Consideration of Bills

SB 91/CS

AN ACT relating to identity documents.

Sponsor: Senator Jimmy Higdon

Senate Bill 91 was discussed by its sponsor, Senator Jimmy Higdon, who indicated there was a committee substitute on the measure. Senator Brandon Smith made a motion to adopt the committee substitute. Senator Phillip Wheeler seconded the motion, which passed by voice vote. After brief discussion, Senator Phillip Wheeler made a motion to pass Senate Bill 91 as amended by the committee substitute. Senator Robby Mills seconded the motion, which passed on an 8-0-0 roll call vote. Senator Robby Mills made a motion to adopt the title amendment (Doc ID 5399). Senator Phillip Wheeler seconded the motion, which passed by voice vote.

SB 107/CS

AN ACT relating to transportation and making an appropriation therefor.

Sponsor: Senator Jimmy Higdon

Senate Bill 107 was recommitted to the committee and discussed by its sponsor, Senator Jimmy Higdon, who indicated there was a committee substitute on the measure. Senator Robby Mills made a motion to adopt Senate Committee Substitute Two. Senator Phillip Wheeler seconded the motion which passed by voice vote. After brief discussion, Senator Phillip Wheeler made a motion to pass Senate Bill 107 as amended by the committee substitute.
