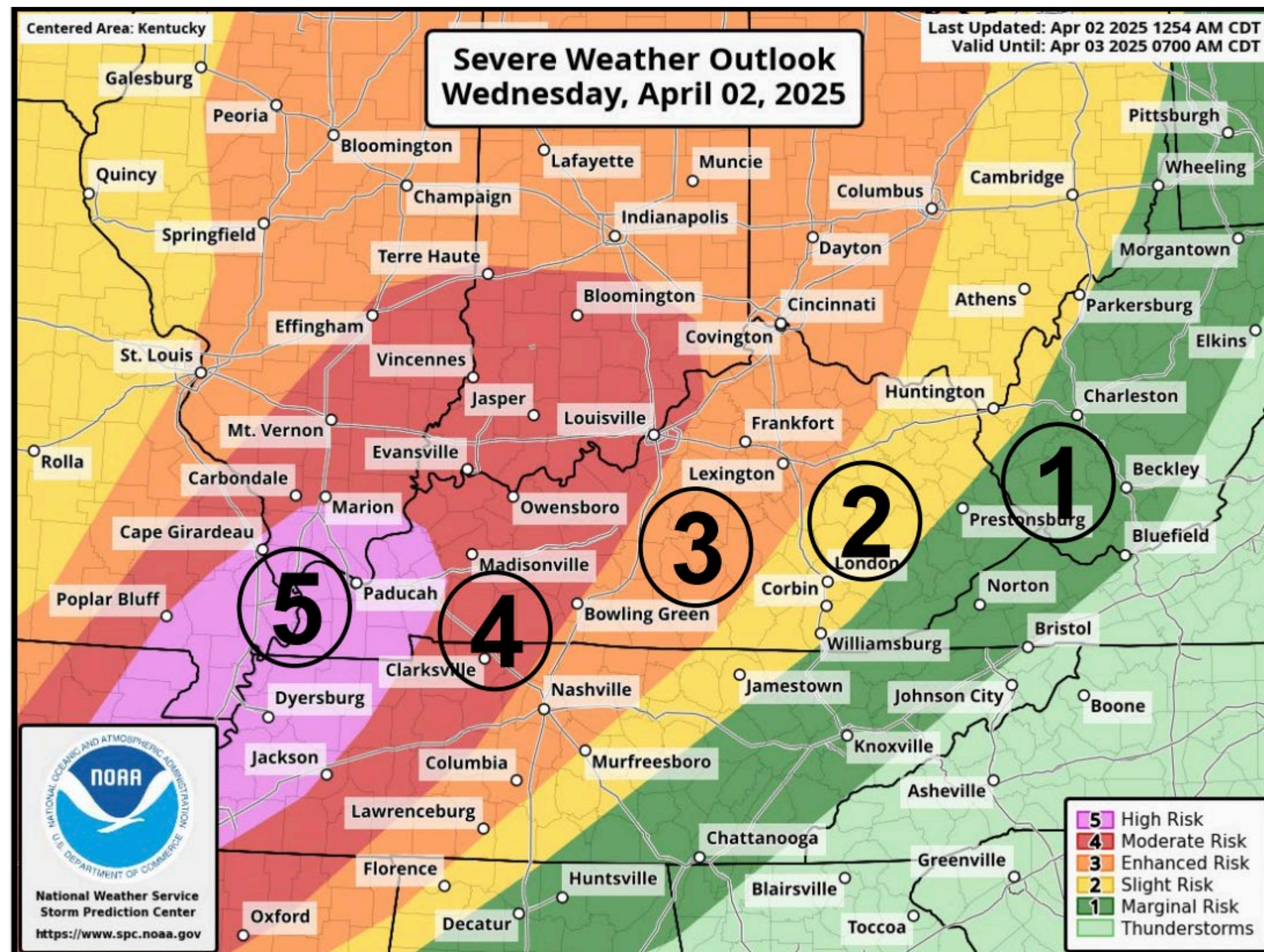

## Kentucky Disasters Statistics



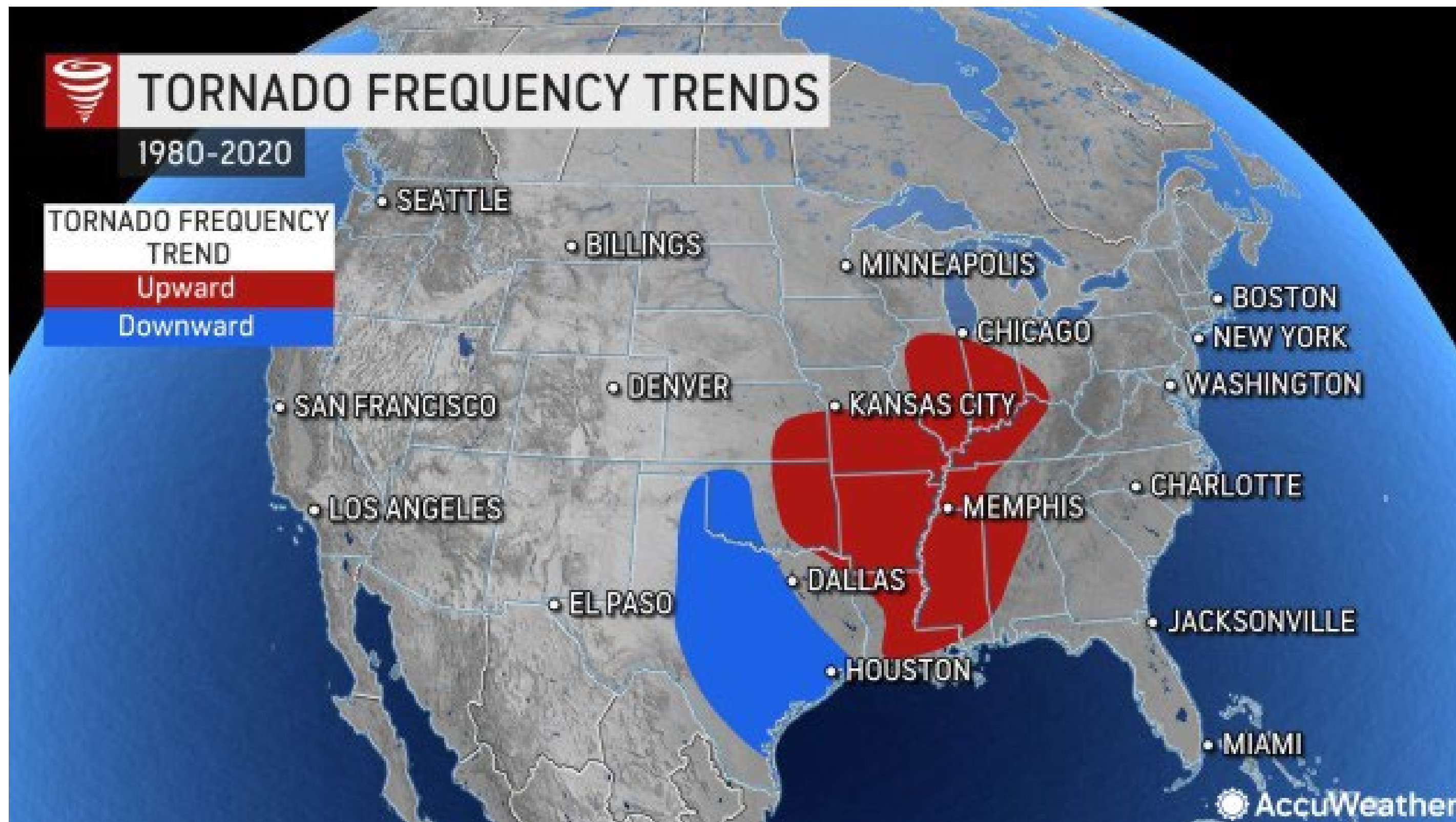
- KY ranks in the **top 10** in federally declared disasters since 2011
- Over **\$500M** in FEMA aid received since 2011

