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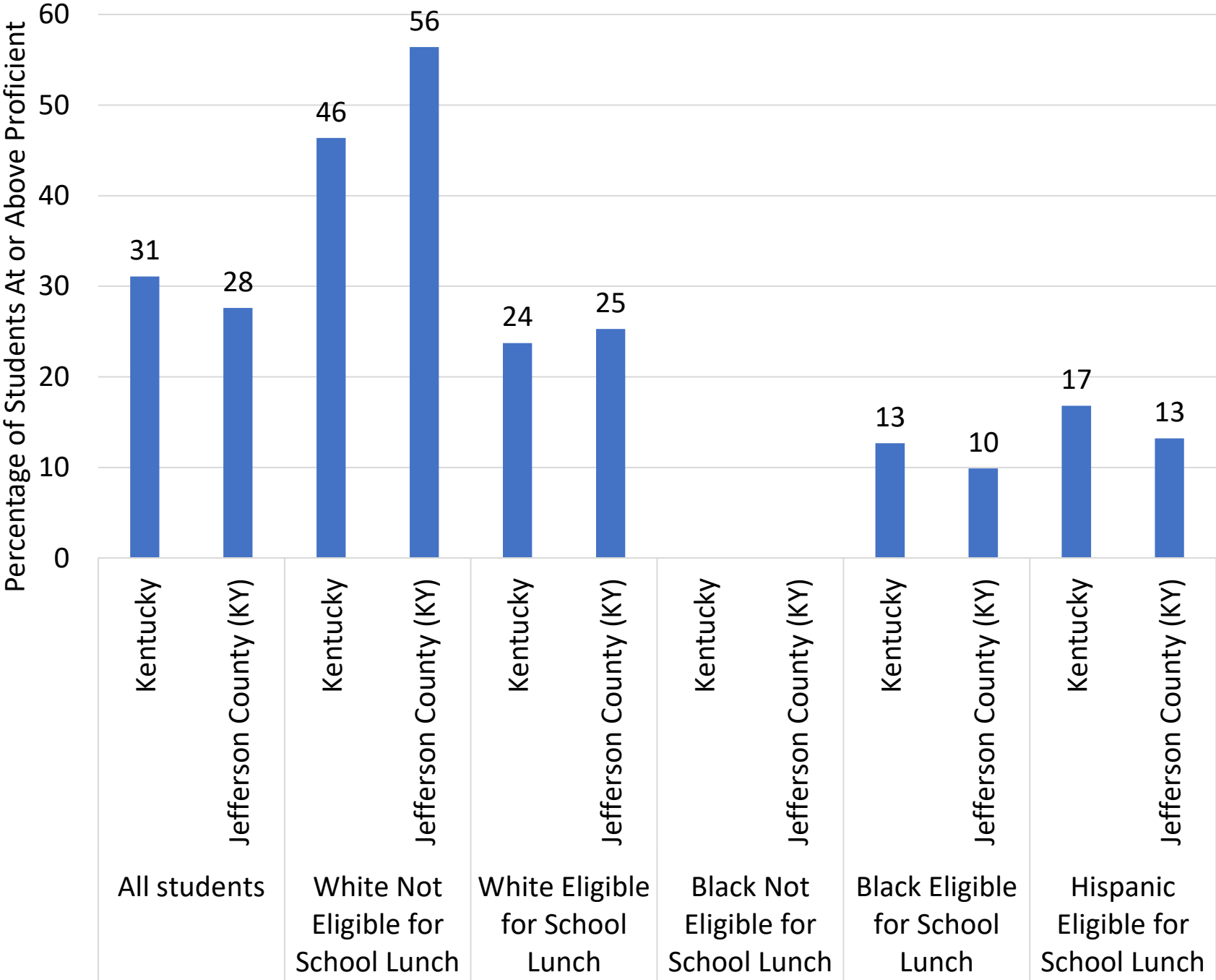

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Percentage