
- 1. Local labor market
 - a. 20% over minimum wage to start
 - b. Workforce participation rate (Ms. Jensen to cover)
- 2. H2-A program
 - a. Uncapped, Seasonal versus year-round agricultural workers
 - b. Legal programs decrease illegal immigration from Mexico
 - c. 55.8% of H2-A certified workers in North Carolina, Washington, Florida, Georgia & California
- 3. H2-B program
 - a. Capped at 66k + 30k added in '19, temporary non-agricultural workers
 - b. Predominantly-used in hospitality and tourism in larger states
 - c. Utilized by trainers
