Cross-Program Waitlist Overlap

Per-waiver cross-listing detail, as of 08/17/2026 — how many waitlisted individuals are already on another waiver's waitlist, or already have a slot allocated in another waiver:

SCL stands out: 49% of its waitlist already holds an allocated slot in a different waiver, and another 42% appear on at least one other waiver's waitlist. ABI-LTC's 55% figure is directionally similar but drawn from a base of only 11 — not statistically meaningful on its own.