of Students At or Above Proficient on the National Assessment of Educational Progress in **Fourth Grade Reading** by Comparable Student Groups, 2022

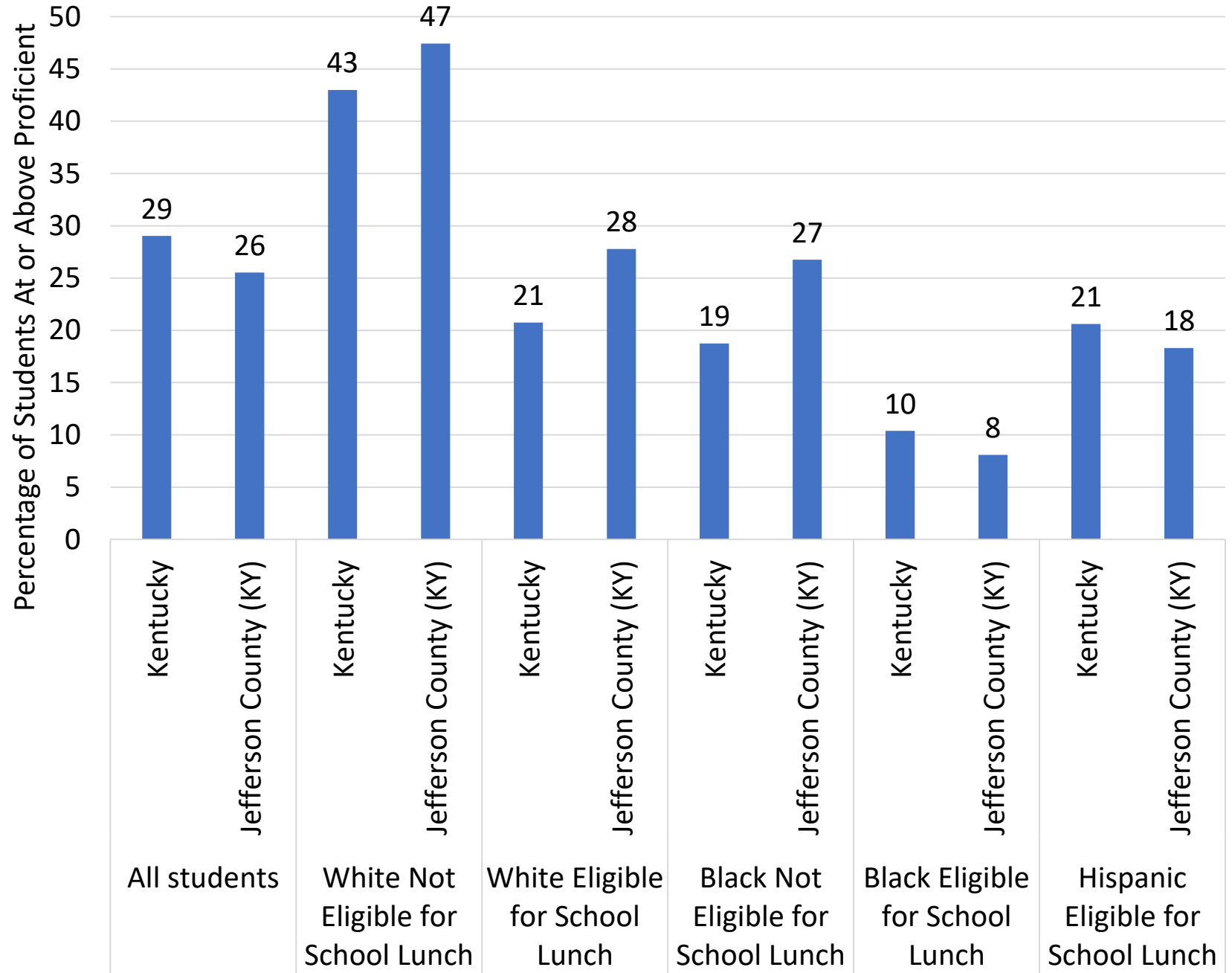

Percentage of Students At or Above Proficient on the National Assessment of