## Kentucky Disasters Statistics



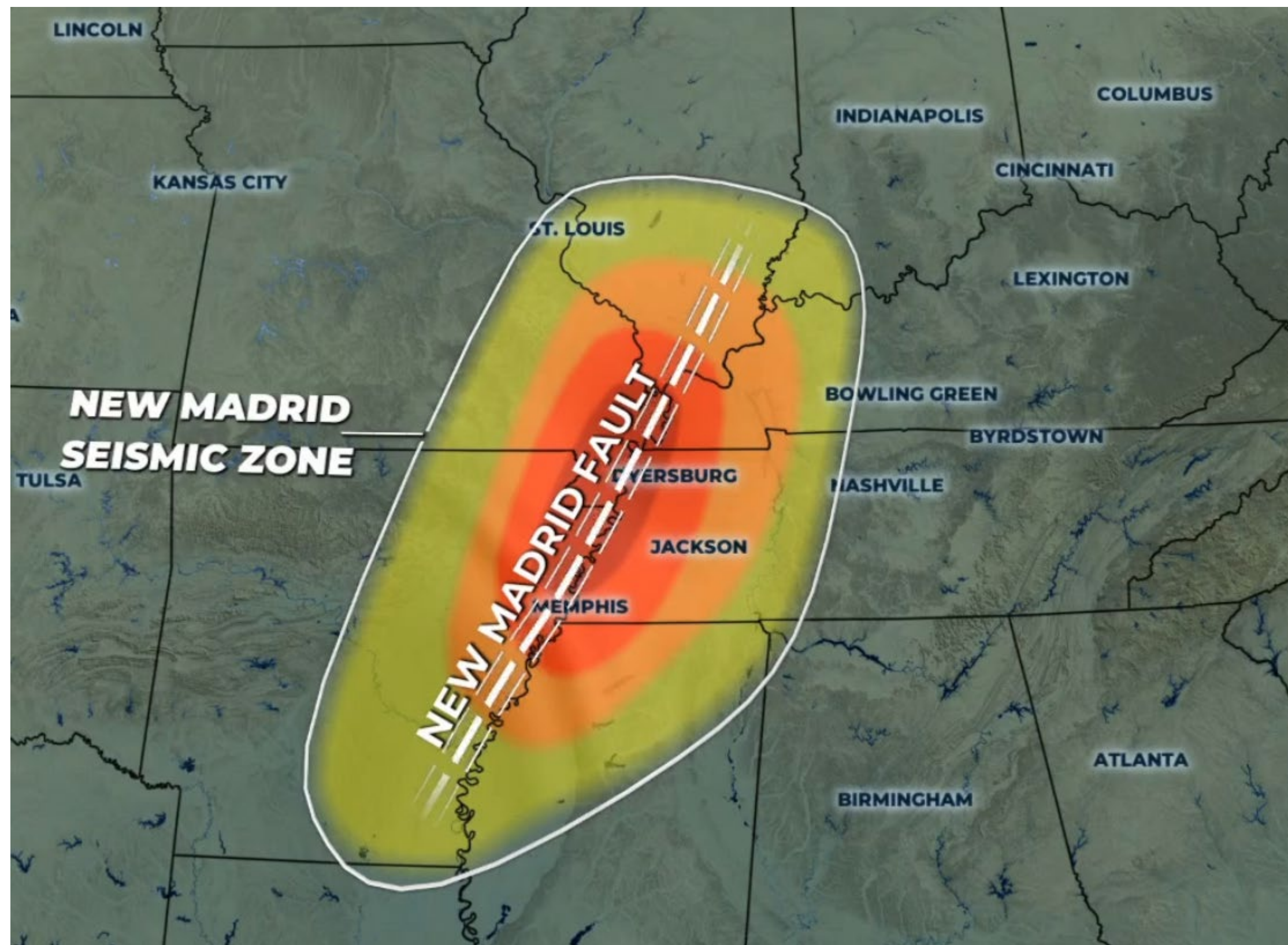
- KY is **#2** in U.S. for the miles of navigable water
- **40** out of the **67** federal disasters since 1953 were flood-related

# Kentucky Disasters Statistics



- The New Madrid Seismic Zone has a moderate probability (25-40% chance) of a large earthquake (magnitude 6.0 or greater) occurring within the next 50 years.







# Recognized Framework of Disaster Recovery



## National Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster (National VOAD)

A **coalition** of major national voluntary organizations in the United States that work together to mitigate and alleviate the impact of disasters.

## State Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster (State VOAD)

Every state and territory in the United States has an active State VOAD. State VOADs are **affiliates of the National VOAD** and play a crucial role in disaster preparedness and response within their respective areas.

## Your Local LTRG

The LTRG is an organization formed **by trusted local leaders** to coordinate efforts and resources in the aftermath of a disaster, focusing on meeting the ongoing, unmet needs of households.

