



Supplementary Material for KYSTATS presentation to Effective and Efficient School District Governance Task Force

KYSTATS aims to provide longitudinal context for students in Jefferson County Public Schools (JCPS) and those Kentucky public K-12 students not in JCPS (Balance of the state). The supplementary material is intended to provide multiple demographic breakouts for a deeper dive while giving highlights during the presentation to the taskforce. Demographic breakouts include race, gender, free or reduced-price lunch status, special education, English language learner, and urbanicity. When redaction must occur due to small counts, racial categories are combined. In instances where counts are smaller than 10 or may reveal counts lower than 10 in any demographic category, statistics must be redacted to avoid disclosure. Racial-ethnic categories are broken out as much as possible while avoiding disclosure. Other race is inclusive of those identified as American Indian, Hawaiian, Other Race, and Two or more races. Values may differ slightly from KDE.

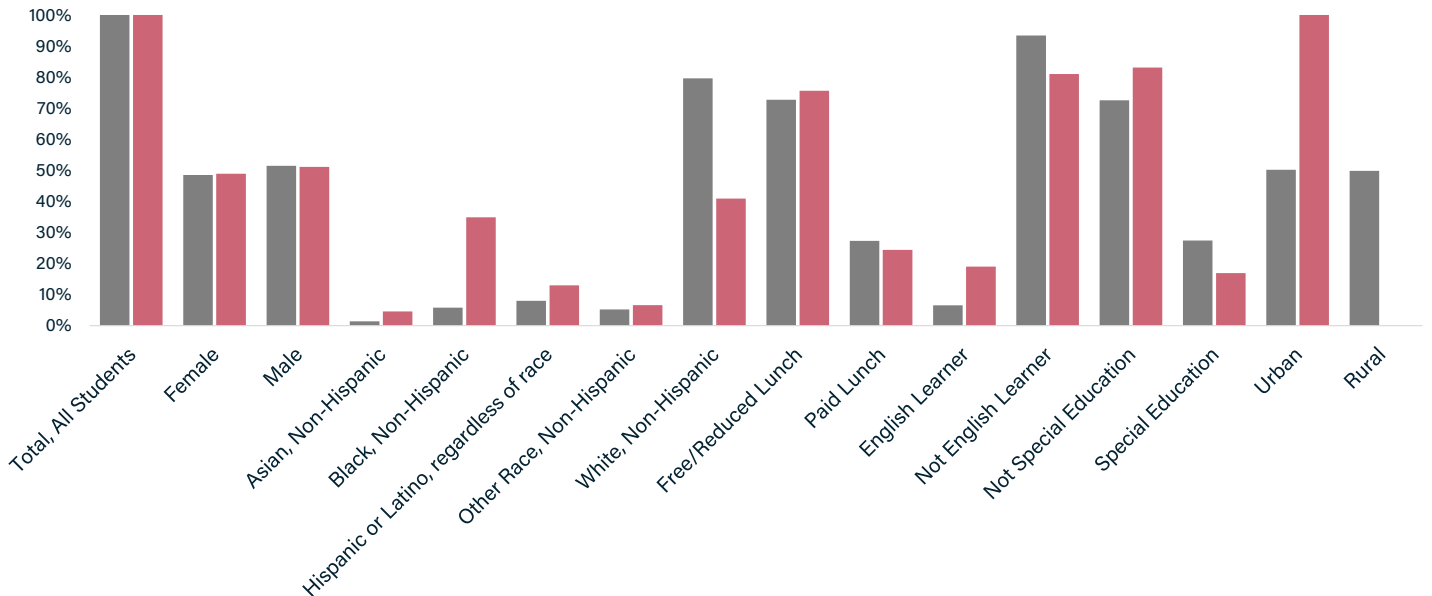
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Early Childhood

Beginning with 2019-20 first-time kindergarten students, we look back to public preschool attendance and forward to third grade proficiency on statewide tests.

