


Number of Youth in Out of Home Care






Total DCBS and PCP Foster Homes

September 2014 – September 2019






Months to Permanency Reunifications




Months to Permanency Adoptions

Three key transitions:




Of the \$18M spent on family preservation and prevention services, 96% of those families remained together and did not result in a child being removed from the home.
