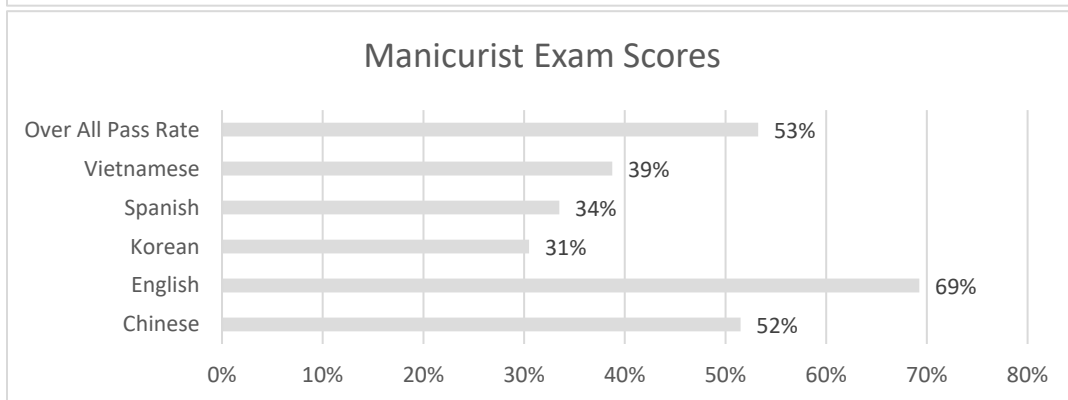
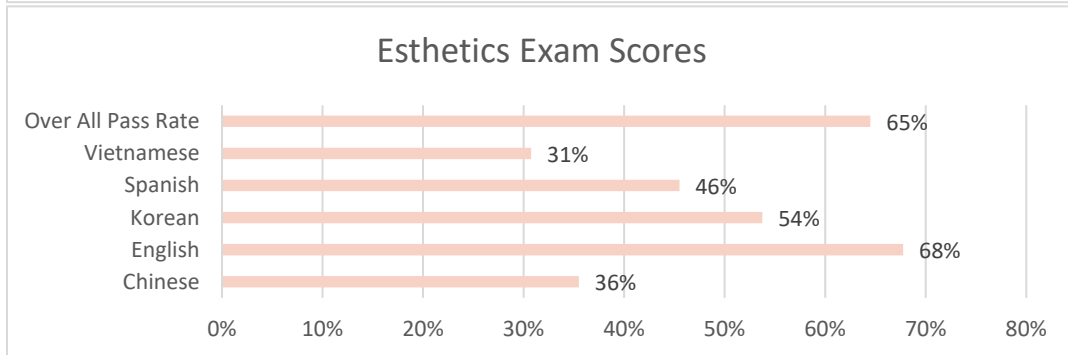
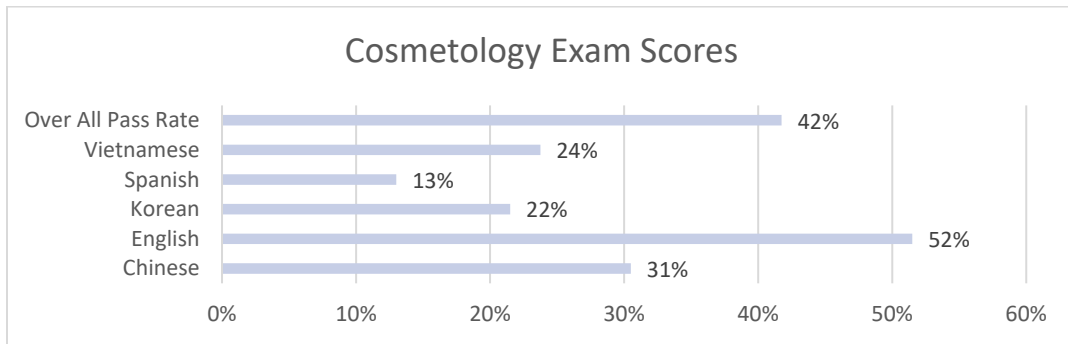
Kentucky & National Average Pass Rates



KY Border State Examinations (2022)