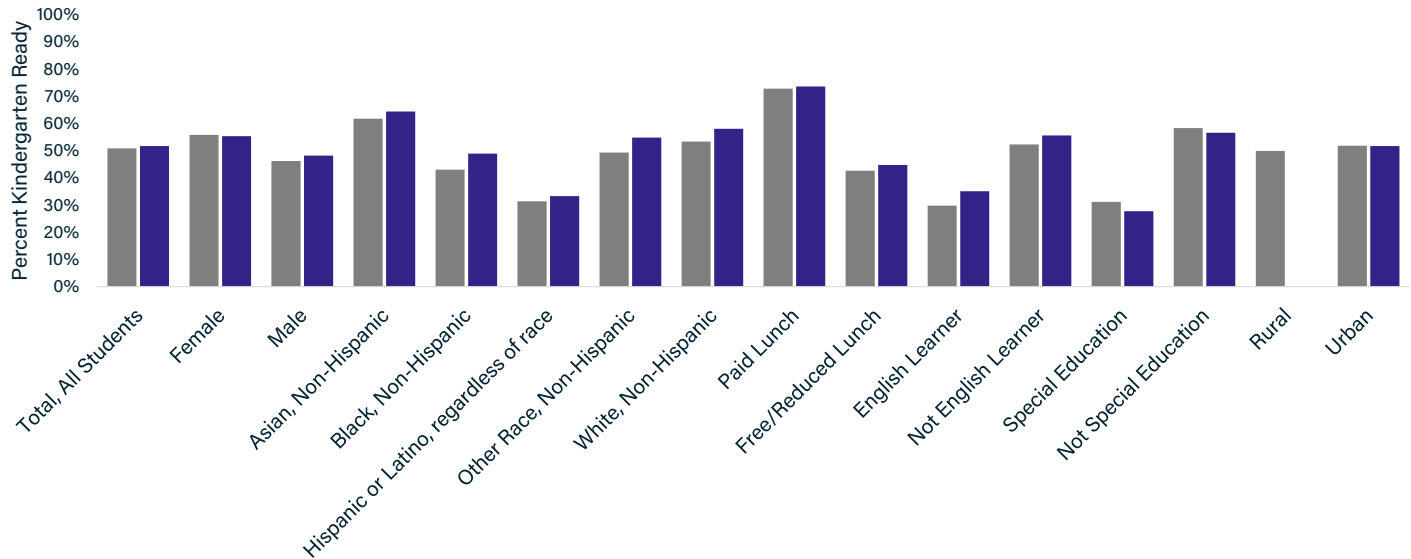

