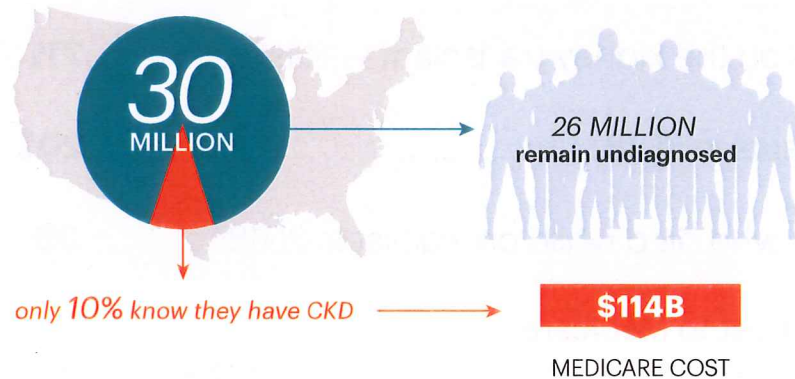


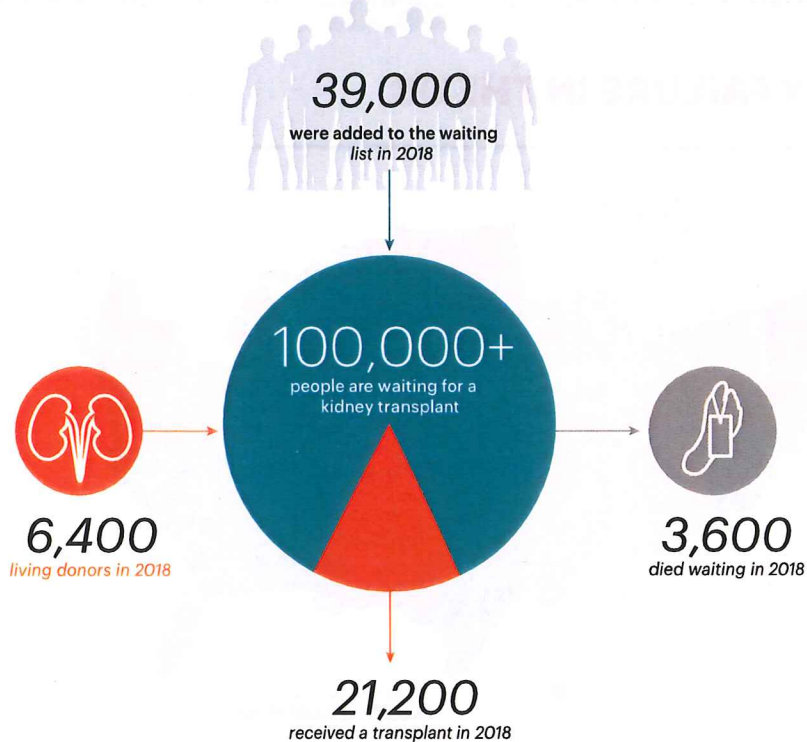

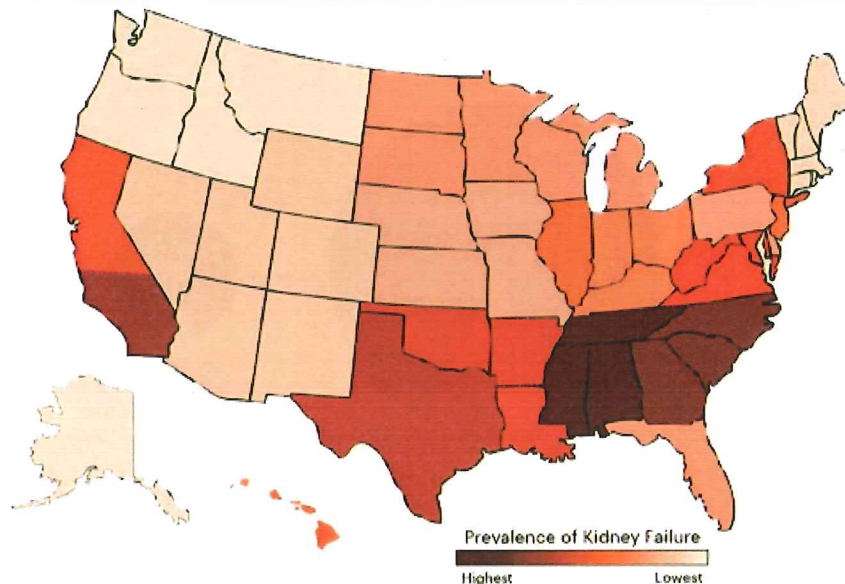
KIDNEY DISEASE IN **KENTUCKY**
