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# Operations and Services

**\$40.47/DAY**

- Oversight of medical care
- 24 hour supervision
- Medication services including administration
- Residential care
- Housekeeping/Laundry Services
- Personal care services/bathing supplies/linens/clothing/furniture

# Operations and Services continued....

902 KAR 20:036

**\$40.47/DAY**

- Therapeutic diets
- Consultation by a qualified dietician or qualified nutritionist
- 3 meals a day and 3 healthy snacks
- Daily activity services
- \*Provide basic instruction in ADL's and IADL's to residents transitioning to community living

# First Option for Kentucky

**\$40.47/DAY**

## Do nothing:

- Freestanding PC Homes will close due to increased costs of operations (i.e. competitive wages for staff, services costs, and other costs)

## Results of doing nothing:

- 3200 Residents across Kentucky will need new placements
- Loss of an important level in the continuum of care
- Increase costs to state: Jails, Homelessness, Hospital emergency room visits, Increased risk of drug addiction

# Second Option for Kentucky

**\$40.47/DAY**

Increase reimbursement and let PC Homes be part of the solution:

- PC Homes will be asking for a rate increase during the 2020 Session
- Last rate increase for PC Homes was in 2006

Results of increasing reimbursement:

- Continue to take care of those with SMI (care, medication, food, services, etc.)
- Most cost efficient level of care