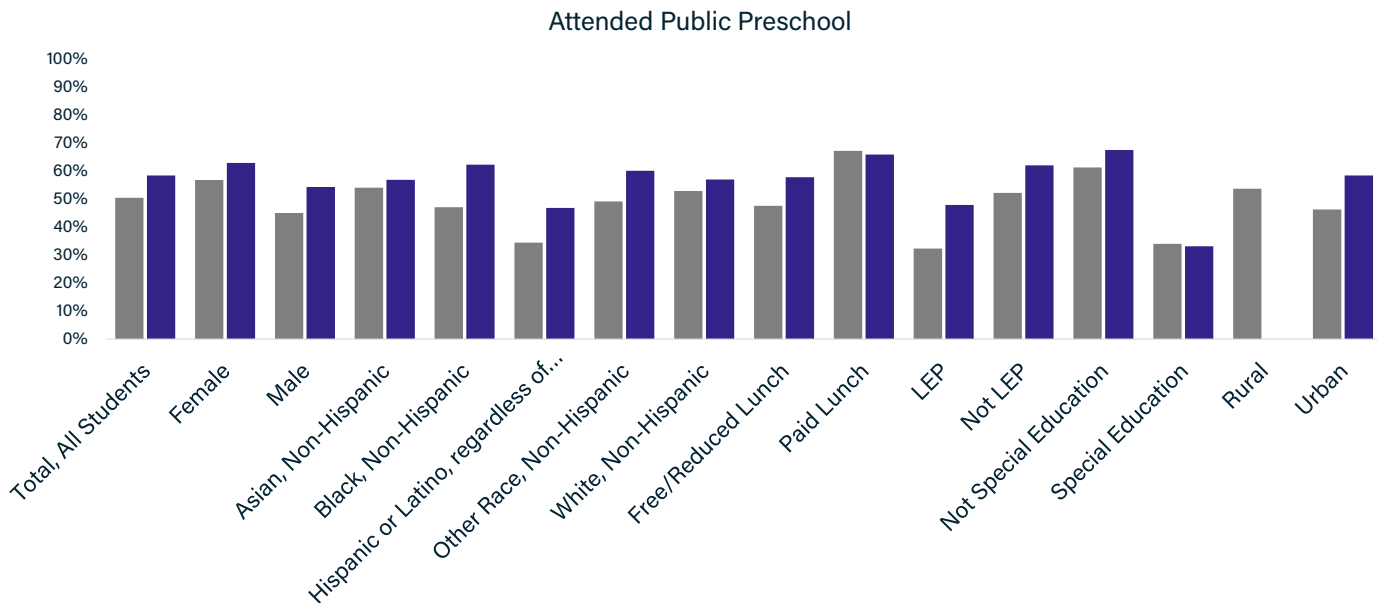
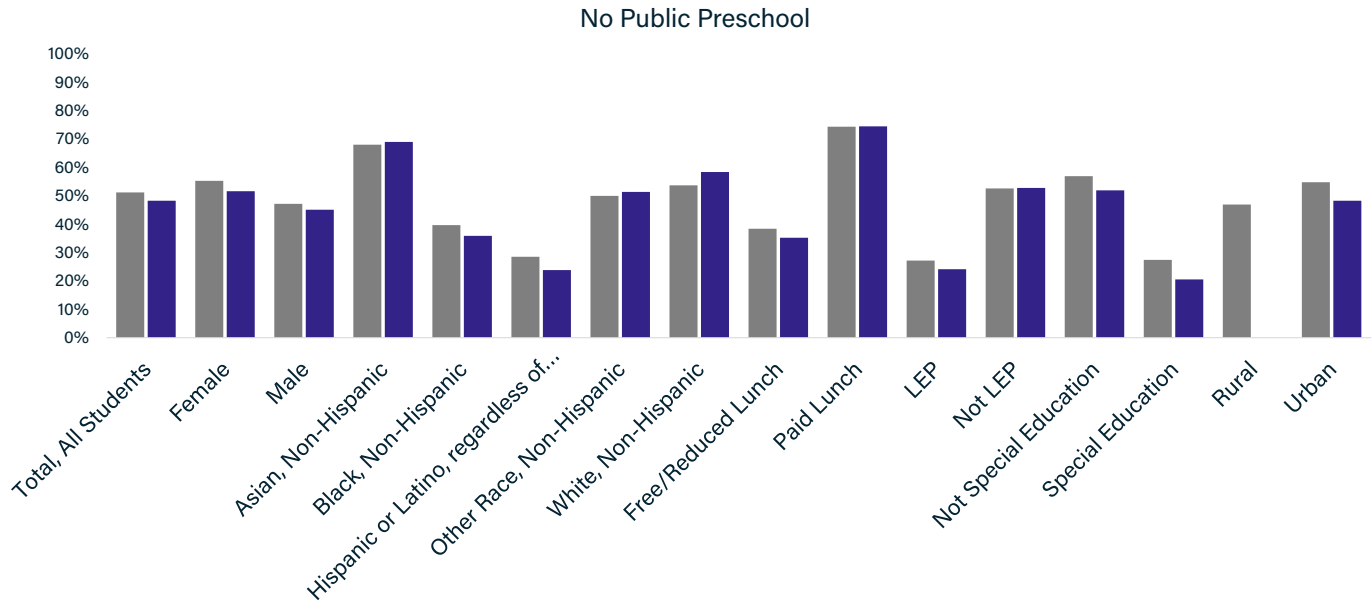