Educational Progress in **Eighth Grade Reading** by Comparable Student Groups, 2022

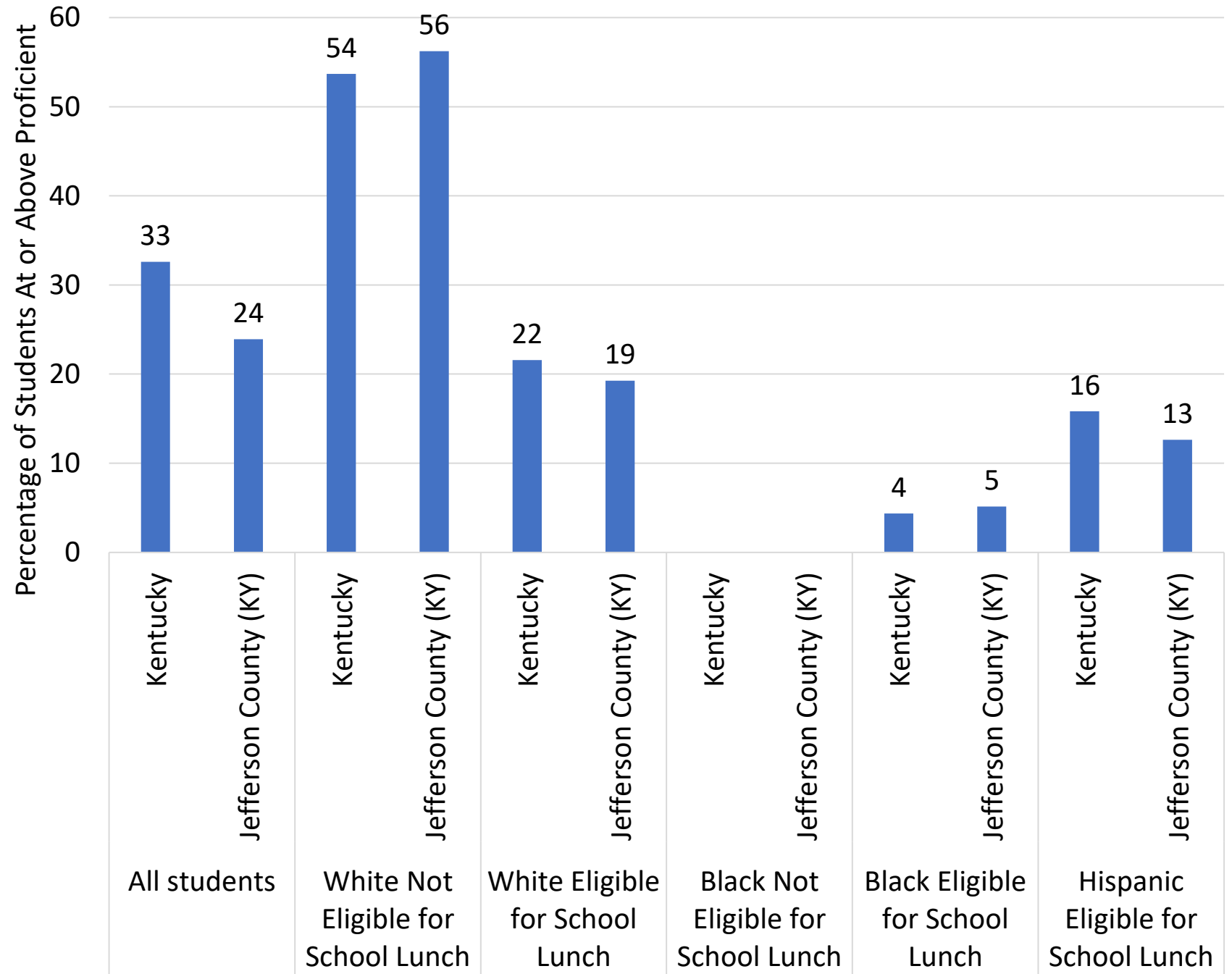

