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Section 22 of SB 199 amends KRS 186.060 to require that applications for the registration of motor vehicles leased or owned by a governmental unit, be entered into AVIS by the county clerk. It is unknown if this will lead to increased administrative costs to the county clerk.

Section 24 of SB 199 sets a fee of \$40 for the reinstatement of a suspended or revoked registration. Of which, the county clerk shall retain \$20.

The fiscal impact of SB 199 is indeterminable, but expected to be positive due to the money received from the reinstatement fee in Section 24.

The Transportation Cabinet has been asked to provide data related to SB 199. This local mandate will be updated once the requested information has been received.