Kindergarteners are assessed as Ready, Ready with Enrichments, and Ready with Interventions. "Kindergarten Ready" is defined as being Ready or Ready with Enrichments.

Fall 2019 Kindergarten Readiness Rates For 2018-19 Public Preschool Attendance

Students labeled as "Attended Preschool" were in JCPS both for preschool and kindergarten OR attended both preschool and kindergarten outside of JCPS. Those who "Did Not Attend Preschool" did not attend preschool in the year prior to kindergarten. The remaining children were left out of these proportions, which removed only 0.2% of the students.

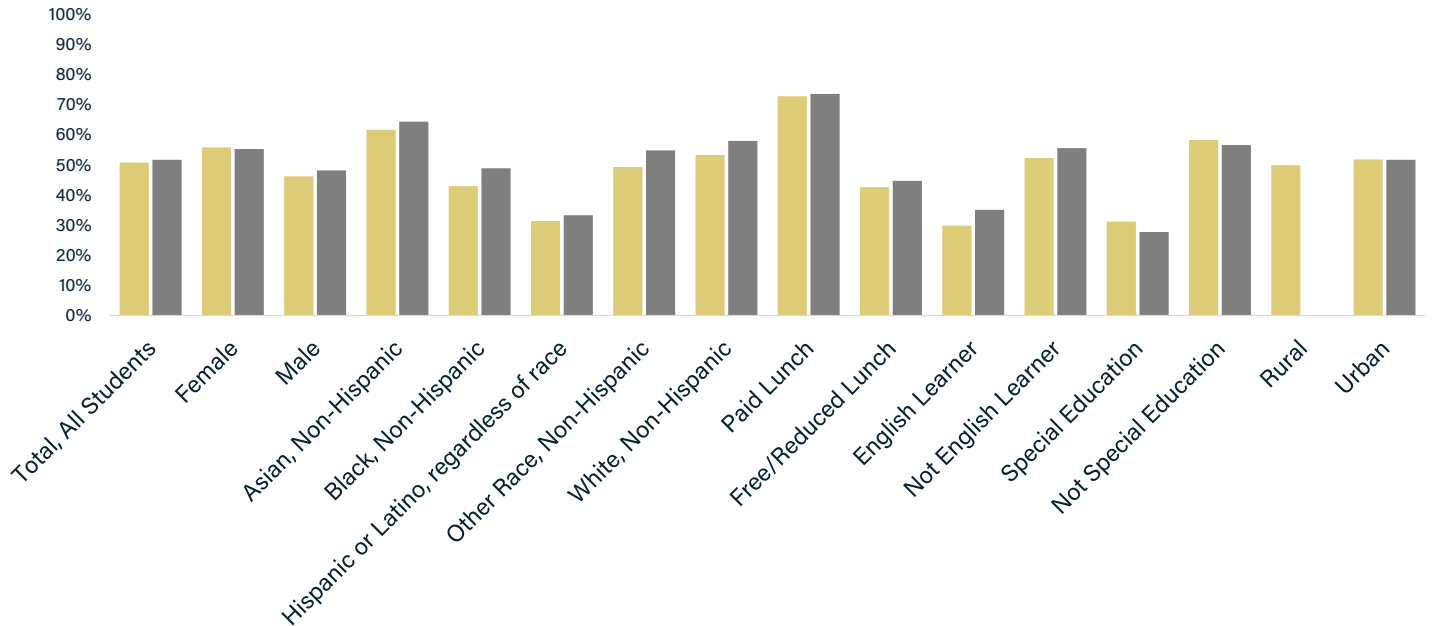

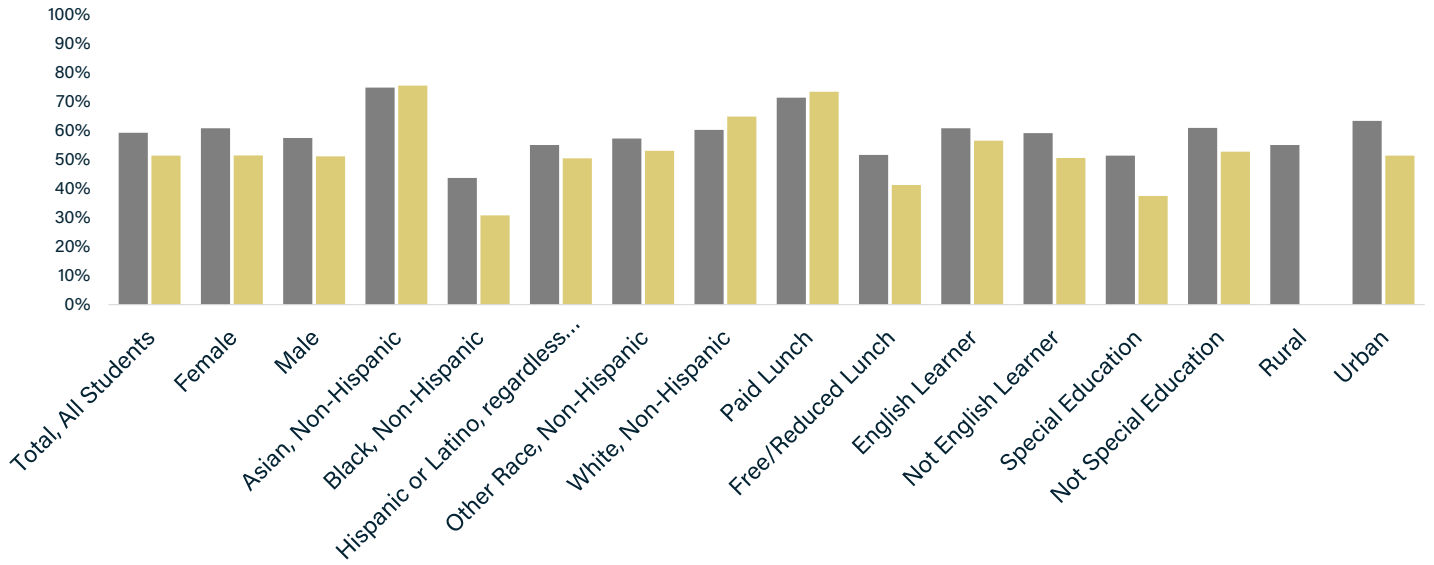

