# **Goals for Public Health Transformation**

- Relieve the fiscal instability of the current system.
- Introduce a simplified and focused public health (PH) model with clearly defined priorities.
- Prevent duplication of effort, and reduce waste internally and externally.
- Support and emphasize data-driven decisions to best promote community health outcomes.

# **Proposed Legislation**

- Outlines the Public Health Transformation structure in statute to ensure accountability at the state and local levels in the future.
- Provides a model for funding the statutorily mandated public health services (known as Foundational Services).
- Sets criteria for local public health priorities to ensure they are data driven, evidence-based or promising practices, are performance or quality based, are adequately funded, and include an exit strategy.
- Eliminates restrictions in current statutes and allows appropriate fees to cover cost of services and eliminate the need for state and local taxpayers to subsidize private businesses.

# Public Health Transformation Addresses These Challenges

- Fiscal Instability of Local Health Departments ~ \$40M deficit in 2020 without significant changes
- Current Programmatic Services Are Not Reflective of Community Public Health Needs
- Public Health Transformation Allows Communities To:
  - Evaluate community assets
  - Define local health priorities

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
