- The only agency to provide comprehensive case management to all survivors of trafficking and the only service provider for labor trafficking survivors




## **Core Principles in Service Provision**

- Non-discriminatory access to services












### Levels of Prevention

**Primary**- Occurs before victimization

**Secondary-** Crisis intervention while victimization is occurring

**Tertiary**- Longer term intervention after victimization occurred