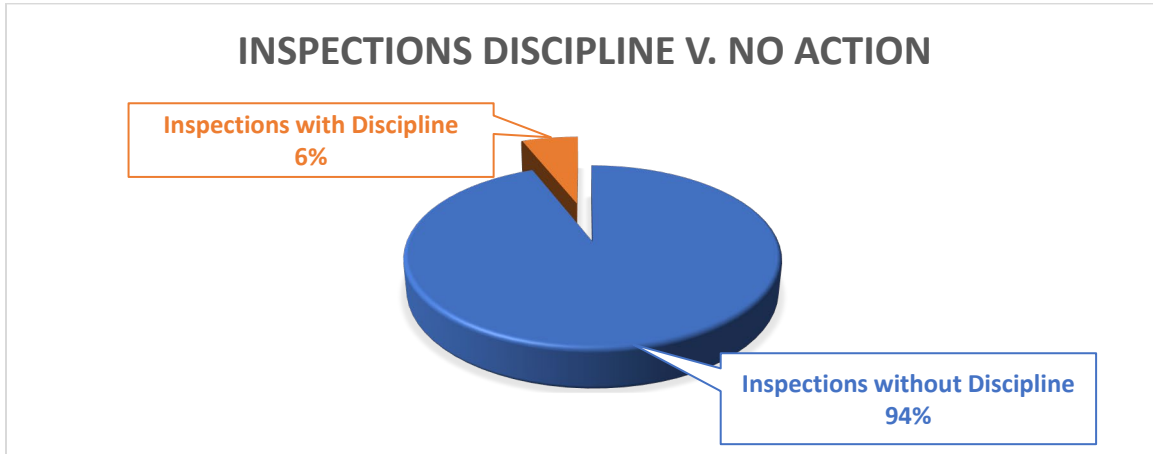
California Pass Rates- Largest Cosmetology License Base in US



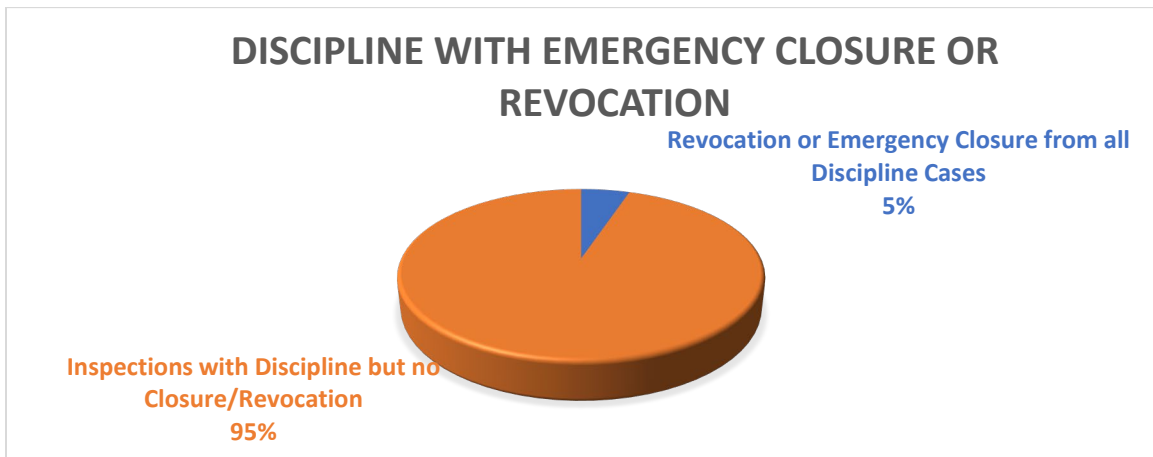
KBC Licensee Discipline (Data from Jan. 2021 – Nov. 2023)

(Review of 3 Years of Inspections and Discipline)

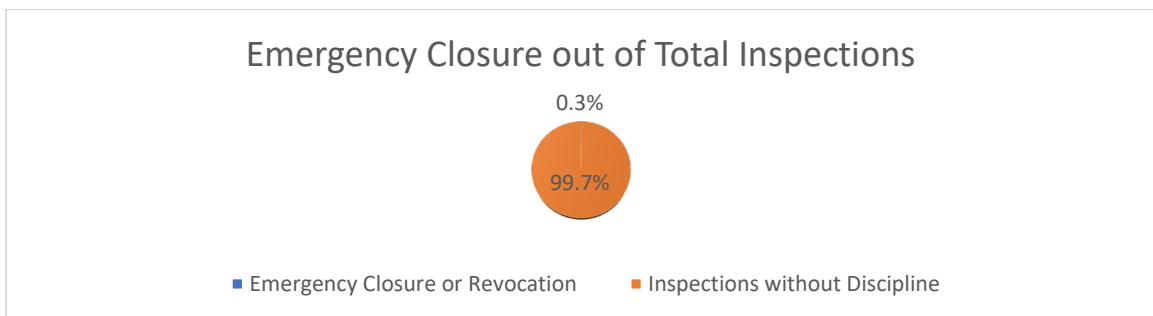
- The board has conducted approximately 7200 inspections during 2021-2023.
- During this time only 423 cases had discipline action by the board.
- Average fine for the 423 cases is \$1,400.



