 **Child Fatality and Near Fatality External Review** Panel, there has been a 350% increase in overdose and /or ingestion cases. Of the 63 cases reviewed, 83% of them occurred in children 6 years of age or younger.

We have distributed over 40 medication lock boxes to decrease the risk of overdose / ingestion in children.





#### **Evaluation Results**

After receiving the Eddie Eagle GunSafe Program, student were evaluated and asked these 3 questions:

Do you know what to do if you see a gun?

Should you ever pick up a gun?

Should you tell a grown up if you see a

gun?





# Results

96% of students evaluated stated they now know what to do if they ever see a gun!

#### Safe Haven Baby Box

A Safe Haven Baby Box was placed at Corbin City Fire Department in Corbin, Kentucky. This is the first box in Southeastern KY. This made the 17th box in Kentucky.

115 babies were saved by Safe Haven laws in 2021 in the US.

- What if it were someone I loved?
- What if there were a bystander that could help the person I loved, but they chose to walk away?