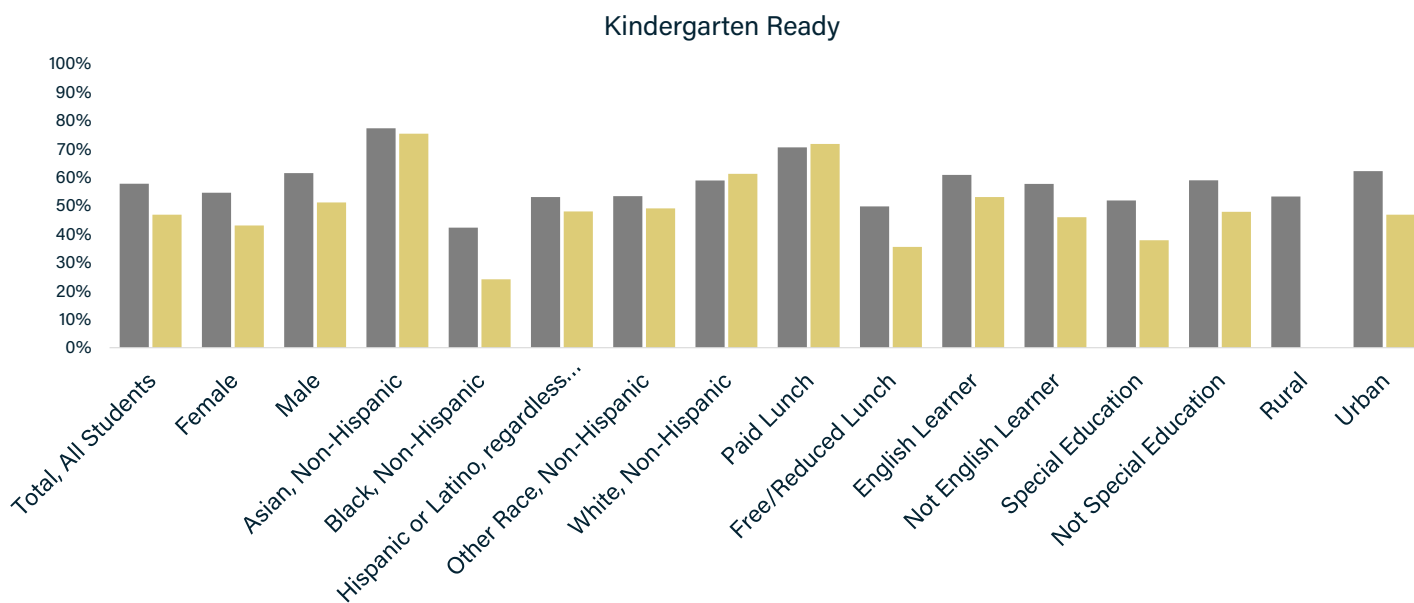

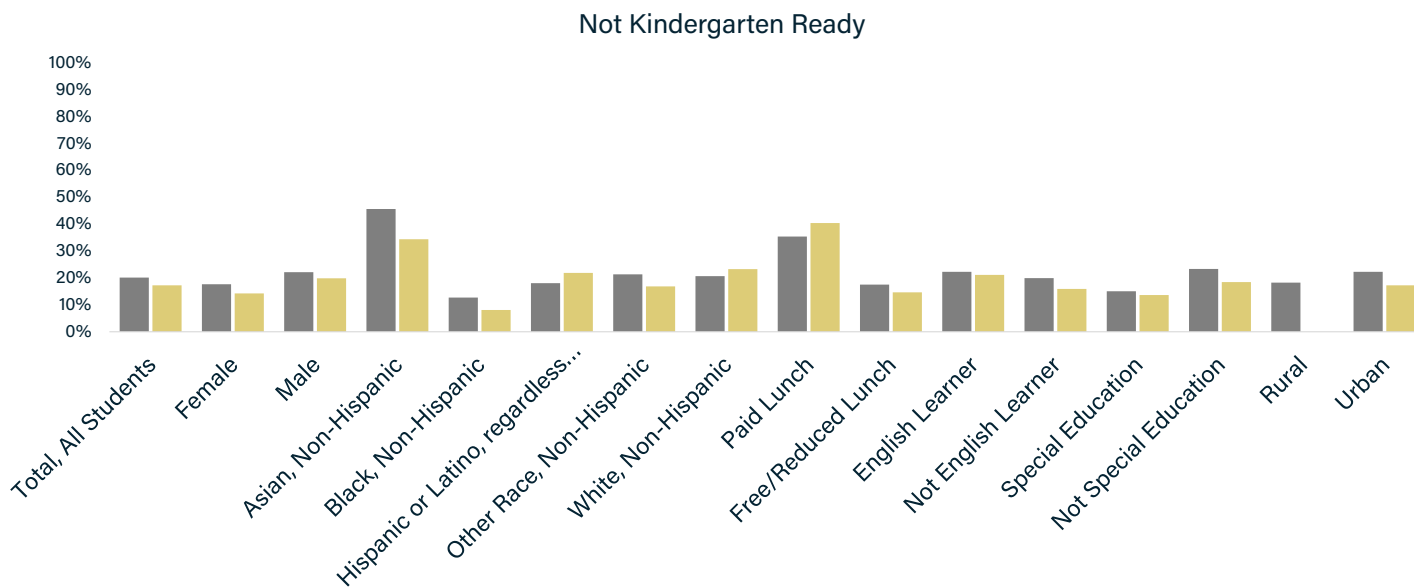

Math Proficiency for those that were NOT Kindergarten Ready

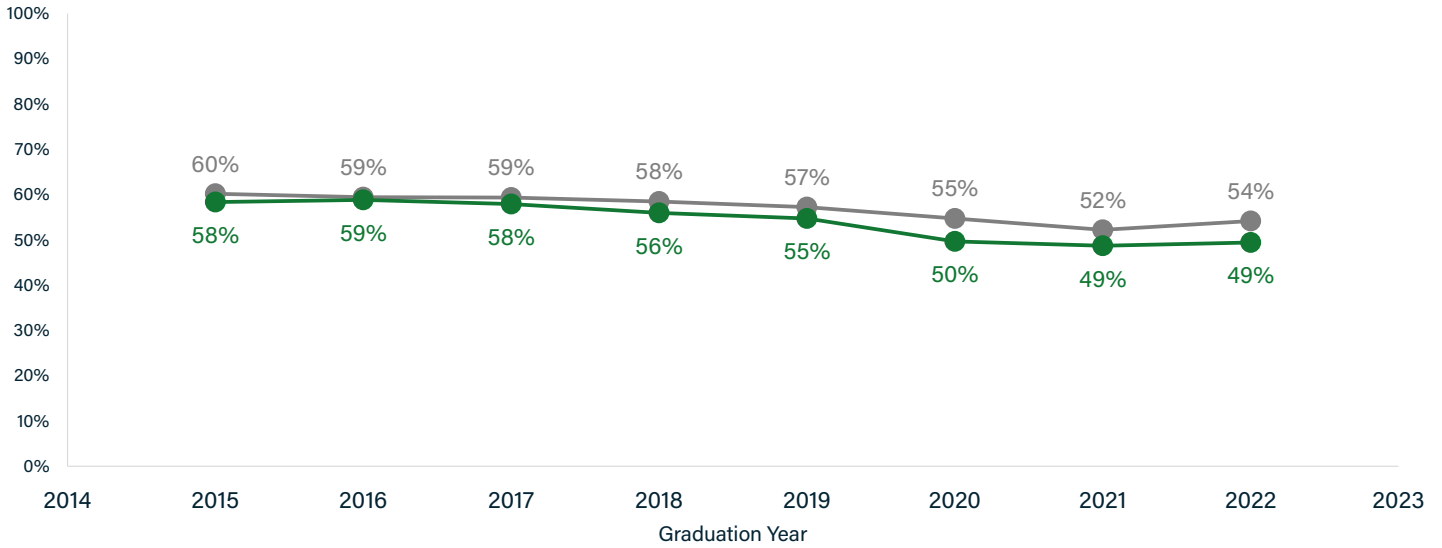

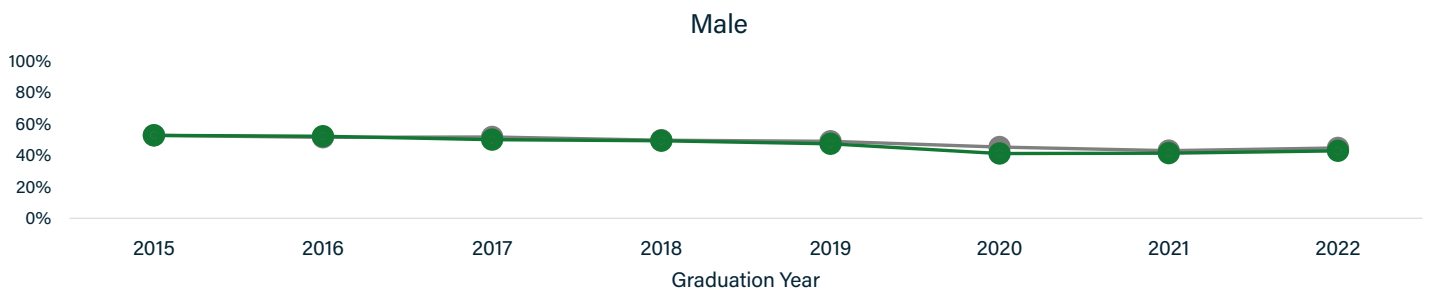
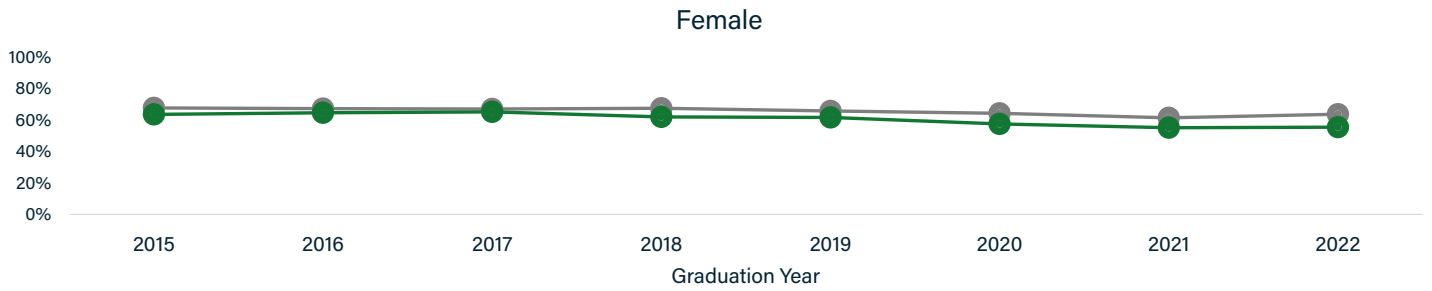
Transitions after Graduation - College-Going

