

Key Components of a Successful Compensation Law

- 1. Set amount of compensation per years of incarceration HB571: \$65,000/yr, with additional award for years on death row, probation, parole, or sex offender registry
- Provides access to non-monetary services
 HB571: Access to counseling, housing assistance, personal financial literacy assistance, tuition, health care
- 1. Ensures fair and straightforward process through courts
 HB571: Judges determine if petitioners have proven
 innocence under same burden as federal wrongful
 conviction claims
- Fiscally responsible for taxpayers
 HB571: Includes civil offset so claimants are not "double dipping"
- Allows exonerees to move on with their lives
 HB571: Provides certificate of innocence and allows record sealing or expungement
