It is very standard practice to upgrade the components in an MX chassis without refreshing the chassis itself. I have confirmed with our product management team that there are no plans for the equipment to go EOL in the near future either. This exact equipment is continuing to be purchased to power some of the most mission critical networks in the world (including in neighboring states) and will continue to be purchased for some time still.