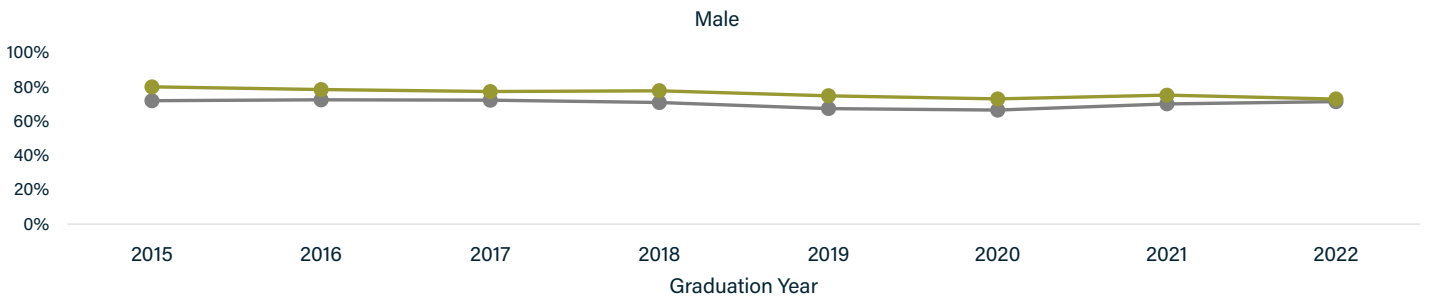
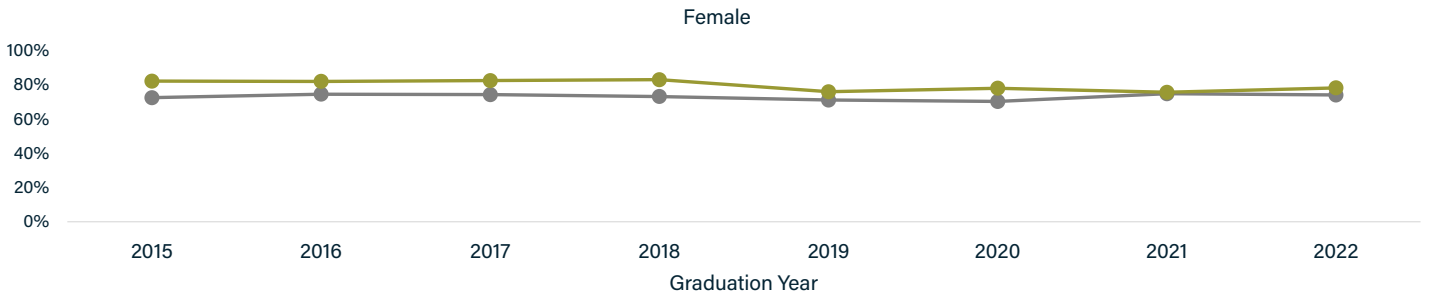
Transitions after Graduation - Employment in Kentucky

KYSTATS collects and links data to unemployment insurance wages in Kentucky which allows for employment metrics after high school graduation. Fulltime status and hours worked are not known, nor is tenure. Employment is measured by the federal fiscal year after high school graduation. Out of state wages and employment are unknown.