Percentage of Students At or Above Proficient on the National Assessment of Educational Progress in **Fourth Grade Mathematics** by Comparable Student Groups, 2022

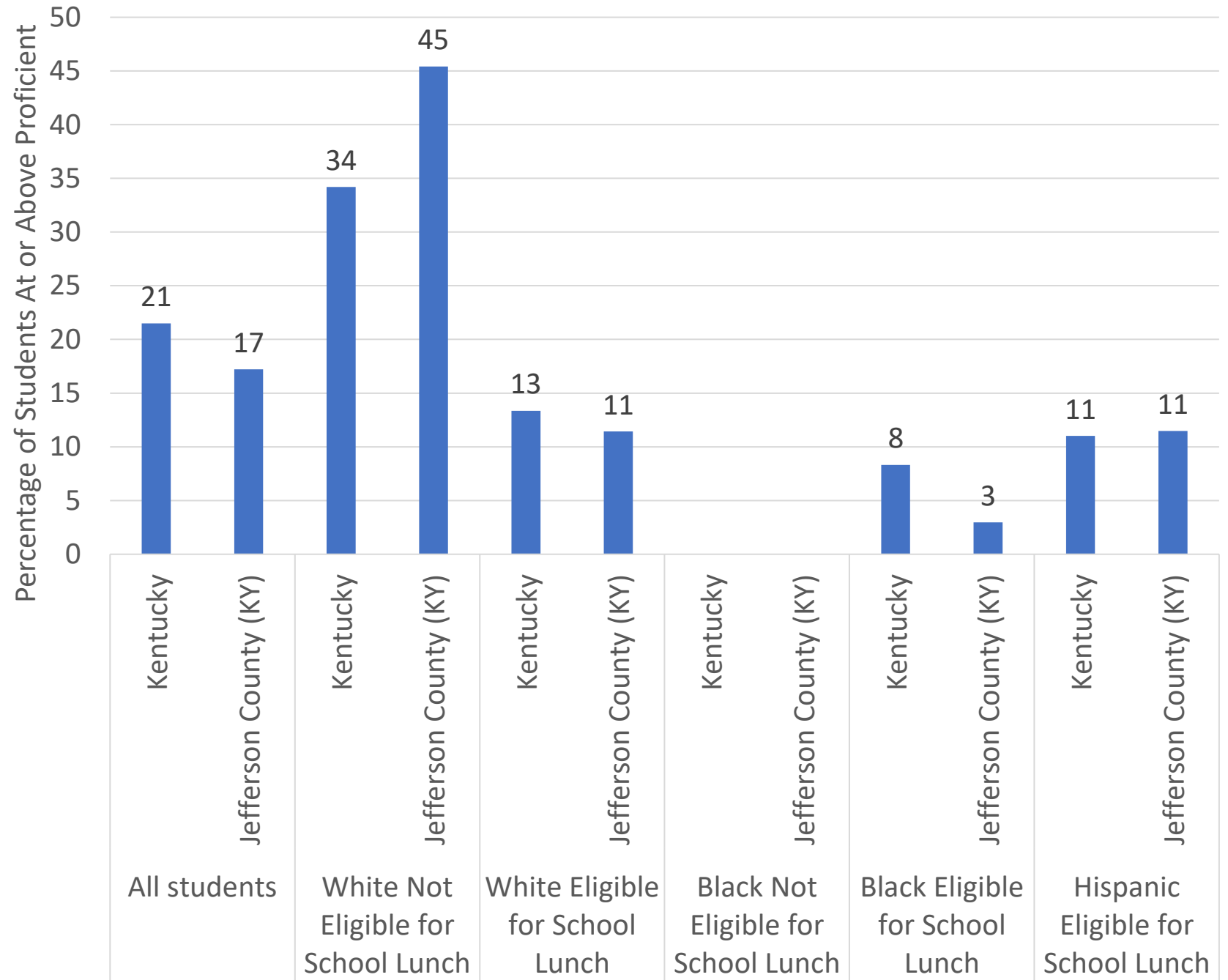

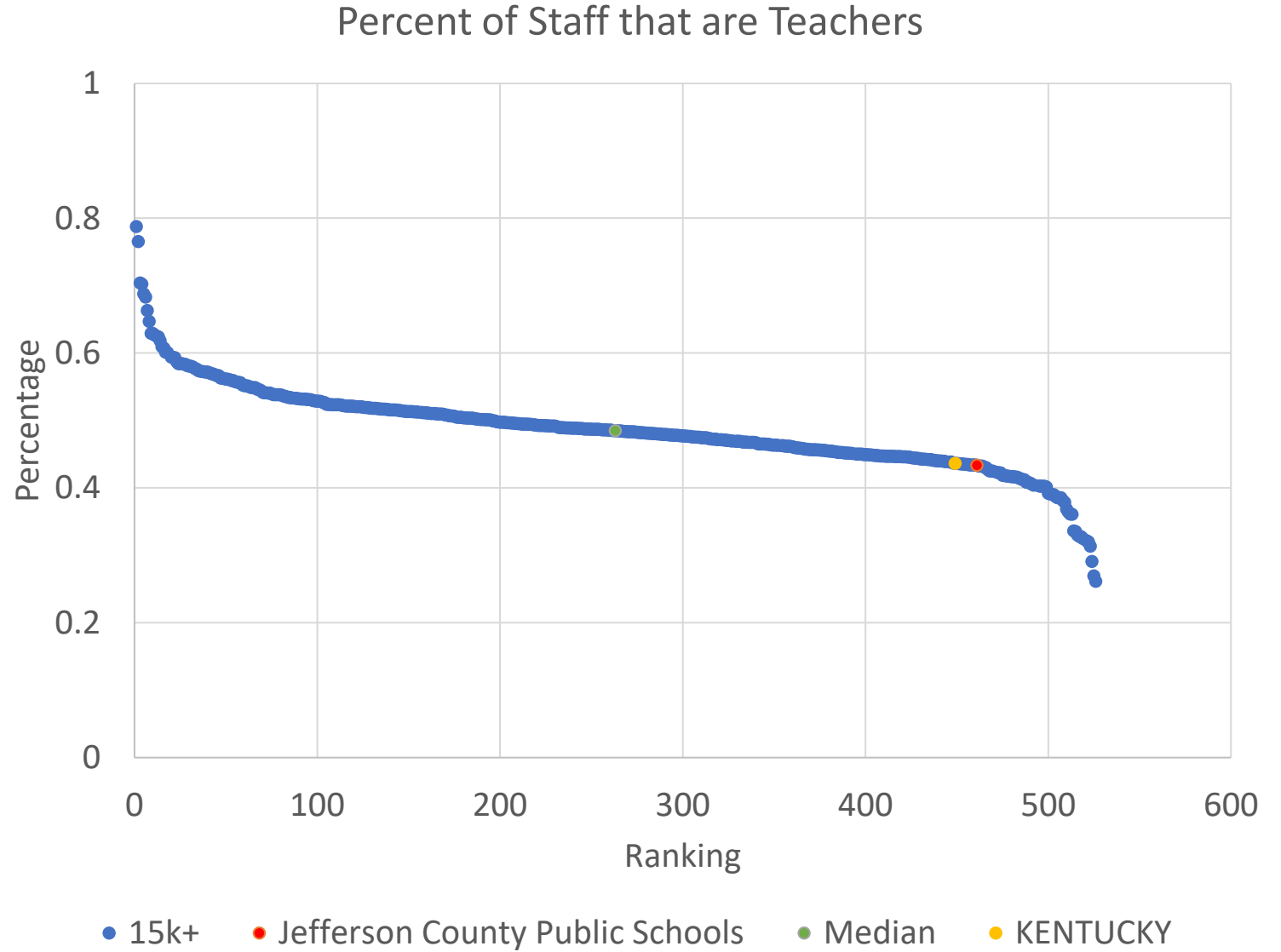




Percentage of Staff that are Teachers, 2022-23

