Alzheimer's Diagnosis

• 2020: 75,000

• 2025: 86,000

Increase of 14.7%



Caregivers

• 2022: 157,000

• 302 million hours of unpaid care

• 4.8 million \$ value



Caregiver Health

- 65% have at least ONE chronic health condition
- 39% have depression
- 21% have poor physical health




Home Health & Personal Care Aides

 - o 35% growth rate


