## Key Facts of Isaiah 117

- Isaiah 117 House is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit focused on helping children awaiting foster care placement.
- The organization started in Tennessee (first house opened in 2018) and has expanded to multiple states
- They supply essentials that children often lack when entering foster care: clothes, toys, personal hygiene items, food, etc. Also support foster families (e.g. car seats, backpacks) to ease transitions.

way before then.










Holy Graffiti: A special event where community members came in to write scriptures, prayers and encouragement on the walls and framework of the house














## The Giving Room