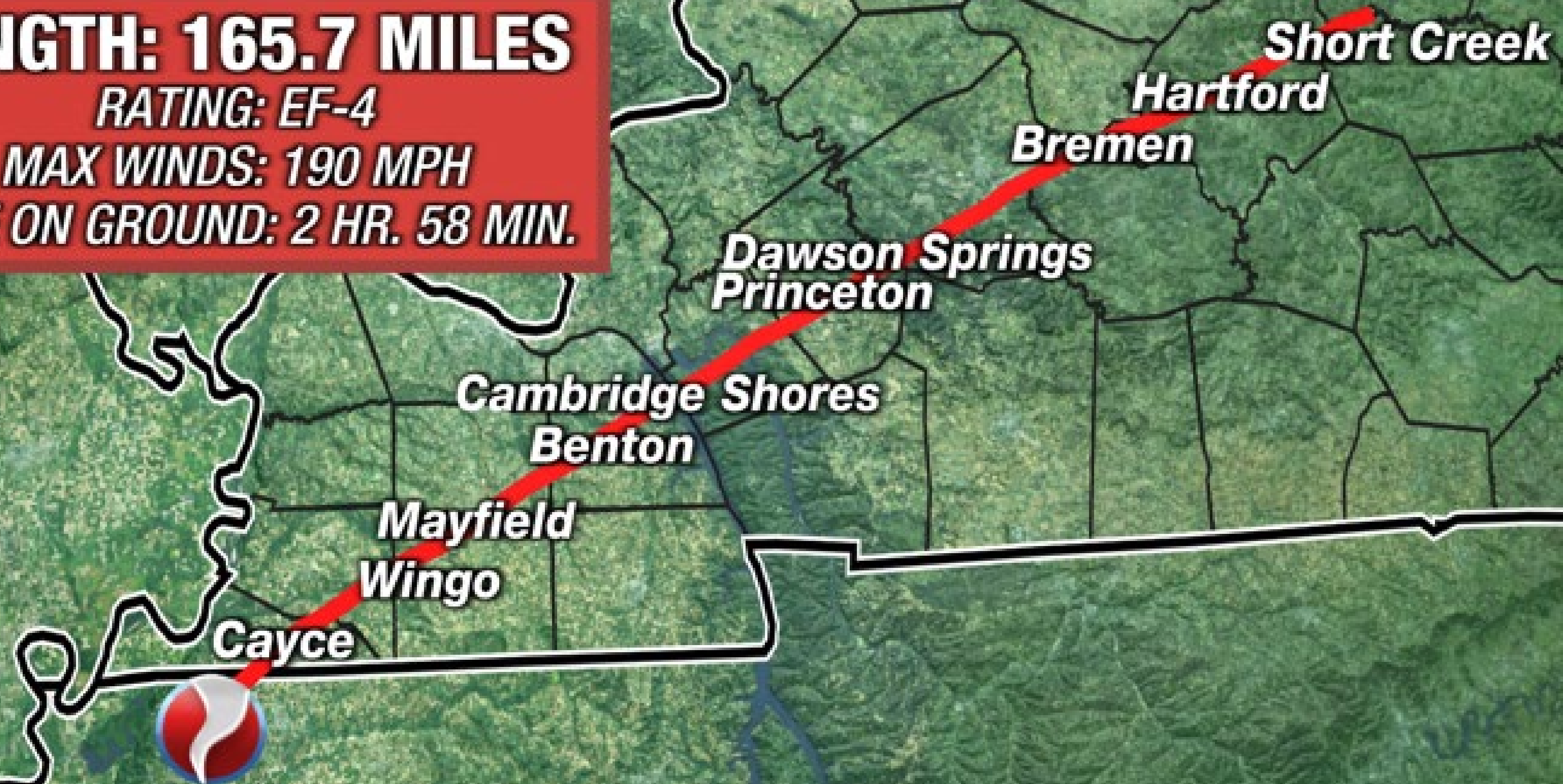

# LONG-TERM RECOVERY GROUP

## Mayfield, KY Impact



- 8 historic churches and more than 60 businesses destroyed
- **Municipal Agencies Destroyed:**
  - Court House – PVA, Sheriff Office, DMV, etc.
  - Fire Department
  - Police Station
  - Post Office
  - School Bus Garage
- **Infrastructure Damaged:**
  - Power Grid
  - Water Treatment Plant & 2 Water Towers







# LONG-TERM RECOVERY GROUP

## Mayfield, KY Impact

- 1,100 housing units damaged
- 400 housing units completely destroyed
- 260 rental units removed from housing stock
- 65% of destroyed housing units were occupied by renters

## Graves County Impact

- 3,806 FEMA Claims
- \$8,543,328.76 FEMA Verified Loss
- \$5,870,117.49 Provided in FEMA Assistance
- Home repairs, rental assistance, personal property replacement, & other needs

