Overview of External Structure

- Federal funding from the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS)
- State service commissions, like Serve
 Kentucky, are conduits for the federal CNCS
 funds for administrative grants and
 AmeriCorps program grants







Overview of Internal Structure

- Name change from the Kentucky Commission on Community Volunteerism and Service, effective July 1, 2018
- 15-25 bipartisan commission board members, appointed and re-appointed by the Governor
- 4 full-time and 5-6 part-time staff members
- 20 AmeriCorps program grants, and 3 administrative grants



Serve Kentucky Funding

AmeriCorps Competitive Grants \$4,067,702

AmeriCorps Formula Grants \$2,614,834

Education Awards (\$5,920 each FTE) \$3,680,464

Serve Kentucky Grants (CSG, TTA, VGF) \$1,097,002

Serve Kentucky's Federal Funds \$11.5 million



Serve Kentucky Funding Match

AmeriCorps Grant Local Match \$10,583,911

Serve Kentucky In-Kind Match \$215,625

State General Funds \$200,000

Subtotal \$10,999,536

+ Federal Funds (previous slide) \$11,531,266

Serve Kentucky ROI (\$1 SGF = \$112.65)

\$22.5 million

- Approximately 19 million service hours, and
- Education awards more than \$44.3 million










Capacity Building and Volunteerism