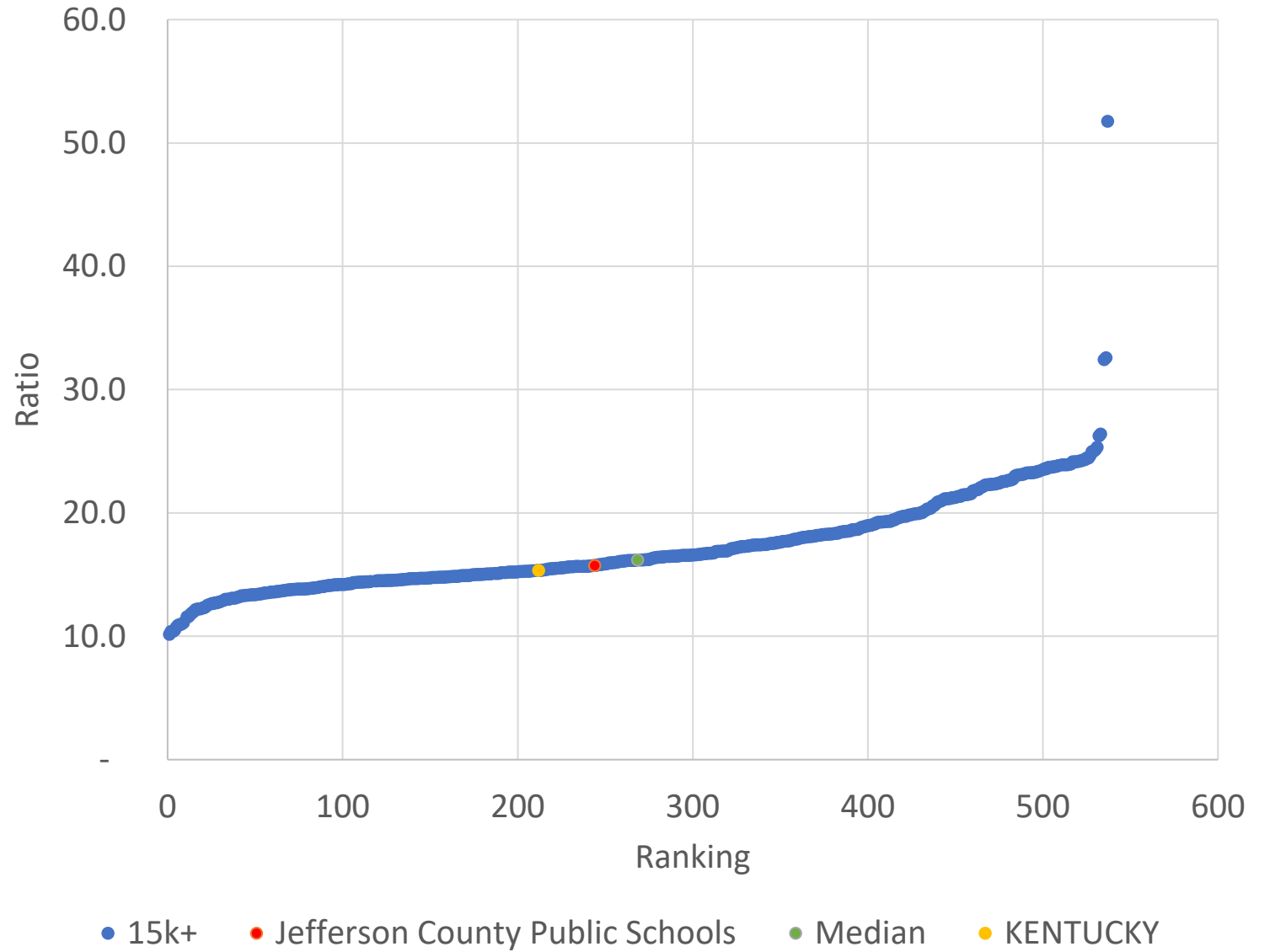




Pupil to Teacher Ratio (All Teachers), 2022-23

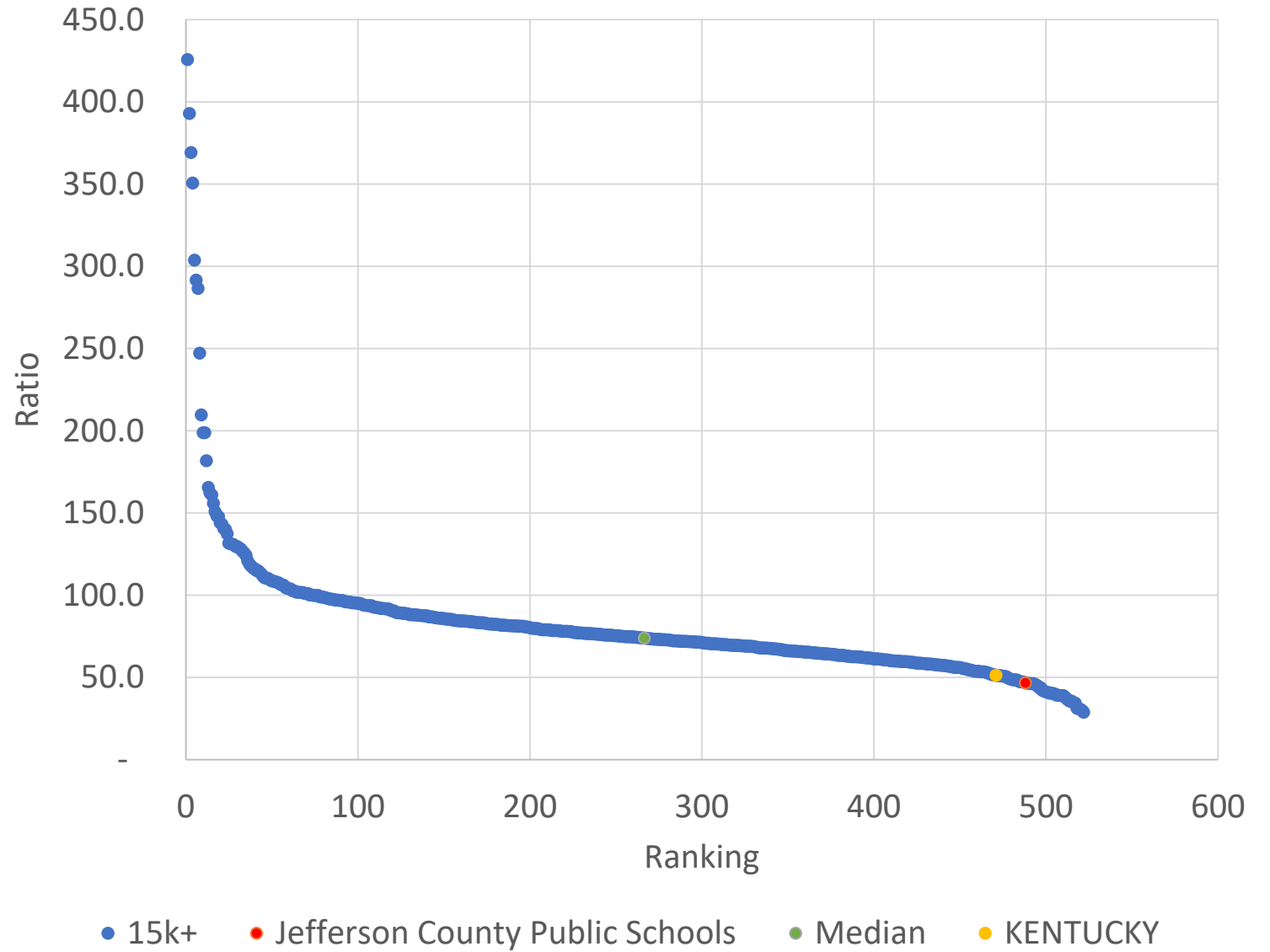




