Maintenance Work Order Backlog

• DEPT. OF MILITARY AFFAIRS manages:

- Real Property valued at over \$545.5 million.
- Over \$13.4 million in fixed assets.
- Over 13,671.646 acres of state owned property.
- Over 363 Buildings totaling over 5,100,000 square feet.
- 52 Armory installations of which 35 are 40 years old or older and make up 70% of backlogged maintenance.
- Prior Major Mnt Pool \$1,000,000 annual funding provides less than 20 cents per square foot ea. yr. (less BGS).
- Capital Construction (Major Maintenance Pool) \$40-600K
 - Over \$45,000,000 in backlogged work orders.
- Operating Budget (Minor Mnt) <\$40,000 each project.
 - Over \$1,800,000 in backlogged work orders.
- Capital Budget Major Maintenance Pool (\$1,000,000)
 - matches dollar for dollar with federal maintenance funds.

DEPT. OF MILITARY AFFAIRS has initiated a comprehensive study to determine the most effective & efficient Armory stationing plan for current force structure.
