

#### Division of Fire Prevention Functions

Statutory Mission – Enforce all laws, administrative regulations, and ordinances relating to fire loss. This includes loss of, or damage to: property and persons by fire, explosions or natural disasters.

#### **KRS Authorizes the State Fire Marshal to:**

- Supervise and make periodic inspections of all property within the state
- Assist local fire departments in making like periodic inspections of all property with the exception of occupied private dwellings
- Investigate the cause, origin, and circumstances surrounding fires and explosions
- Conduct fire prevention and educational campaigns

## Authorizations

Require permits for flammable, combustible, and hazardous material storage vessel installations.

Oversee and register consumer fireworks retail sales sites

- Emergency Response Commission
- Community Crisis Response Board
- Child Care Advisory Counsel
- Department of Housing, Building, and Construction Advisory Board
