A place where medicine, compassion and community come together — a hospital when you need it and a village of hope when you need more.



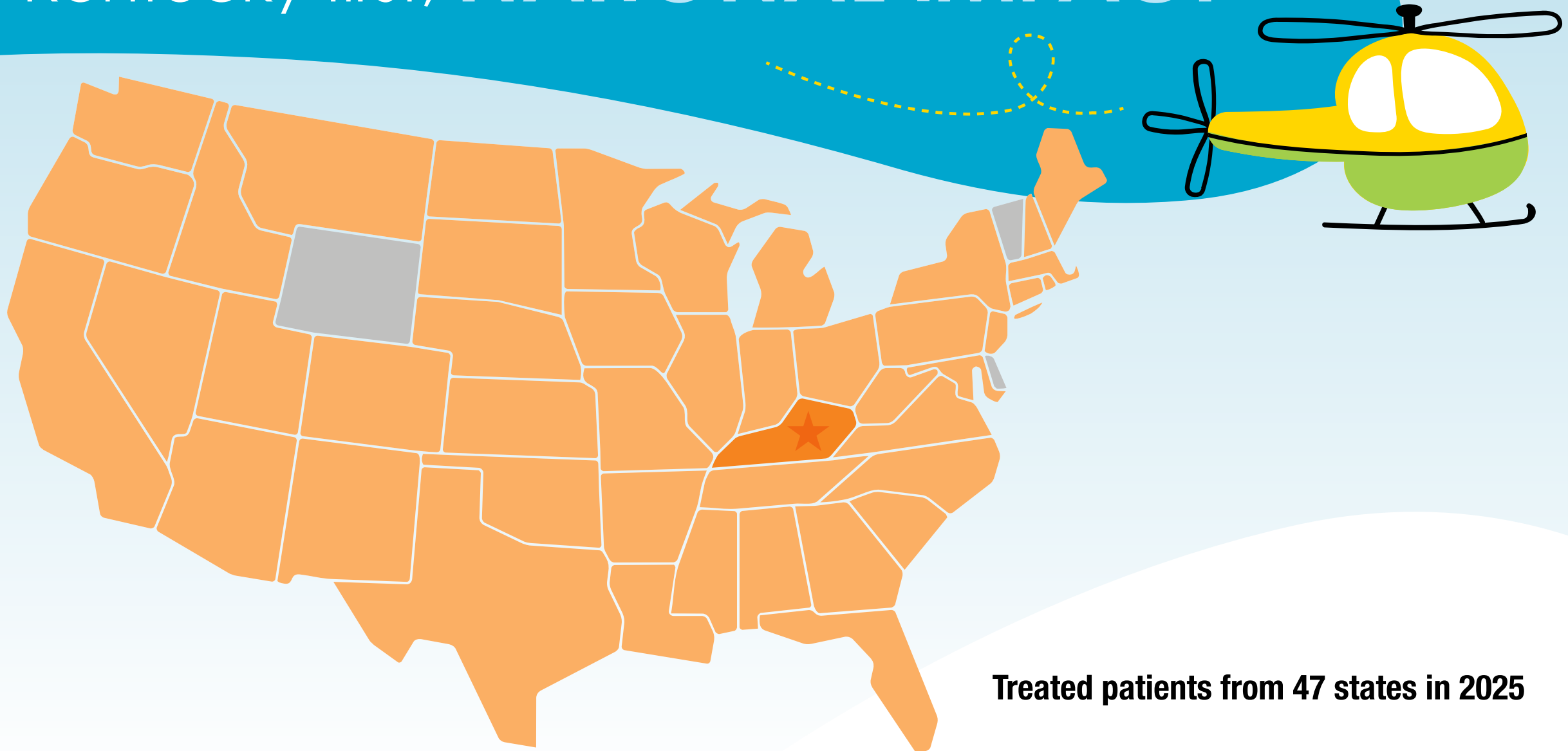
Serving Kentucky **AND BEYOND**

For more than 130 years, Norton Children's has provided compassionate, comprehensive care to kids, families and communities.

- More than 250,000 patients and 1.2 million visits in 2025
 - > 64% received Medicaid
- 90,000 patients from outside Jefferson Co.
- Level I Pediatric Trauma Center/Level IV NICU
- Partner with 100+ community hospitals throughout the state and region

Kentucky first, **NATIONAL IMPACT**



The need is **GROWING**

- Kentucky ranks 31st in kids' health
- Nearly 33% of Kentucky children and teens are overweight/obese
- Higher prevalence of children with Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes
- Nearly 1 in 10 Kentucky babies is born with low birth weight
- More than one-third of Kentuckians treated for mental health are under age 18 (nearly 38,000 youth)
- Increase in eating disorders and autism

June 11, 2025, Norton Children's announced plans to build Kentucky's second free-standing children's hospital and a pediatric care village

- 152 acres in Jeffersontown
- Launched 18-month regional listening tour
- Developed statewide/national survey
