This pathway is targeted for individuals preparing for careers related to early childhood education, such as those associated with child care, teaching, community-based children's programs, social services or counseling for children, and after-school programs. **101 students are enrolled in this pathway**.

Opening Little Purples Academy

- BGISD received \$8.3 Million for the new center as part of the *Better Kentucky Plan*, funded by the 2022 General Assembly.
- BGISD will partner with Bowling Green / Warren County Community Education to open a
 daycare center for up to 66 children ages 6 weeks to four years old.
- Received \$100,000 Community Partnership Grant from the Department of Community Based Services to start a new daycare.
- High School students in the BGHS Early Childhood Career Pathway will have the opportunity to jobshadow and assist with daily operations of the center as part of their learning.
- Priority admission for enrollment in the daycare center will be for children of BGISD employees.