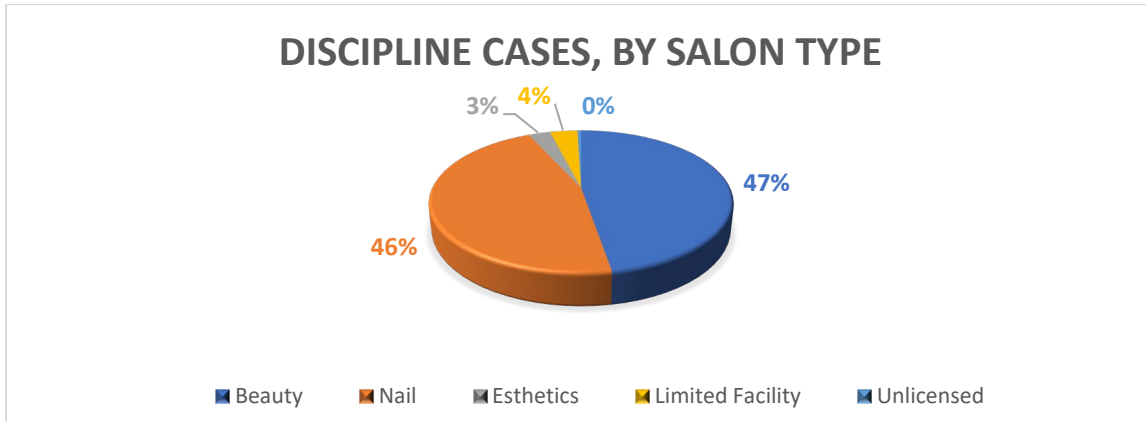
- 22 cases resulted in emergency closure or revocation; of those, only 10 remain closed today.



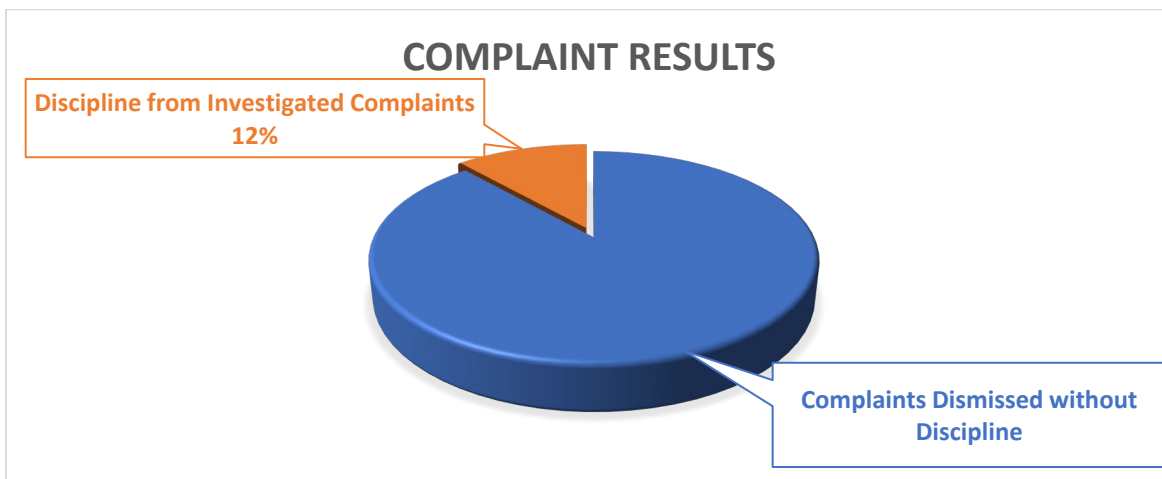
- Out of total inspections only .3% resulted in an emergency closure or revocation action. With more than 50% of those closures now reopened the board revoked less than .14% of salons inspected.



- This shows the variety of facility licenses that were disciplined and the complaints that led to the inspections with discipline action.



- 1,100 Complaints were filed by the public during this time, and all were investigated. 88% of these were dismissed with no further action, and the other 12% resulted in some discipline being issued.



- Out of the 423 discipline cases, 30% resulted in discipline action from a complaint investigation. The remaining 70% of discipline cases stemmed from a standard regulatory inspection.