Pupil to Total Administrative Staff Ratio, 2022-23

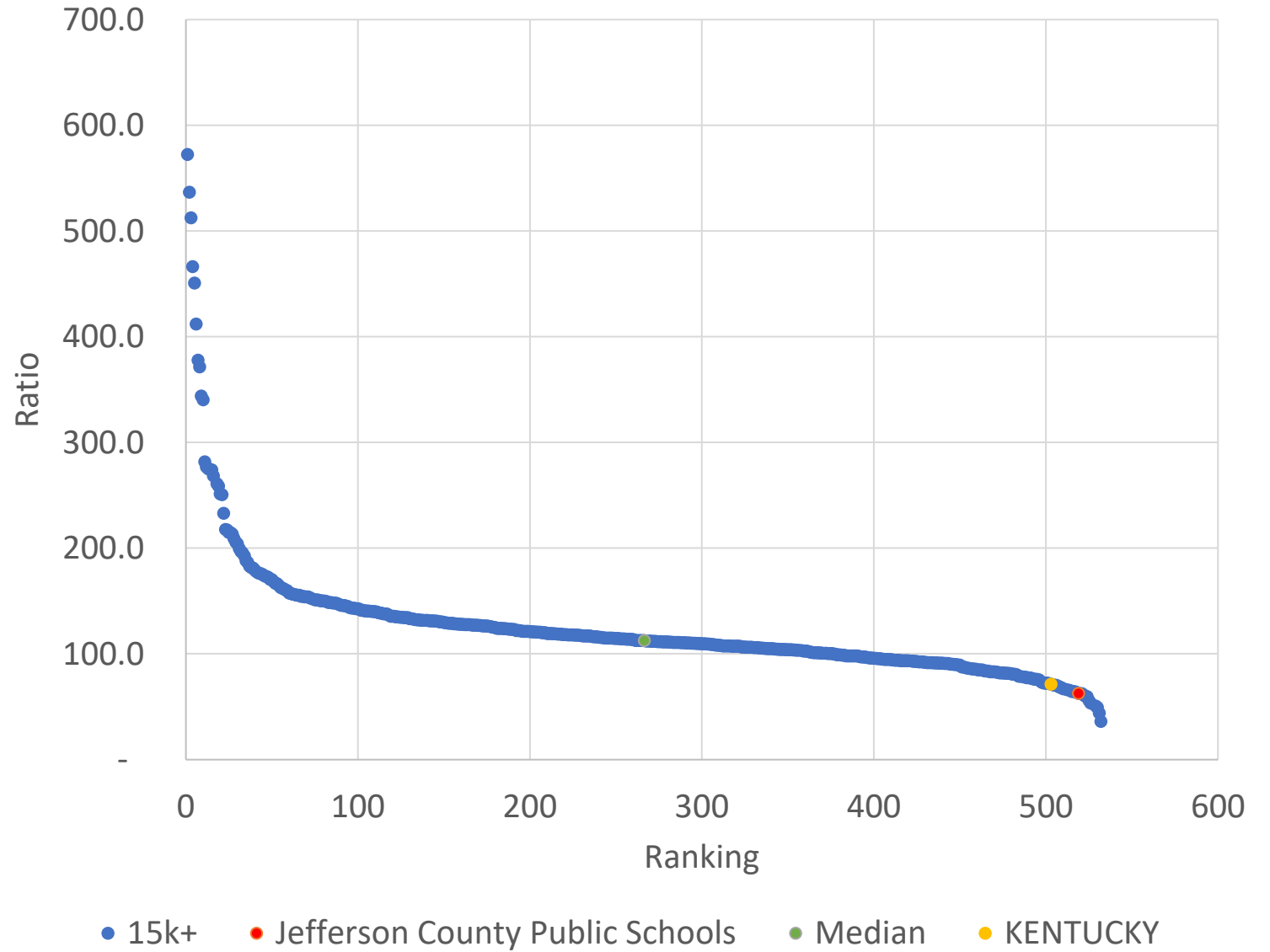




Pupil to School Administrative Staff Ratio, 2022-23