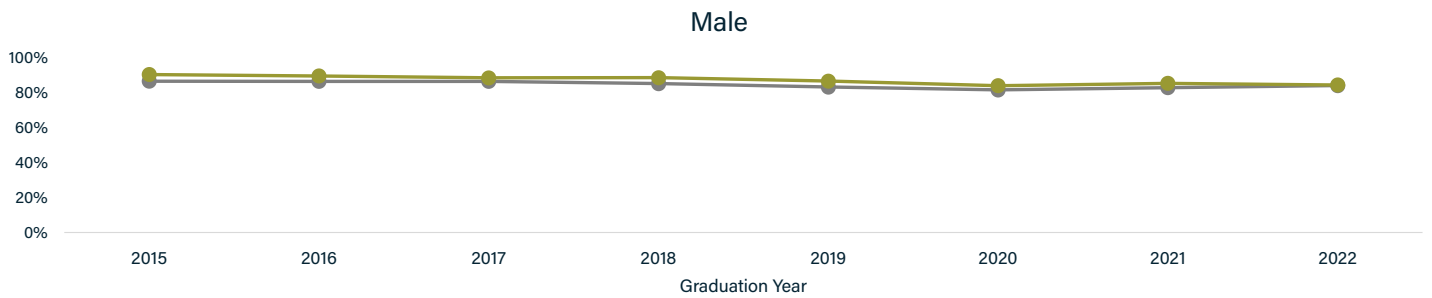
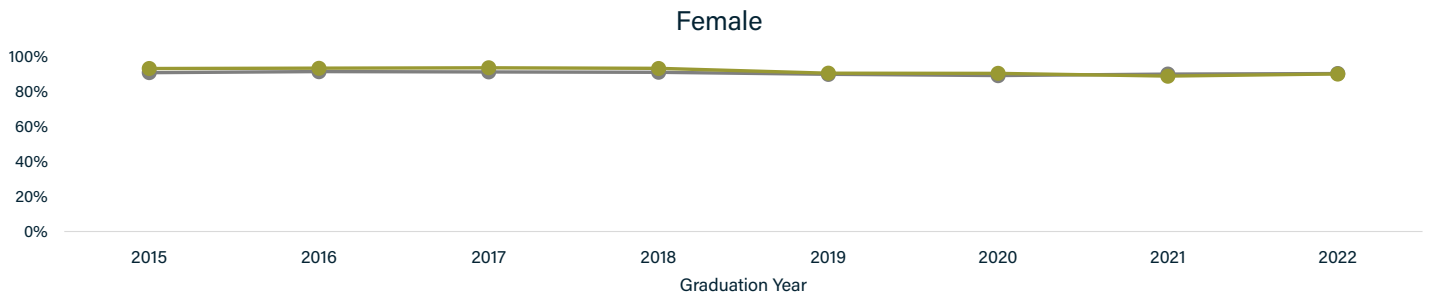
Transitions after Graduation - College Going or Employment

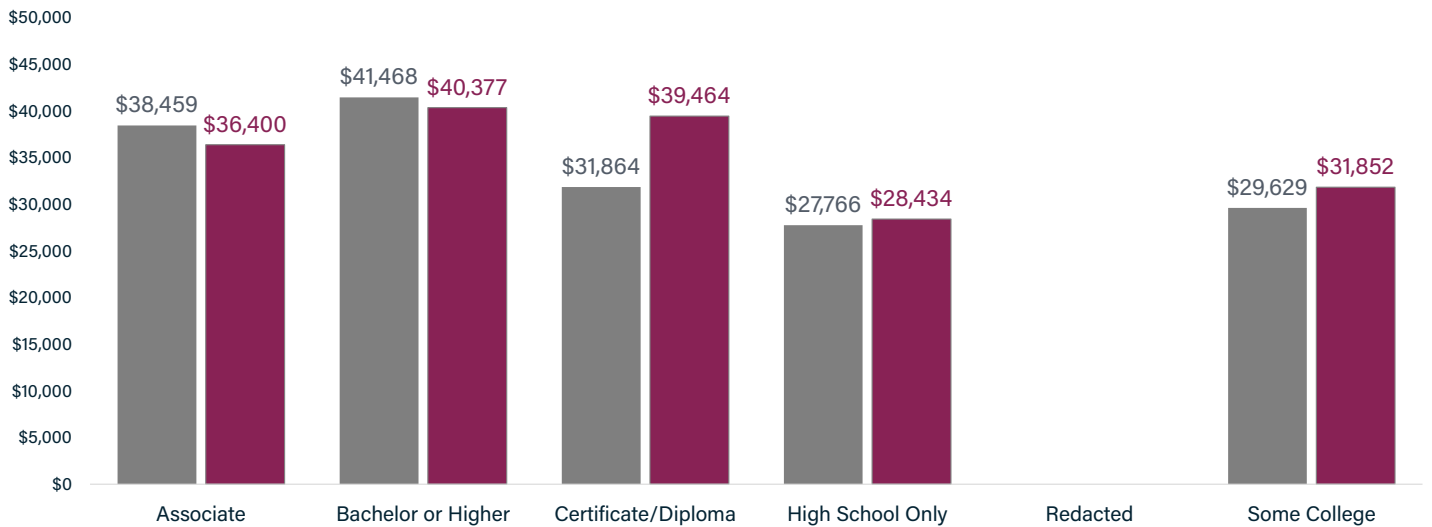
Life Outcomes