## LTRG Development

- Community Meetings Began in March, 2022
- 501c3 Status establish May, 2022
- Warehouse Became Operational in August, 2022

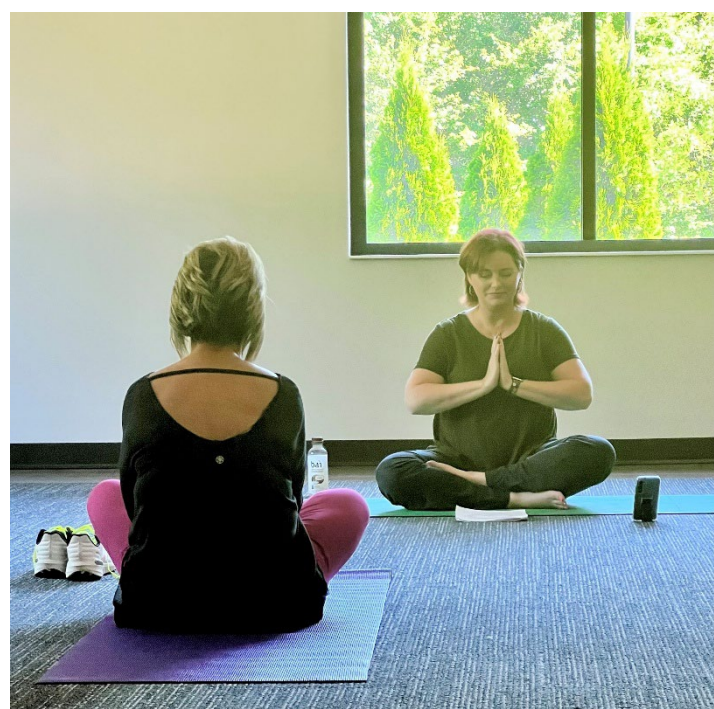

# LONG-TERM RECOVERY GROUP

## Warehouse and Logistics

- 32,000 sq ft warehouse
  - Easy access to i69, 4 acres for Connex, camper, and other outdoor storage options
- Equipment:
  - Forklift, shrink wrap machine, pallet jacks, hand dollies, shelving, etc.
- Vehicles:
  - 2002 Ford E150 Van, 2002 Chevrolet 14' Box Truck, & 2024 Dodge 3500 Flatbed Truck











# LONG-TERM RECOVERY GROUP

## Warehouse and Logistics

- Managing **Donations** and Partner Relationships
  - \$1,749,316.17 in physical donations leveraged
  - Good360, Matthew25 Ministries, Kohler, Temper Sealy, Mayfield Tornado Relief Fund, KY Colonels, etc.
- Supporting a Network of **Partnerships**
  - New Lease on Life, UMCOR, Samaritan's Purse, Fuller, Camp Graves, etc.
- Oversight of Campers & Volunteer Bunkhouse







# LONG-TERM RECOVERY GROUP

## Volunteer Coordination

- Recruitment, Skills Assessments, Volunteer Housing, & Oversight
- Supporting LTRG, NLOL, and Other Partners through repeat disasters
- Volunteer Hours Served: 87,204
- Monetary Value of Volunteer Labor: \$2,519,883.72

# LONG-TERM RECOVERY GROUP

## Subsequent Disasters

### July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Flood

- Mayfield set the state record for the most rainfall in a 24 hour period, receiving **11.28"** of rain.
- **139** Impacted Households
- **121** Households Received Referrals for Assistance
- **88** Households Received support in Long Term Recovery
- Funding Secured for Flood Recovery Efforts: **\$121,613.27**

### May 27, 2024 Storms & Tornados

- Graves County was hit by multiple rounds of straight-line winds and an EF-1 tornado.
- **55** Impacted Households
- **32** Households Provided Volunteer Support w/ debris and tree removal
- **26** Households Provided Referrals to Partner Agencies for Financial Support

### April 2-6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 Severe Weather

- Graves County was hit by multiple rounds of severe weather, flooding, and an EF-1 tornado.
- **40** Impacted Households
- **35** Households Received Referrals for Assistance
- **17** Households will need Long Term Recovery support
- Funding Secured for Flood Recovery Efforts: **\$141,060.48**

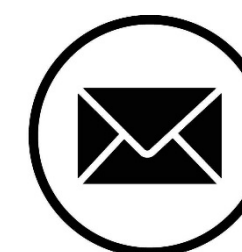
