**PURPOSE OF MEASURE:** This measure would allocate Federal Funds made available through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund to the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority (KIA) towards administering the Drinking Water and Wastewater Grant Program specified provisions in FY 22 and declaring an emergency.

Section 2 of the measure also makes provisions for the reimbursement of contracted providers of substance abuse, mental health and reentry center and requires a report of said providers about the specifics of their inmate patients.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** KIA is going to administer the grant program and will provide grants up to \$250 million.

There would be no fiscal impact on the Department of Corrections.
